## lock-in

 an event or situation in which people are unable to leave a specific location, such as a building or room until a particular condition is met or the time has passed

# patient

 a person who is receiving medical treatment, care, or attention from a healthcare professional, such as a doctor, nurse, or therapist; a personal quality or characteristic

# psychiatric

## excellence

n. the quality of being extremely good

synonym: distinction, goodness, superiority

## convince

v. to persuade someone or make someone believe that something is true

*synonym*: persuade, win over, convert

# psychotherapy

- the treatment of mental or emotional problems by talking with a therapist
- (1) field of **psychotherapy**, (2) **psychotherapy** for depression

He took **psychotherapy** to help him deal with his accident trauma.

## intervention

n. the action or process of being done to improve or help a circumstance, often they have not been asked to do so

synonym: interference, intercession, treatment

# spectacular

adj. striking or impressive to look at or in performance or achievement

synonym: breathtaking, impressive, grand

## vivid

adj. producing very clear, powerful, and detailed images in the mind

synonym: intense, powerful, dazzling

(1) **vivid** colors, (2) still **vivid** in my memory She made a **vivid** impression.

# symbol

something visible that is used to represent something else

synonym: mark, character, insignia

(1) **symbol** color, (2) **symbol** for happiness

The dragon is considered a **symbol** of bravery.

## artwork

 the pieces of art, such as pictures and photographs used in books, magazines, etc.

synonym: painting, picture, graphics

(1) ancient **artwork**, (2) **artwork** conservation Videos documenting the process of creating this pencil **artwork** have been popular worldwide.

## observe

v. to watch or notice something carefully, often to gather information or insights; to take note of something or someone; to celebrate or commemorate a special event or occasion

# **bypass**

## encode

v. to convert information into a code or format suitable for storage or transmission

synonym: transcribe, convert

## threaten

v. to utter intentions of injury or punishment against someone

*synonym*: endanger, terrorize, intimidate

# integrate

 to combine one thing with another so that they form a whole or work together; to accept equal participation for members of all races and ethnic groups

synonym: mix, merge, combine

He found that it is difficult to **integrate** socially.

# hemisphere

- n. half of the terrestrial globe; half of a sphere

# collage

 a work of art composed by assembling various materials, such as photographs, newspaper clippings, and other objects, onto a surface; any composition made by combining various distinct elements

# mask

# grip

 the act of holding onto something firmly with your hands, or the ability to do so; (verb) to hold fast or firmly

# amazing

 adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

# initially

adv. at the beginning; at first

# internal

adj. of or relating to the inside of something

synonym: interior, inner, domestic

# session

 a formal meeting or series of meetings for the execution of a particular group's functions; a period spent doing a particular activity

synonym: conference, gathering

## anxious

adj. worried and nervous

synonym: nervous, uneasy, afraid

## haunted

adj. inhabited, visited, or frequented by ghosts or spirits;
 disturbed or troubled by persistent or disturbing
 memories or emotions

synonym: spooky, eerie, ghostly

The old mansion was known to be **haunted**, with strange noises and eerie sightings reported by visitors.

## disturb

- v. to interrupt someone who is trying to work, sleep, etc. synonym: agitate, bother, intrude

# philosophy

- the study of general and fundamental questions, such as those about existence, reason, knowledge, values, mind

# destroy

 to ruin or damage severely or completely; to eradicate or eliminate completely

synonym: demolish, ruin, obliterate

# healing

 the process of becoming or making somebody or something well again

*synonym*: recovery, recuperation, convalescence

## zone

 a specific area, region, or section that is marked off or defined in some way

synonym: area, region, territory
