homeless

adj. without a home, and therefore typically living on the streets

instantaneous

adj. occurring or happening immediately or without delay; taking place in an instant or moment

- to move slowly, quietly, and carefully, usually to avoid being seen or heard

volume

 the amount of space occupied by an object or substance; the magnitude of sound

 beliefs and actions employed to influence supernatural beings and forces; any art or performance that invokes supernatural powers

synonym: fascination, illusion, wizardry

replacement

the act of replacing something with something else,
 especially that is newer or better; a person or thing that takes or can take the place of another

synonym: alternate, substitute, backup

specific

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise

synonym: particular, definite, distinct
