## illegible

## damage

## philosophy

- the study of general and fundamental questions, such as those about existence, reason, knowledge, values, mind

## provocative

## conjure

participate

adventurer

a person who enjoys or seeks dangerous and exciting experiences

synonym: explorer, entrepreneur, daredevil

undiscovered

adj. not yet found or known

#### academic

adj. associated with schools, colleges, and universities, especially studying and thinking, not with practical skills synonym: educational, scholarly, theoretical

#### mere

adj. used to emphasize how insignificant or minor someone or something is

synonym: bare, minor, sheer

## scholarly

adj. relating to or characteristic of academic study synonym: academic, learned, erudite

(1) scholarly article, (2) scholarly attainment

The **scholarly** journal published articles on various academic subjects.

#### diminish

to reduce or be reduced in size, extent, or importance; to make something smaller, weaker, etc.

synonym: decline, dwindle, lessen

#### sliver

## insight

## archaeology

## whip

v. to hit a person or an animal severely with a thin, flexible stick with a cord or leather thong at the end, as a punishment, discipline, etc.

## poem

 a piece of writing that emphasizes the expression of feelings and ideas by paying particular attention to diction (sometimes rhyme), rhythm, and imagery

edit

dam

 a wall constructed over a river to block the flow of water, mainly used to generate energy

synonym: barricade, barrier, embankment

### pronounced

adj. clearly and distinctly expressed or noticeable; emphasized

synonym: emphasized, distinct, noticeable

(1) clearly- **pronounced** utterances, (2) **pronounced** difference

The chef's herbs and spices gave the dish a **pronounced** flavor.

#### ultraviolet

 adj. relating to or occupying the part of the spectrum beyond the violet end, especially radiation

synonym: black light, UV light, invisible light

(1) **ultraviolet** protection, (2) **ultraviolet** light **Ultraviolet** radiation can cause skin damage if one is exposed for too long.

#### trace

- v. to find or discover someone or something that was lost synonym: seek, follow, depict
- (1) **trace** a telephone call, (2) **trace** back to medieval times Let's **trace** the origins of some familiar foreign words.

## spectral

adj. relating to or having the properties of a spectrum (= an ordered array of colors into which a light beam can be split); relating to a ghost or apparition

synonym: spiritual, ghostly, otherworldly

The **spectral** analysis revealed unexpected details about the composition of the planet's atmosphere.

#### fame

 the condition of being well-known and discussed by a large number of people as a result of one's accomplishments, abilities, and so on

synonym: celebrity, renown, stardom

leap into fame,

 Good fame is better than a good face.

#### mathematics

 the science dealing with the logic of quantities, shapes, spaces, and arrangement synonym: arithmetic, calculation, calculus

(1) a good grounding in **mathematics**, (2) **mathematics** competition

He has a flair for mathematics.

## palimpsest

- n. a manuscript or piece of writing material on which the original writing has been effaced to make room for later writing
- (1) **palimpsest** parchment, (2) medieval **palimpsest**The **palimpsest** manuscript he discovered contained layers of text from different centuries, offering a fascinating glimpse into the past.

#### erase

- v. to remove something completely, especially by rubbing it synonym: wipe out, delete, obliterate

#### overwrite

 to replace or overwrite existing data or information with new data, often in the context of computer files or software

#### decide

## plea

 an appeal or request, especially for help or understanding; a legal excuse or defense; an earnest entreaty or supplication

#### grant

- v. to agree to give or allow somebodysynonym: allocate, authorize, give
- (1) grant a new license, (2) grant a landThe chairperson granted him the right to speak.

## government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

## transport

- n. a system for moving people or products from one location to another using automobiles, roads, and so on synonym: shipment, transit, conveyance
- (1) **transport** facilities, (2) access to public **transport** Enhanced rail **transportation** is crucial for our business.
- n. a workplace for the conduct of scientific research; a laboratory

*synonym*: workshop, laboratory, research chamber

(1) **lab** instrument, (2) medical **lab**The Prime Minister will pay a courtesy visit to the Nobel

laureate's **lab**.

#### charred

lab

adj. burned or blackened as a result of being subjected to high heat

synonym: burned, blackened, scorched

(1) charred body, (2) badly charred

The fire left the building a charred shell of its former self.

#### mess

 a state of confusion, dirtiness, or untidiness; (verb) to fail to do something or to make something dirty or untidy

synonym:

disarray, confusion, predicament

(1) have a whole **mess**, (2) get into a **mess** He made a frightful **mess** in his room.

#### classic

adj. judged or deserving to be regarded as one of the best or most important of its kind over a period of time; of a well-known type

synonym: definitive, traditional, typical

(1) a **classic** experiment, (2) Chinese **classic** literature He displayed the **classic** symptoms of depression.

#### infrared

adj. relating to or denoting electromagnetic radiation with a wavelength just longer than that of red light but shorter than that of microwave radiation, used for sensing heat and for remote control

synonym: thermal, warm, radiant

(1) an **infrared** lamp, (2) **infrared** radiation

The **infrared** camera revealed a hidden image on the surface.

#### vision

 the ability to think about or see the future with imagination and intelligence; the faculty of being able to see

synonym: sight, image, concept

(1) a prodigious vision,(2) telescopic visionDriving is difficult for me because of my poor vision.

## goggle

to look at someone or something with amazement; to look stupidly; (noun, plural) tight-fitting spectacles that are worn to prevent particulates, water, or chemicals from striking the eyes

synonym: gaze, gawk, gape

(1) **goggle** his eyes, (2) infrared **goggles**The software company bought the VR **goggles**manufacturer.

### immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately** 

A suspension order from the court is effective **immediately**.

## appreciate

- v. to value and acknowledge the worth of someone or something; to be grateful for something or someone
- synonym: acknowledge, admire, enjoy
- (1) **appreciate** her feedback, (2) **appreciate** the value We would **appreciate** an early reply.

#### visible

adj. capable of being seen; or open to easy view synonym: clear, observable, seeable

(1) visible stars, (2) visible by X-ray

My home is easily **visible** from the shore.

## **spectrum**

 an ordered array of colors into which a light beam can be split

synonym: range, scale, spread

(1) a broad **spectrum** of opinion, (2) infrared **spectrum** This device displayed the speech **spectrum** spectrographically.

#### fraction

 a small part or item forming a piece of a whole; the quotient of two rational numbers

synonym: piece, part, fragment

(1) a **fractional** share of the vote, (2) a numerator in a **fraction** 

He spent only a **fraction** of his earnings.

#### invisible

adj. impossible or nearly impossible to seesynonym: hidden, imperceptible, unseen

(1) an **invisible** asset, (2) **invisible** stars

The phenomenon is **invisible** at optical wavelengths.

#### wavelength

- n. the distance between two points in the same phase in consecutive cycles of a wave
- (1) wavelength of light, (2) long- wavelength laser White color is made up of many different wavelengths of light.

#### individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom

## sequence

- a series of related events, actions, numbers, etc., which have a particular order
- synonym: arrangement, succession, series

## digital

- adj. processing or storing information as a succession of 1 and 0 to show that a signal is present or missing; relating to the use of computer technology, especially the internet
- synonym: numerical, computerized, cyber
- (1) a **digital** watch, (2) **digital** electronic signature Sensors convert physical phenomena into **digital** signals.

## equip

- v. to provide a person or a place with the things that are needed for a particular purpose or activity
- synonym: prepare, furnish, provide
- (1) **equip** an army, (2) **equip** our children with some special skills

The construction company **equipped** the building with an earthquake-resistant device.

#### lens

 a transparent optical device with curved sides, used in an optical instrument that makes objects seem larger, smaller, clearer, etc.; (metaphor) the basic thoughts or mindsets through which someone sees or understands the environment or situation

synonym: glass

(1) a convex lens, (2) a lens with a wide angle The photographer took this photo using a telephoto **lens**.

quartz

a hard, mineral compound consisting of silicon dioxide, often occurring as colorless or white crystals but also found in various colors, and commonly used in jewelry and watches, as well as in the production of glass and other industrial applications

synonym: crystal, mineral, rock

(1) quartz rock, (2) rose quartz

The crystal pendant was made of clear quartz.

capture

to catch a person or an animal and confine them in an area which they cannot escape

synonym: catch, arrest, imprison

(1) **capture** a glimpse, (2) **capture** customers' hearts I was able to **capture** the moment on film.

statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) statistics for cancer, (2) official statistics The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

algorithm

a set of rules or rigorous instructions typically used to solve a specific problem or to perform a computation

synonym: logic, method, rule

(1) the RSA algorithm, (2) algorithm for image processing We can evaluate the performance of an algorithm in terms of computation time.

enhance

to increase or improve the quality, amount, or strength of ν. someone or something

synonym: improve, enrich, refine

(1) **enhance** value, (2) **enhance** the flavor of the vanilla The new strategy will **enhance** the profitability of our company.

## clarify

v. to make something, such as a statement or situation, less confusing and more understandable

synonym: explain, ascribe, purify

(1) clarify a goal, (2) clarify his feelings

The police tried to **clarify** the facts concerning her death.

#### software

 a set of computer programs and associated documentation and data for doing particular computational jobs

synonym: program, system, operating system

(1) **software** architect, (2) copyrighted **software**The company specializes in both hardware and **software**.

## origin

n. the first existence or beginning of something

synonym: root, source, ancestor

(1) **origin** of information, (2) racial **origin** 

There are various hypotheses concerning the **origin** of life.

#### satellite

n. an electronic device that is sent up into space and moves around the Earth or another planet, used for gathering information or communicating by radio, television, etc.

synonym: orbiter, asteroid, moon

(1) a GPS **satellite**, (2) a meteorological **satellite** Launching an artificial **satellite** contributed to the technological development of our country.
