inflated

showy

adj. attracting attention due to being bright, flashy, or ostentatious; tending to be more concerned with appearance or showmanship than with substance or quality

synonym: flashy, flamboyant, ostentatious

She wore a **showy** dress to the awards ceremony to grab people's attention.

lavender

- a fragrant herb of the mint family, typically having purple or blue flowers, sometimes used for its soothing scent in aromatherapy or as a flavoring in cooking and baking

havoc

 widespread destruction or devastation, often caused by natural disasters, war, or other violent events

synonym: destruction, devastation, ruin

hyacinth

 (also "jacinth") a fragrant flowering plant with clustered flowers that grow on a tall, spiky stem, typically in shades of blue, purple, or pink

synonym: jacinth

The beautiful purple **hyacinth** flowers bloomed every spring in the garden.

botanical

adj. relating to the study or science of plants; of, pertaining to, made from, or derived from plants

synonym: botanic, plant-based, herbal

The **botanical** gardens were filled with exotic plants from all around the world.

annul

v. to make something legally or officially invalid

synonym: cancel, void, rescind

relocate

synonym: emigrate, resettle, migrate
