#### commerce

 the activity of buying and selling things, especially on a large scale

synonym: trade, transaction, dealings

#### ultimate

adj. furthest or highest in degree or order synonym: highest, maximum, foremost

### suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

#### matte

adj. having a surface without a shine, luster; non-glossy synonym: dull, flat, lusterless

#### observation

 the act or activity of carefully examining or monitoring something or someone

synonym: watching, notice, reflection

(1) class observation day, (2) observation instrument

#### deck

 a flat surface that is usually made of wood or other material and is attached to a building, vehicle, or other structure

synonym: platform, veranda, patio

### empire

- n. a group of countries ruled by one leader or government synonym: imperium, conglomerate, kingdom

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

*synonym*: intellect, mind, encephalon

### surgery

medical treatment of injuries or diseases involving an incision with instruments and often removing or replacing some parts of the body; the branch of medical science that treats disease or injury by operative procedures

synonym: operation, (medical) procedure

(1) cardiac **surgery**, (2) the professor of **surgery** He had undergone heart **surgery** years before.

#### lifetime

- n. the duration of someone's life or something's existence;synonym: lifespan, duration

### courageous

adj. able to face and deal with danger or fear without flinching

synonym: brave, valiant, fearless

- v. to return to a former condition, health, mind, or strength synonym: come back, convalesce, heal

### fortunate

### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

#### headline

a heading at the top of a newspaper or magazine story or page

synonym: title, caption

(1) headline article, (2) banner headline

The engagement of the two golf players became **headline** news.

### largely

adv. virtually entirely; to a large degree synonym: mainly, chiefly, broadly

(1) **largely** accepted, (2) **largely** mitigate the issue Nevada is **largely** a desert state.

#### unnoticed

adj. not seen or noticed

synonym: ignored, overlooked, unrecognized

### disgrace

 a loss of respect, honor, or dignity; a state of shame or public humiliation; an action or behavior that is seen as immoral or unacceptable; (verb) to bring shame, dishonor, or discredit upon someone or something

synonym: shame, dishonor, humiliation

 The government's failure to address the poverty issue was a

### epidemic

n. the widespread outbreak of a particular disease in a large number of people at the same time

synonym: outbreak, contagion, plague

(1) a worldwide epidemic, (2) health epidemic

The disease is now reaching **epidemic** proportions in our country.

#### norm

n. something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standardsynonym: criterion, mean, standard

### quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

*synonym*: aggressive, intense, turbulent

#### engage

v. to attract and keep someone's attention and interest; to participate in or obtain services of something

### overlap

### amendment

*n*. the act or the process of changing something, especially a document or proposed new law

#### criminal

n. a person who has committed a crimesynonym: offender, lawbreaker, delinquent

#### domestic

adj. relating to or inside a particular country, not foreign or international

synonym: endemic, private, household

### abuse

- n. the use of something in an incorrect or harmful manner synonym: misuse, misconduct, vilification
- (1) the problem of drug **abuse**, (2) victim of sexual **abuse** Our company has an audit team that monitors directors for **abuse** of authority.

### appreciate

- v. to value and acknowledge the worth of someone or something; to be grateful for something or someonesynonym: acknowledge, admire, enjoy
- (1) **appreciate** her feedback, (2) **appreciate** the value We would **appreciate** an early reply.

### background

- n. the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem synonym: ground, experience, backdrop
- (1) a **background** color, (2) a criminal **background**The company's hiring criteria emphasize personality, not a person's **background**.

### incredibly

adv. in a way that is very difficult to believe; exceedingly or extremely

synonym: enormously, exceptionally, extraordinarily

(1) **incredibly** cheerful character, (2) get **incredibly** insecure

Several cities are experiencing incredibly high

unemployment rates.

#### license

an official permission or authorization to do, use, or own something; a legal document that grants the holder the right to perform certain activities, such as driving a car, practicing a profession, or using a particular product or service

synonym: permit, authorization, certificate

#### firearm

 a weapon that is designed to be fired and uses an explosive charge to propel a projectile, such as a bullet or a shell

### overwhelming

adj. very great or intense; so powerful that you cannot fight or react against it

### expand

v. to increase or to make something greater in size, number, or importance

### percentage

the number, amount, or rate of something, which is usually the amount per hundred

### fake

adj. not genuine; fraudulent or counterfeitsynonym: affected, bogus, counterfeit

(1) fake police officer, (2) spread of fake news

The prime minister was not well prepared for the debate and **faked** it

### government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

#### broadcast

v. to send out a program or some information on radio or television

synonym: air, announce, advertise

(1) **broadcast** a concert, (2) **broadcast** a radio ad Most of the programs are **broadcast** in this area.

#### extent

- n. the point or degree or area to which something extendssynonym: amount, degree, intensity
- certain extent, (2) the extent of the damage
   was amazed at the extent of her generosity.

#### decent

- *adj.* satisfactory, acceptable, or good in a general sense *synonym*: respectable, honorable, good
- (1) yearn for the **decent** living, (2) a **decent** education He earned a **decent** salary at his job.

#### abide

v. to accept or tolerate something or to act in accordance with a rule, decision, recommendation, etc.; to remain in a particular state or condition

synonym: reside, dwell, live

(1) **abide** by a contract, (2) **abide** in the same place They must **abide** by the rules set by the governing body.

#### incorrect

- adj. not in accordance with fact or truth or not accurate synonym: unsound, wrong, inaccurate

### belly

n. the front part of the body below the chest, containing the stomach and bowels; the rounded or curved part of an object, such as a ship or aircraft

synonym: stomach, abdomen, gut

### eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

### corporate

adj. of or relating to a large companysynonym: business, commercial, organizational

### lobby

 a large area inside the entrance of a public building where people can meet and wait; a group of people who try to persuade a politician, the government, or an official group to influence legislation

*synonym*: entrance, hall, anteroom

(1) **lobby** for legislation, (2) a hotel **lobby**That **lobby** group actively advocated environmental protection to the government.

### pediatrics

 the branch of medicine that deals with the care and treatment of children

*synonym*: pedology, child health

(1) **pediatrics** department, (2) **pediatrics** clinic I am studying **pediatrics** in medical school because I love working with children.

### desperate

adj. feeling or showing a lack of hope and a willingness to do anything because of the problematic situation

*synonym*: anguish, frantic, hopeless

her desperate screams, (2) desperate attempt
 He was desperate when he lost all his money by gambling.

#### threat

 a strong indication or likelihood of harm, danger, or adverse consequences; an expression of intent to inflict harm or injury on someone or something, often made as a means of coercion or intimidation synonym: menace, danger, hazard

(1) economic threat, (2) environmental threat

The **threat** of severe weather prompted the city to issue an evacuation warning.

#### unintentional

*adj.* not done or made on purpose; accidental *synonym*: accidental, unforeseen, spontaneous

(1) avoid **unintentional** harm, (2) **unintentional** insult The mistake was **unintentional** and made in good faith.

### sandy

adj. covered with or containing sand; (especially of hair color) pale yellowish to yellowish brown

synonym: arenaceous, sandlike

(1) miles of **sandy** beaches, (2) **sandy** hair The rain rapidly soaked into the **sandy** soil.

### hook

 a curved device used for suspending, holding, or pulling something, especially one attached to a surface for hanging things on; a sharp curve or crook

synonym: buckle, pin, curve

(1) a hat **hook**, (2) the curved shape of a **hook** Please hang your towel on a **hook**.

#### heartbreak

- n. a feeling of great sadness or disappointmentsynonym: grief, sorrow, bitterness
- (1) ease her **heartbreak**, (2) go through **heartbreak**They had experienced the **heartbreak** of losing two children due to premature births.

### unimaginable

adj. beyond what can be imagined or conceived; impossible to comprehend or envision

synonym: unthinkable, inconceivable, incredulous

The complexity of scientific theories was **unimaginable** for most people.

#### consequence

*n.* the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

#### decision

 the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

synonym: choice, determination, judgment

(1) decision authority, (2) a selfish decision

She was struggling to make a **decision** between two job offers.

### misery

- n. a state of ill-being due to affliction or misfortunesynonym: affliction, despair, anguish
- (1) live in **misery**, (2) untold **misery**

Our company suffered misery from incurring a heavy loss.

### bold

adj. brave, daring, and confident; not frightened of danger or afraid to say what you feel or to take risks

synonym: brave, courageous, fearless

(1) a **bold** design, (2) big, **bold** piano sounds

The effort to alleviate climate change needs **bold** action.

### absolutely

*adv.* without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly *synonym*: completely, utterly, definitely

(1) **absolutely** against, (2) **absolutely** obsessed with the girl

I am **absolutely** opposed to his idea because of morality.

#### folk

 n. people in general, especially those of a particular group or type

synonym: community, family, person

(1) **folk** art, (2) the **folk** songs of a particular district Some seaweed was used as **folk** medicine in ancient times.

#### movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

- (1) a circular **movement**, (2) **movement** of troops

  The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.
- n. the top or extreme point of something slender or tapering, usually a mountain or hill; a piece of advice about something practical; a small amount of money given for services

#### claim

### proportion

 a part, share, or amount of something considered in comparative relation to a whole

synonym: ratio, balance, consonance

(1) direct **proportion**, (2) a building of vast **proportions**He is more concerned about the **proportion** of his body fat than usual because of an upcoming bodybuilding competition.

#### craven

adj. lacking courage; cowardly; characterized by a complete lack of bravery or boldness; excessively timid

synonym: cowardly, fearful, timid

(1) craven behavior, (2) craven apology

The **craven** employee refused to speak up in the meeting, even though he had valuable input.

### politician

 a person who is a member of a government or law-making organization, especially as an elected member of parliament, etc.

synonym: congressperson, lawmaker, legislator

(1) a **politician** in the ruling party, (2) a corrupt **politician**The **politician** lost his position in the end due to the scandal.

elect

v. to choose someone for a specific position by voting for them; to decide or choose to do something

*synonym*: select, choose, prefer

### represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

### exciting

*adj.* causing a lot of interest or excitement *synonym*: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

(1) **exciting** football player, (2) **exciting** news The findings of the experiment were both **exciting** and unexpected.

### suspect

- v. to consider anything to be actual or probable synonym: assume, distrust, surmise
- (1) **suspect** a plot, (2) **suspect** that he is sick The cops **suspected** him of being the killer.

### proof

 a fact or piece of information that shows something is true or exists

synonym: testimony, evidence, assurance

(1) documentary **proof**, (2) a geometric **proof Proof** is better than argument.

### conversation

 an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

(1) **conversation** in English, (2) a friendly **conversation** Your **conversation** reflects your thoughts.

### advocacy

 the act of supporting or promoting a particular cause or point of view, often through public campaigning or lobbying

*synonym*: support, promotion, defense

(1) advocacy group, (2) consumer advocacy group

The group engages in **advocacy** through lobbying and campaigning for policy changes.

### celebrity

someone who is well-known, particularly in the entertainment industry

synonym: figure, star, VIP

### platform

n. the raised flat space close to the track at a train station where passengers get on or off the train; (technology) a computational or digital environment in which a piece of software is executed

synonym: stage, podium, forum

synonym: player, contestant, jock

(1) an arrival **platform**, (2) a digital **platform** for enterprise The speaker mounted the **platform** and started to speak.

#### athlete

- a person who competes in one or more sports that involve physical strength, speed, or endurance

#### conservative

adj. holding traditional views and values and opposed to change or innovation

synonym: traditional, reactionary, cautious

### pundit

 an expert, authority, or knowledgeable commentator who frequently expresses opinions or gives analysis on a particular subject or issue

#### unsolicited

adj. given or sent without being requested or asked for; not invited or desired

synonym: uninvited, unrequested, unsought

(1) unsolicited email, (2) unsolicited proposal

The company received **unsolicited** feedback from a customer about their product.

### appeal

 a serious, earnest, or urgent request for money, information, or help; a quality that makes somebody or something attractive or interest

synonym: request, charm, attraction

(1) draw out your **appeal**, (2) an **appeal** for help He needed to resolve the problem as soon as possible, so he made an **appeal** directly.

### classic

adj. judged or deserving to be regarded as one of the best or most important of its kind over a period of time; of a well-known type

synonym: definitive, traditional, typical

- (1) a **classic** experiment, (2) Chinese **classic** literature He displayed the **classic** symptoms of depression.
- a long, thin piece of metal or wood that is used to make fences or as a support for something; (verb) to complain bitterly

synonym: bar, beam, (verb) criticize

democracy

n. a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so
