weird

psychology

- n. the scientific study of mind and behavior
- (1) **psychology** experiment, (2) **psychology** of crowd She had a master's degree in **psychology**.

normally

adv. usually; under normal conditionssynonym: commonly, generally, naturally

(1) complete **normally**, (2) not **normally** drink much I don't **normally** take a vacation in the middle of summer.

ribcage

n. the bony structure in the chest that protects the heart and lungs, composed of twelve pairs of curved bones called ribs that are joined to the spine in the back and the breastbone (sternum) in the front

synonym: chest, thorax, torso

(1) ribcage pain, (2) ribcage injury

After the accident, the doctors found multiple fractures in his **ribcage** and advised him complete rest.

terribly

adv. very badly; to a great extent or very much

synonym: awfully, abominably, badly

(1) suffer **terribly**, (2) I am **terribly** sorry His arm was swollen and **terribly** red.

exciting

adj. causing a lot of interest or excitement synonym: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

(1) exciting football player, (2) exciting news

The findings of the experiment were both **exciting** and unexpected.

intercostal

adj. located between or among the ribs; relating to the intercostal muscles, which aid in breathing by raising and lowering the ribcage

synonym: ribcage, thoracic

(1) intercostal nerve, (2) intercostal artery

The **intercostal** muscles are essential for breathing.

rib

 each of a series of curved bones that are connected to the spine and surround the chest; (adjective) subject to laughter or ridicule

synonym: costa

(1) brake a rib, (2) rib cage

The accident caused a cracked rib.

lung

- either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing
- (1) **lung** capacity, (2) do **lung** transplantation He has terminal **lung** cancer.

expand

v. to increase or to make something greater in size, number, or importance

synonym: extend, grow, boost

(1) **expand** a lineup, (2) **expand** agricultural output They hope to **expand** their business worldwide.

contract

 a legally binding agreement between two or more parties, setting out their rights and obligations to each other, typically in writing and enforceable by law

synonym: agreement, deal, arrangement

strap

n. a long, narrow strip or belt of leather, fabric, or another material used for binding, fastening, or supporting something or someone; a band or string that attaches one object to another, often used to secure items during transport

breath

the air that is taken into and expelled from your lungs;

belt

movement

gentle

adj. having or showing a kindly or tender nature; soft and mild

sinusoidal

adj. having a smooth, curved shape like a sine wave; characterized by regular, rhythmic oscillations or fluctuations

squeeze

mortal

zigzag

We had to go through a **zigzag** course.

contraction

n. the act or process of becoming smaller or shorter in size, volume, or amount

synonym:

shrinking, compression, reduction

(1) **contraction** of a disease, (2) **contraction** in the industry The **contraction** of the economy has led to job losses.

spasm

 a sudden, involuntary contraction of a muscle, causing a range of sensations from mild discomfort to severe pain; a sudden outburst or brief episode of intense emotion or activity

synonym: convulsion, cramp, twitch

The patient's face twitched in **spasms** as the dentist started drilling her tooth.

wheeze

 to breathe with difficulty, usually accompanied by a whistling or rattling sound; to make a high-pitched or whistling sound

brilliant

adj. extremely clever, skilled, or impressive synonym: luminous, intelligent, clever

observe

primate

 any mammal of the order Primates, which includes monkeys, apes, and humans synonym: ape, monkey, lemur

associate

v. to mentally connect someone or something with someone or something else

synonym: tie in, link, consociate

tickle

comedy

emotional

adj. relating to people's feelingssynonym: affecting, impactful, impressive

enormous

adj. extremely large or great

mod

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

context

origin

- n. the first existence or beginning of somethingsynonym: root, source, ancestor
- (1) origin of information, (2) racial originThere are various hypotheses concerning the origin of life.

neurobiology

n. a field of biology that studies the structure, function, and development of the nervous system, including the brain, spinal cord, and peripheral nerves encompassing a wide range of research topics, including the molecular and cellular processes involved in neural signaling, the organization of neural circuits, and the neural basis of behavior, cognition, and emotion

synonym: brain science, neural science, neurology

polite

adj. showing consideration, respect, or deference towards others; having good manners, civility, or courteous

behavior

synonym: courteous, civil, respectful

encounter

v. to face something, particularly something unpleasant or difficult, while attempting to do something else; to meet, especially unexpectedly

synonym: meet, run into, come across

horrible

adj. extremely unpleasant or bad; causing fear or disgust *synonym*: dreadful, terrible, awful

communicate

 to share or exchange information with others by speaking, writing, moving your body, or using other signals

synonym: convey, share, transmit

evolution

- n. a gradual process of transformation of living thingssynonym: elaboration, expansion, transition

develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

voluntary

adj. done of one's own free will; without being forced or coerced

pose

to present a risk, problem, or other issues that must be addressed

chimpanzee

a small, very intelligent ape found in west and central Africa with black or brown fur

acoustic

adj. relating to sound or the sense of hearing synonym: aural, hearing, acoustical

pitch

the property of sound that varies with variation in the frequency of vibration; the degree of a slope, especially of a roof; short presentation for selling or sharing something

synonym: angle, gradient, slope

Her voice gradually increased in **pitch**.

whistle

v. to make a high-pitched sound by forcing breath through a small opening, usually with the lips or fingers; (noun) a piece of equipment that forces air or steam against an edge or into a cavity and so produces a loud shrill sound

spot

- a particular location or place; a small round or roundish area, differing in color or feels from the surface around it

contrast

- v. to put in opposition to show or emphasize differences synonym: differ, vary, counterpoint

fake

adj. not genuine; fraudulent or counterfeitsynonym: affected, bogus, counterfeit

cue

 a signal, gesture, or action that provides information or direction for someone else to act or respond; a reminder or prompt for someone to do something

synonym: signal, sign, hint

(1) cue card, (2) visual cue

The director gave the actor a **cue** to begin the scene.

nasal

adj. relating to the nose or the sense of smell; characterized by or involving the nasal passage

synonym: adenoidal, pinched, rhinal

(1) nasal congestion, (2) nasal bone

The **nasal** spray helped alleviate my allergies.

genuine

adj. real and exactly; not pretended; sincerely felt or expressed

synonym: actual, honest, unpretending

(1) a **genuine** article, (2) show **genuine** regret Is this painting **genuine** or forged?

scan

 to examine something hastily, with the eyes or with a machine, to get information

synonym: look over, scrutinize, browse

(1) **scan** the face of the man, (2) **scan** a document into PDF She stood on the podium and **scanned** an audience.

brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon

(1) basic brain function, (2) permanent brain damageX-rays revealed a small tumor in his brain.

boring

adj. lacking interest or excitement; tedious or dull

synonym: dull, tedious, monotonous

(1) **boring** work, (2) **boring** day

The lecture was so **boring** that many people fell asleep.

experiment

 the scientific test conducted to observe what happens and gain new knowledge

synonym: experimentation, investigation

(1) **experiment** design, (2) series of **experiments** His **experiments** showed highly positive results.

distract

 to draw someone's attention away from what they are trying to do synonym: divert, preoccupy, confuse

(1) **distract** attention from the real issue, (2) **distract** public opinion

Please don't **distract** me while I'm studying.

nonetheless

adv. in spite of what has just been said or done; neverthelesssynonym: nevertheless, regardless, still

(1) we are **nonetheless** confident, (2) love him **nonetheless**

They each choose **nonetheless** to battle.

auditory

adj. of or relating to hearing or the ability to hear synonym: hearing, audible, aural

(1) a good **auditory** memory, (2) **auditory** system

The **auditory** nerve carries sound signals from the ear to the brain.

cortex

- n. the outermost layer of an organ, especially the brain
- (1) **cortex** cells, (2) visual **cortex** neuron The cerebral **cortex** consists of six layers.

ambiguous

adj. open to more than one interpretation; not clear or decided

synonym: unclear, uncertain, equivocal

(1) **ambiguous** situation, (2) clarify **ambiguous** points

process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

complicated.

novel

 an extended fictional work in prose; usually in the form of a story; (adjective) original and of a kind not seen before

synonym: fiction, story, (adjective) innovative

(1) historical **novel**, (2) **novel** effect

The **novel** has largely gotten positive feedback.

occupy

- v. to consume all of someone's space, attention, or time synonym: inhabit, settle, populate
- (1) **occupy** his time, (2) **occupy** a position The young prince will soon **occupy** the throne.

necessarily

adv. in an essential manner; in such a way as could not be otherwise

synonym: inevitable, certainly, automatically

not necessarily a problem, (2) necessarily true
 This accident was something that happened necessarily.

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

royal

adj. relating to or belonging to the king or queen or a member of their family

synonym: imperial, noble, aristocratic

(1) a royal palace, (2) prince royal

She is willing to give up her position in the **royal** family to marry him.

onset

the beginning or early stages of unpleasant something;
 a military attack

synonym: beginning, attack, commencement

(1) at the first **onset**, (2) the **onset** of spring

This medicine works best when taken at the **onset** of a cold.

peak

the point to which something or someone is at its strongest, best, or most successful; the pointed top of a mountain

synonym: summit, vertex, apex

- (1) at **peak** hour, (2) the **peak** current in the circuit This measurement aims to reduce traffic at **peak** periods.
- a structured collection of data that is compiled and processed in a computer system or program, typically for analysis, research, or machine learning purposes

synonym: data array, database

(1) dataset analysis, (2) publicly available dataset The scientist analyzed the large **dataset** to conclude the experiment.

puberty

the process of a person's physical changes through which their sexual organs develop and become capable of reproduction

synonym: adolescence, young adulthood

(1) at the height of **puberty** ., (2) the onset of **puberty** In this culture, men are initiated when they reach **puberty**.

grumpy

adj. easily annoyed or irritable; inclined to complain or show dissatisfaction, often in an ill-tempered way

synonym: crabby, grouchy, irritable

assume

to think or accept something to be true without having proof of it; to take or begin to have power; to begin to exhibit a specific quality or appearance

dataset

The following example **assumes** that the capacity of each battery is the same.

incorrect

- adj. not in accordance with fact or truth or not accurate synonym: unsound, wrong, inaccurate

emotion

- n. a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from one's situation, mood, or relationships with otherssynonym: feeling, sentiment, passion
- (1) control my **emotion**, (2) afraid to show **emotion**Some **emotions** are common across cultures and backgrounds.

phenomenally

- adv. extremely or exceptionally, especially in a way that is surprising

nuanced

lab

- a workplace for the conduct of scientific research; a laboratory

longitudinal

adj. relating to or measuring along the length of an object or course or longitude (= the angular distance between a point on any meridian and the prime meridian at Greenwich); running downwards rather than across

synonym: axial, lengthwise

(1) longitudinal axes, (2) longitudinal data

The researchers conducted a **longitudinal** study on the effects of the new medication.

polygraph

n. a machine that measures physiological responses such as heart rate, respiration, and skin conductance, used especially as a lie detector in criminal investigations or other circumstances where truthfulness is questioned

synonym: lie detector, truth detector

(1) **polygraph** interrogation, (2) **polygraph** machine Some people refuse to take a **polygraph** test because they believe it is unreliable.

irritate

v. to annoy, provoke, or cause resentment or anger in someone; to inflame or make sore

synonym: annoy, vex, bother

immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

physically

adv. in a way related to a person's body or appearance rather than their mind

(1) **physically** and mentally, (2) stay **physically** fit Having a **physically** healthy physique is essential for a great life.

unpleasant

adj. not enjoyable or comfortablesynonym: disagreeable, displeasing, distasteful

(1) **unpleasant** behavior, (2) with **unpleasant** body odor It is **unpleasant** to see criminal behavior even though it is minor.

satisfaction

 a pleasant feeling you have when you have fulfilled a desire, need, or expectation or have achieved something

synonym: delight, pleasure, content

- the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

synonym: association, linkage, connection

index

relation

n. a list of items, such as names, subjects, or keywords, that is arranged in a particular order and is usually found at the end of a book or document; a number or symbol that indicates the value or level of something, such as a stock index or a temperature index

emit

v. to give off or send out something such as light, heat, sound, gas, etc.

synonym: give off, radiate, expel

romantic

adj. of or relating to love or a sexual relationship

synonym: idealistic, unrealistic, amatory

(1) romantic movies, (2) romantic breakup

It was his first **romantic** love.

characteristic
