## sequin

## conversation

Your **conversation** reflects your thoughts.

## proficiency

*n.* expertise or ability in a particular area or skill; skillfulness or adeptness in performing tasks or duties

*synonym*: expertise, skill, mastery

Her **proficiency** in Spanish allowed her to communicate easily with the locals during her vacation in Mexico.

## intelligence

*n.* the ability to learn, comprehend, or make judgments or conclusions based on reasons

*synonym*: brains, brightness, cleverness

In terms of **intelligence**, he was head and shoulders above his classmates.

## bot

*n.* a computer program or software application that is capable of performing automated tasks, often on the internet; a type of electronic device that provides autonomous service or assistance to users

## database

## uncomfortable

*adj.* providing or feeling physical discomfort or slight pain

*synonym* : comfortless, discomforting, painful

(1) an **uncomfortable** silence, (2) with an **uncomfortable** face

His abusive words made me **uncomfortable**.

## reaction

*n.* a response that reveals a person's feelings or attitude; (in chemistry) a process in which one or more substances are changed into others

*synonym* : response, reply, answer

(1) chemical **reaction**, (2) trigger a **reaction**

There was a chemical **reaction** of the lime with the groundwater.

## ribbon

*n.* a long, narrow strip or band of fabric, often used for decoration or tying things together; a symbol or badge representing a particular honor or award

## leap
