## transport

- a system for moving people or products from one location to another using automobiles, roads, and so on synonym: shipment, transit, conveyance

## straight

adj. extending or moving in one direction without bending or curving; having no deviations

*synonym*: linear, honest, consecutive

#### nowhere

adv. not in, at, or to any place; not anywhere

(1) nowhere else to go, (2) come out of nowhere

#### grunt

#### swear

v. to make a solemn promise or vow; to use rude or offensive language

synonym: declare, assert, curse

## transition

 the process or period of changing from one state or circumstance to another

synonym: change, growth, shift

(1) **transition** phase, (2) ensure a smooth **transition**The nation's healthcare system is in **transition** at the moment.

## entirely

adv. completely

synonym: completely, fully, totally

(1) **entirely** satisfied with the meal, (2) he was **entirely** to blame

Later, his claim was found to be **entirely** false.

#### seamless

adj. without spaces or breaks between one part and the next synonym: smooth, continuous, unseamed

(1) enable **seamless** access, (2) **seamless** device connectivity

The service was **seamless**, and the food was quite delicious.

## sequence

*n.* a series of related events, actions, numbers, etc., which have a particular order

synonym: arrangement, succession, series

#### genome

- n. the complete set or sequence of genes of a human, animal, plant, or other living things

## telescope

- a device like a tube in shape containing lenses used to magnify and observe distant objects

#### achieve

v. to successfully complete a task or goal, often through hard work, perseverance, and dedication; to attain or accomplish something that one has set out to do

synonym: accomplish, attain, reach

## windy

adj. characterized by or affected by strong winds; of or relating to the wind; describing a person who talks a lot, often in an exaggerated way or without saying much substance

The weather is too **windy** for us to go on a boat ride.

## altitude

 the height of an object or point in relation to sea level or ground level

synonym: height, elevation, tallness

#### continent

one of the earth's large landmasses; (adjective)
 abstaining from your feelings, especially your desire to have sex

synonym: landmass, (adjective) chaste, (adjective) pure

(1) the inland of a **continent**, (2) **continent** urinary diversion Flight across the **continent** was a daring adventure in its day.

## fascinating

adj. extremely interesting

synonym: alluring, intriguing, captivating

# phenomenon

 something that exists and can be perceptible, especially one that is not fully understood

synonym: marvel, wonder, splendor

(1) natural phenomenon,(2) historical phenomenonA rainbow is a natural phenomenon.

#### conversation

*n.* an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

(1) **conversation** in English, (2) a friendly **conversation** Your **conversation** reflects your thoughts.

#### awesome

adj. inspiring fear, admiration, or respect; very good, nice, fun, etc.

synonym: miraculous, marvelous, astounding

(1) **awesome** mental faculty, (2) have an **awesome** birthday. There is a lot of **awesome** nature and food in Hawaii.

# anniversary

 the annual recurrence of a date marking a notable event; a date on which an event occurred in a previous year

synonym: commemoration, celebration, observance

(1) **anniversary** celebration, (2) a bicentennial **anniversary** They celebrated their 10th **anniversary** with a romantic

dinner.

#### marathon

- n. a long-distance race of 42.195 kilometers
- synonym: endurance, race, event
- (1) run a marathon, (2) watch a marathon

She successfully completed her first **marathon** with a personal best time.

## pole

- n. one of two antipodal points where the Earth's axis of rotation intersects the Earth's surface; a long, slender, rounded rod, typically of wood or metal, used as a support or to hang something
- synonym: rod, staff, shaft
- (1) a fishing **pole**, (2) the plus **pole**

The North **Pole** is the northernmost point on Earth.

## process

- n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products
- synonym: procedure, method, system
- (1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process**The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

## bay

- a part of the coast that is partially enclosed by land; a compartment or section of a ship or building
- synonym: inlet, cove, gulf
- (1) bay area, (2) the mouth of a bay

She walked along the **bay** and collected shells.

#### summarize

- v. to give a brief statement of the most important facts or ideas about something
- *synonym*: recap, outline, digest
- (1) **summarizes** the main ideas, (2) **summarize** text Each chapter **summarizes** the most critical issues.

#### succinct

adj. concise, clear, and to the point; using as few words as possible to convey an idea or message; brief but comprehensive

synonym: concise, brief, pithy

(1) succinct reply, (2) succinct explanation

My manager gave me a **succinct** summary of the project's goals and objectives.

#### hallowed

adj. considered holy or sacred; deserving of reverence or respect

synonym: sanctified, sacred, revered

(1) hallowed tradition, (2) hallowed memory

The church was considered a **hallowed** ground for the community, where their ancestors had worshiped for generations.

## insider

- a person who has privileged access to special or secret information about a particular organization or field
- synonym: mole, privileged person
- (1) **insider** trading, (2) company **insider**

He's a Wall Street **insider** with a lot of valuable information.

## explorer

 a person who travels to places where no one or few people have been before to find out what is there

synonym: adventurer, trailblazer, scout

(1) team of **explorers**, (2) a polar **explorer** 

Aboriginal people killed the **explorer** who entered the sacred land for them.

## eloquent

- *adj.* able to speak or write clearly and impressively *synonym*: persuasive, fluent, well-spoken
- (1) an **eloquent** speaker, (2) **eloquent** writing

She gave an **eloquent** speech at the graduation ceremony.

#### odds

 the degree or probability that a particular thing will or will not happen

synonym: chances, likelihoods, probabilities

(1) **odds** in favor, (2) **odds** of business What are the **odds** that he will survive?

#### survival

 the state of continuing to exist or live, frequently in the face of difficulty or danger

synonym: endurance, continuity

(1) survival ability, (2) survival food

He evaluated his chances for **survival** rather pessimistically.

## captain

 the leader of a group of people, especially who is in charge of a ship or aircraft

synonym: boss, director, leader

(1) the **captain** of an opposing team, (2) **captain** of industry The **captain** ordered the troops to fire.

#### falcon

 a bird of prey characterized by its sharp talons and hooked beak; typically having a long tail and wingspan and known for its swift and agile flight

synonym: hawk, eagle, kestrel

(1) falcon feathers, (2) peregrine falcon

The **falcon's** keen eyesight makes it an excellent hunter.

#### rival

 a person, company, or thing competing with others for the same thing or in the same area

synonym: adversary, competitor, contender

(1) **rival** bidder, (2) merge with a **rival** company He interfered with his **rivals** in various ways during the campaign.

chart

 a visual display of information such as a diagram, lists of figures, etc.; a map designed to assist navigation by air or sea

synonym: diagram, graph, map

(1) a weather **chart**, (2) a statistical **chart** This pie **chart** represents our market share.

#### interior

 the inside or inner part of something; the space within the walls of a building

synonym: inner, inside, internal

(1) interior decoration, (2) plenty of interior space

The painter focused on the moody **interiors** of abandoned buildings in his work.

#### uncharted

adj. not mapped or surveyed; unknown or unexplored; without a clear or definite course of action

synonym: unknown, unexplored, undiscovered

(1) uncharted wilderness, (2) uncharted waters

The explorer ventured into **uncharted** territory, not knowing what to expect.

terra

 a Latin word meaning earth or land, often used in scientific or technical contexts to refer to the planet itself or the soil or ground of a particular area

synonym: earth, land, ground

(1) terra cotta, (2) terra firma

Scientists study the **terra** of other planets to learn more about their formations and compositions.

nova

 a star that suddenly becomes brighter, typically because of an explosion in its interior; a sudden increase or burst of activity or growth

synonym: supernova, exploding star, nova remnant

The astronomer spent months studying the **nova's** light spectrum to learn more about its properties.

giant

adj. enormous; much bigger or more important than similar items usually are

synonym: big, gigantic, huge

siege

n. the surrounding of a place and isolating it by an army to defeat those defending it

synonym: blockade, encirclement, barricade

pony

n. a small horse

synonym: cayuse

(1) **pony** engine, (2) a spotted **pony** 

At this ranch, children can experience riding a **pony**.

petrol

 a flammable liquid made from petroleum that is used as a fuel in internal combustion engines, commonly known as gasoline in North America

synonym: gasoline, fuel, gas

tractor

- a powerful vehicle with large back wheels and thick tires, used for pulling farm machines

preposition

 a word or group of words that shows the relationship of a noun or pronoun to another word in a sentence, indicating location, time, direction, or manner (e.g., in, on, at, above, before, after)

synonym: connective, particle, word

(1) English **preposition**, (2) complex **preposition**When learning a new language, understanding the use of **prepositions** can be quite challenging.

depot

 a place or a building where goods, materials, or equipment are stored, manufactured, or distributed; a transportation hub where buses or trains start or end their journeys

*synonym*: warehouse, storage, station

(1) weapon depot, (2) food depot

The train **depot** was a hub for commuters and travelers.

fuel

 a substance that is typically burned to generate heat or energy

synonym: energy, power, gas

(1) biomass fuel, (2) smokeless fuel

The **fuel** scarcity most severely impacted the manufacturing sector

sled

 a vehicle used for traveling over snow or ice, typically consisting of a flat-bottomed frame mounted on runners, sometimes pulled by dogs or horses

synonym: sleigh, toboggan, sledge

We used a **sled** to slide down the hill in the snow.

high-water

n. the highest level of water in a river or other body of water, especially as it exceeds the normal level

endeavor

v. to make an earnest attempt or effort; to strive or work hard towards a goal or objective

athlete

*n*. a person who competes in one or more sports that involve physical strength, speed, or endurance

## achievement

n. a thing that someone has accomplished, primarily through their effort and ability

*synonym*: accomplishment, attainment, triumph

## arguably

adv. used when expressing an opinion or idea that you believe can be proven true

synonym: probably, possibly

(1) she is **arguably** the best singer, (2) **arguably** the greatest discovery

He is **arguably** regarded as the finest actor of his generation.

#### harsh

adj. severe and unkind; extremely tough and unpleasant to inhabit

synonym: brutal, severe, backbreaking

(1) **harsh** climate, (2) use of **harsh** chemicals The prime minister faced **harsh** criticism.

#### climate

the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

synonym: atmosphere, weather, environment

(1) a cold **climate**, (2) effects of **climate** change **Climate** and weather have an impact on every part of our lifestyles.

#### unbroken

adj. continuous and not interrupted; (of promises or contracts) not violated or disregarded

synonym: intact, unchanged, continuing

(1) an unbroken horse, (2) unbroken chain

He enjoyed the **unbroken** quiet of the afternoon at the villa.

*adj.* capable of being known, seen or declared in advance *synonym*: foreseeable, expectable, likely

## curiosity

 the trait of being unyielding, obstinate, or inflexible; a refusal to change one's opinions or behavior despite pressure or persuasion

#### **hubris**

 excessive pride, arrogance, or overconfidence, often leading to someone's downfall or ruin

haul

v. to physically drag or pull someone or something with effort

## pound

# genuine

## valley

 a long depression on the surface of the land, which typically contains a river

synonym: canyon, gorge, dale

# territory

- n. an area under the control of a ruler or statesynonym: domain, region, realm
- (1) acquire **territory**, (2) **territory** in charge They incorporated the conquered **territory** into their nation.

#### brain

- the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling
- synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon
- (1) basic **brain** function, (2) permanent **brain** damage X-rays revealed a small tumor in his **brain**.

#### curse

- a rude or offensive word or an expression that is not polite and shows that you are very angry
- synonym: condemnation, cuss, hex
- (1) under a **curse**, (2) few **curse** words Many autocratic policies became a **curse** for that country's economy.

#### indoor

- adj. located, happened, or used inside a building
- an indoor pool, (2) designed for indoor use
   Table tennis is an indoor sport.

## sunset

- n. the time in the evening at which the sun begins to fall below the horizon; (verb) to expire or be terminated automatically at the end of a fixed period
- synonym: evening, sundown, dusk

## daylight

- n. the natural light produced by the sun during the day, especially in contrast to artificial light or darknesssynonym: sunlight, daytime, day

#### custom-made

#### satellite

 an electronic device that is sent up into space and moves around the Earth or another planet, used for gathering information or communicating by radio, television, etc.

synonym: orbiter, asteroid, moon

(1) a GPS **satellite**, (2) a meteorological **satellite** Launching an artificial **satellite** contributed to the technological development of our country.

#### transmitter

 a piece of equipment used for generating and sending electronic signals, especially radio or television signals

*synonym*: sender

(1) a **transmitter** of a family line, (2) radio **transmitter** This substance acts as a neural **transmitter** substance.

#### solar

adj. of, from, or relating to the sun

(1) the solar system, (2) a solar eclipse

**Solar** panels have greatly improved not only in performance but also in durability.

#### flexible

adj. able to change or be changed to suit new conditions or situations; able to bend easily

synonym: adaptable, elastic, pliable

(1) flexible schedules, (2) a flexible wire

You can be more **flexible** and creative in your approach.

# photovoltaics

 a branch of technology that involves the conversion of sunlight into electricity using solar cells or other photoelectric devices; the generation of electricity directly from sunlight, typically using solar panels

synonym: solar cells, solar power

The development of thin-film **photovoltaics** has allowed for a wider range of applications in building design.

#### panel

## inspire

#### adventure

- a journey or a series of events that is unusual, exciting, or dangerous
- synonym: experience, happening, incident

## importance

- n. the quality of being important and worthy of notesynonym: significance, primacy, matter
- (1) a man of **importance**, (2) high **importance** I stopped by the branch though I have no business of **importance**.

# storytelling

- n. the act or art of narrating or writing storiessynonym: narrating, relating, recounting
- (1) **storytelling** performance, (2) courtroom **storytelling** She was skilled in **storytelling** techniques, such as using different voices for other characters.

## gear

 a toothed wheel that engages another toothed mechanism to change the speed or direction of transmitted motion; a set of tools, equipment, or other items for a particular purpose

synonym: equipment, tools, apparatus

(1) sports **gear**, (2) a **gear** change lever

She checked her **gear** before embarking on the hike.

glide

to move smoothly and effortlessly

synonym: slide, skim, coast

(1) **glide** through the water, (2) **glide** down the mountain The eagle gracefully **glided** on the thermals, soaring above

the mountains.

friction

n. the force that opposes motion between two objects in contact, especially by producing heat and wear, and is proportional to the normal force between the objects

*synonym*: rub, scrape, resistance

(1) friction force, (2) surface friction

The **friction** between the two countries was causing tension.

chill

 a feeling of coldness that makes one shiver; (verb) to make cool or cooler

synonym: coldness, coolness, (verb) freeze

visible

adj. capable of being seen; or open to easy view

*synonym*: clear, observable, seeable

whiteout

 a meteorological phenomenon occurring in winter conditions, where snowfall and strong winds create a uniform, featureless white appearance that obscures visibility

synonym: snowstorm, blizzard
