ajar

adj. partially open; slightly or partly open

synonym: open, askew

The door was left **ajar**, letting a cool breeze enter the stuffy room.

slam

v. to shut a door or window noisily; to strike something violently or noisily

synonym: bang, crash, shut

(1) slam the door, (2) slam the book against a wall

She **slammed** the door shut, angry at the person on the other side.

fingerprint

 a unique pattern of ridges and valleys on the surface of a finger that can be used to identify a person

synonym: print, mark, impression

(1) **fingerprint** at a crime scene, (2) **fingerprint** identification

The police used a **fingerprint** scanner to identify the suspect.

flounder

v. to struggle or stumble awkwardly; to move or act clumsily or in confusion; to be in a difficult or uncertain situation

synonym: struggle, stumble, falter

I watched him **flounder** through the difficult math problem, unable to find a solution.

beard
