religion

ordinary

relegate

subservient

edict

 a person who performs religious duties and ceremonies, especially in the Christian faith

deacon

in some Christian denominations, an ordained minister ranks below a priest; a layperson chosen to assist and support a priest or pastor in their religious duties, often involved in serving the community and performing charitable acts

chaplain

 a type of poetry that is characterized by a metrical structure and often a rhyme scheme

pervasive

exterior

adj. very great in amount or degree

sew

urine

 a liquid by-product of metabolism in humans and in many other animals that are released from the body when you urinate

menstruate

v. to have or experience the process in a woman's menstrual cycle during which blood and other materials are discharged from the uterus

mutilate

v. to cause severe damage, disfigurement, or injury, usually to a person or an animal; to destroy, alter, or damage something severely or irreparably

affliction

 a condition of physical or mental suffering or distress, often caused by illness, injury, or other adversity; a burden or trouble that causes hardship or grief

mandate

rap

slavery

- the practice or system of owning, buying, and selling people as property and forcing them to work synonym: bondage, servitude, enslavement

trafficking

n. the illegal trade in goods, services, or people, often across national borders

admire

 to have regard for or respect for someone's qualities or the actions they have performed

assault

 a violent physical attack; the crime of forcing someone to submit to sexual intercourse against their will

command

submarine


