#### retinoblastoma

n. a rare type of malignant tumor that develops in the retina of the eye, primarily affecting young children, characterized by abnormal cell growth and can lead to vision loss or other eye-related complications if left untreated

*synonym*: ocular cancer, eye tumor

(1) **retinoblastoma** tumor, (2) **retinoblastoma** gene Early detection and treatment of **retinoblastoma** can save both vision and lives.

#### retina

- the innermost light-sensitive membrane covering the back wall of the eyeball
- (1) **retinal** cells, (2) **retina** scanner

  Damage to the **retina** may play a role in the development of glaucoma.

#### awaken

- v. to stop sleeping or to cause someone to stop sleeping synonym: rouse, arouse, revive
- (1) **awaken** at daybreak, (2) **awaken** a child The friend's death **awakens** them.

#### crib

n. a small, enclosed bed for a baby, typically on rockerssynonym: bed, bassinet, cradle



(1) crib bed, (2) baby crib

She put the baby in the portable **crib** for a nap.

## incomprehensible

adj. impossible to understand or explain; not able to be grasped or comprehended

synonym: unintelligible, unfathomable, inexplicable

(1) **incomprehensible** jargon, (2) **incomprehensible** math problem

The mathematical formula was **incomprehensible** to most of the students.

## epitome

 a person or thing that is a typical or perfect example of a particular quality or type

synonym: embodiment, apotheosis

(1) an **epitome** of history, (2) world's **epitome** 

He was the **epitome** of courage, always standing up for his beliefs.

## hapless

adj. having no luck; unfortunate

synonym: unfortunate, unlucky, pitiable

(1) her hapless fate, (2) hapless situation

The **hapless** victim had no way to defend themselves.

## ravage

v. to cause damage to something badly

*synonym*: devastate, ruin, destroy

(1) ravage a country, (2) ravage the brain

A large fire ravaged the forest.

## poetic

 adj. of or relating to poetry (= a piece of writing that emphasizes the expression of feelings and ideas); using language in an imaginative and expressive way

synonym: literary, verse-like, rhythmic

(1) poetic genius, (2) poetic justice

The sunset was so beautiful it looked like a **poetic** scene from a movie.

## pragmatic

adj. practical rather than idealisticsynonym: practical, realistic, down-to-earth

(1) **pragmatic** approach, (2) **pragmatic** politics

He was a **pragmatic** leader who made decisions based on what was practical rather than ideal.

## adaptable

adj. able or willing to modify or be modified to deal with new situations

synonym: flexible, adjustable, elastic

(1) **adaptable** enough for the environment, (2) an **adaptable** person

We seek a candidate who possesses **adaptable** fighting potential.

## immobilize

- v. to render someone or something unable to move or function normally; to restrain, inhibit, or stop
- synonym: incapacitate, paralyze, disable
- (1) **immobilize** the city, (2) **immobilize** our opponent The paramedics had to **immobilize** the accident victim to prevent further injury during transport to the hospital.

## dignify

v. to make something worthy of respect or honor; to elevate or give importance to something that may otherwise be considered insignificant

synonym: elevate, ennoble, honor

(1) dignify the role, (2) dignify the occasion

It's important to **dignify** other people's opinions and not dismiss them without consideration.

## imaginable

- adj. capable of being imaginedsynonym: conceivable, plausible, possible
- (1) easily **imaginable**, (2) worst **imaginable** case This is the only **imaginable** strategy.

## mishap

 an unfortunate or unlucky accident or incident, often resulting in injury or damage

synonym: accident, misfortune, incident

(1) avoidable **mishap**, (2) unfortunate **mishap**The small **mishap** caused a delay in the construction schedule.

#### moniker

n. a name or nickname, especially one that is unconventional or adopted rather than given

synonym: name, nickname, alias

(1) royal **moniker**, (2) commonly used **moniker**The **moniker** of The King of Pop will forever be associated with Michael Jackson.

#### whoosh

n. a rushing or swishing sound, such as that made by something moving quickly through the air or by a sudden gust of wind; (verb) to move swiftly with a rushing or whooshing sound

synonym: swoosh, swish, whizz

(1) whoosh of a falling object, (2) hear a whoosh The whoosh of the wind through the trees was the only sound in the forest.

## endemic

adj. (of a disease or other problem) regularly found among particular people or in a certain area

synonym: prevalent, widespread, native

(1) **endemic** disease, (2) cholera- **endemic** area Malaria is **endemic** in many tropical countries.

lectern

 a tall stand or podium with a slanted top used to hold a book or notes from which a speaker can read or deliver a speech

*synonym*: podium, stand, platform

(1) portable **lectern**, (2) **lectern** microphone

The speaker stood confidently behind the wooden **lectern**, ready to deliver their important speech.

#### centimeter

- a unit of measurement of length in the metric system, equivalent to one-hundredth of a meter
- (1) centimeter measurement, (2) thirty centimeters tall

The room was only one **centimeter** wider than the piano, making it a tight fit.

## opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

## terrify

- to frighten someone very much synonym: unnerve, scare, horrify
- (1) **terrify** people, (2) the threats **terrify** him It would be best not to **terrify** your associates into doing complex tasks.

## exemplify

- to serve as a typical example of something synonym: illustrate, show, demonstrate
- (1) **exemplify** the importance, (2) **exemplify** the solution The example of a successful startup serves to exemplify the potential of the industry.

#### ovation

a sustained and enthusiastic show of appreciation, usually given in the form of applause, for something or someone that is admired or respected

synonym: applause, accolade, praise

(1) standing **ovation**, (2) spontaneous **ovation** The singer received an **ovation** from the crowd after her performance.

#### instruct

to teach someone practical skills or knowledge; to formally order or tell someone to do something

synonym: train, coach, guide

(1) **instruct** a student, (2) **instruct** a computer The facility manager **instructed** the security guards to be on high alert.

## loudspeaker

 an electronic device that amplifies sound, typically used to address a large audience or to play music or other audio content in public areas

synonym: speaker, loudhailer, megaphone

(1) wireless **loudspeaker**, (2) **loudspeaker** system

The teacher spoke through the **loudspeaker** so that every student could hear the announcement.

## fidget

 to make small, restless movements; to be unable to sit still

synonym: fiddle, jiggle, squirm

(1) **fidget** with hands, (2) **fidget** on my lap
He **fidgeted** with his pen while waiting for the interview to begin.

#### curvature

 the degree to which a line or surface deviates from being straight or flat; a measure of the amount of bending of a curve

synonym: bend, arch, bow

(1) the degree of **curvature**, (2) spinal **curvature**The **curvature** of the earth can be seen from space.
