cannabis

 a flowering plant that contains psychoactive compounds, often used for recreational or medicinal purposes, particularly in the form of marijuana or hashish

synonym: marijuana, weed, pot

(1) cannabis plant, (2) cannabis legalization

The use of **cannabis** for medicinal purposes is legal in some states.

riot

 a violent disturbance of the peace by a crowd, characterized by destruction of property, looting, arson, and attacks on individuals

synonym: disturbance, unrest, upheaval

(1) riot police, (2) riot control gas

The **riots** in the city have left many buildings damaged and several people injured.

colossal

adj. extremely large and impressivesynonym: gigantic, huge, enormous

(1) colossal statue, (2) a colossal success

The new building is truly **colossal**, towering over the surrounding buildings.

controllable

adj. able to be controlled or directedsynonym: manageable, governable, submissive

(1) computer- **controllable**, (2) **controllable** aircraft The new software is much more **controllable** and user-friendly.

anarchy

n. a state of society without government or law synonym: chaos, disorder, lawlessness

stutter

synonym: stammer, falter, stumble

cofounder

ninja

 a Japanese warrior or assassin trained in martial arts and stealth tactics, associated with the feudal era of Japan

synonym: assassin, spy

The skilled **ninja** moved stealthily through the shadows to carry out their mission.

acronym

 a word formed from the first letter of each word in a phrase, such as NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration) or AIDS (Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome)

synonym: abbreviation, initialism, shortcut

RADAR is an acronym for radio detection and ranging.

hyperconnected

adj. having multiple, complex links or relationships between different people, objects, or systems

synonym: highly connected, fully connected

the internet and social media playing a significant role in communication and information exchange.

manifesto

erupt

 a public declaration or statement of policy and aims, usually issued by a political party or government; a written statement or proclamation of one's beliefs or intentions

synonym: declaration, proclamation, statement

reckon

synonym: conflicting, opposing, inconsistent

confused.

catharsis

 a release or purging of emotional or psychological tension, often through artistic or creative experiences or expressions

synonym: cleansing, purification, purging

Many people find that physical exercise provides a sense of **catharsis**, helping to relieve stress and anxiety.

anonymity

smartphone

mindset

 the established set of attitudes or fixed ideas held by someone

synonym: attitude, ethos, mentality

Countries whose goal is economic development often focus on fostering an entrepreneurial **mindset** in each individual.

accusation

 a statement or claim alleging that someone has committed a crime, offense, or wrongdoing; a charge or indictment made against someone

synonym: charge, indictment, imputation

The **accusation** of theft was unfounded, and the suspect was eventually cleared of all charges.

dedicate

He **dedicated** his life to helping others.

cyberspace

synonym: Internet, virtual reality, online world

pundit

 an expert, authority, or knowledgeable commentator who frequently expresses opinions or gives analysis on a particular subject or issue

synonym: expert, commentator, punditry

empower
