#### opportune

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

#### rehabilitate

v. to restore to good health or physical condition; to help someone return to a normal life, especially after a period of illness, addiction, or imprisonment

synonym: reform, restore, renovate

The organization works to **rehabilitate** drug addicts and help
them rebuild their lives.

#### neuroscience

- the scientific study of the function, structure, and disorder of the brain and the nervous system
- (1) the branch of **neuroscience**, (2) a theoretical concept in **neuroscience**

Our university is famous for its professors, who are well-versed in behavioral **neuroscience**.

#### trove

 a valuable collection of rare or interesting things, usually on the earth

synonym: hoard, collection, assemblage

(1) **trove** of information, (2) stumble on a **trove**The treasure **trove** of ancient artifacts was a museum's dream come true.

#### determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

*synonym*: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

#### refurbish

v. to renovate or improve something old or worn out, typically by cleaning, repairing, or replacing parts to restore its original condition or appearance

*synonym*: renovate, revamp, remodel

(1) **refurbish** a room, (2) **refurbish** a classic car I plan to **refurbish** my old dresser with a fresh coat of paint and new drawer handles.

divert

to change the course or direction of something, often away from a specific path or target; to entertain or

amuse someone, often to distract them from a problem or concern; to appropriate something for a different purpose

synonym: distract, redirect, sidetrack

(1) divert attention, (2) divert an assault

Due to the road construction, we had to **divert** our course to get to the restaurant.

### recapture

- v. to take back control or possession of something synonym: retake, reoccupy, regain
- recapture prisoner, (2) recapture territory
   The company launched a campaign to recapture lost market

## recycle

v. to sort and collect things to process them and produce valuable materials that can be used again

*synonym*: reclaim, reuse, reprocess

share.

(1) **recycle** the cardboard boxes, (2) **recycle** milk packaging into new paper

We largely **recycle** the circuit board of cell phones because they contain a lot of valuable metals.

#### tractable

- adj. easily managed, controlled, or influenced; capable of being shaped, guided, or persuaded
- synonym: manageable, compliant, docile
- (1) tractable child, (2) tractable problem

His **tractable** attitude during the negotiations made the entire process more comfortable for everyone involved.

#### incentivize

v. to make someone want to do in a particular way by offering them a reward

synonym: encourage, motivate

(1) **incentivize** carpooling, (2) **incentivize** the right behavior Governments **incentivize** their citizens to buy eco-friendly products through subsidies.

## upskill

- v. to teach someone, especially workers, new or additional skills; to learn new or additional skills

## policymaker

*n.* a person in charge of or involved in developing action plans for a political party, business, etc.

synonym: lawmaker, legislator

#### excite

#### summon
