synonym: undervalued, under-compensated, under-rewarded

circulate

v. to move continuously or freely around a place or closed system

synonym: flow, disperse, rotate

(1) **circulate** a rumor, (2) **circulate** an agenda before the meeting

The fan **circulates** the air in the room quickly.

entitle

v. to give someone the right to have or do something; to give a title to someone or something

synonym: allow, permit, enable

(1) **entitle** him to a pension, (2) **entitle** the company to use the logo

The employee was **entitled** to a week of vacation time.

forbidding

adj. giving the impression that something is difficult or unpleasant; intimidating or uninviting

synonym: intimidating, uninviting, daunting

(1) **forbidding** atmosphere, (2) **forbidding** mountain The teacher's stern expression and strict rules made her classroom feel **forbidding** to the students.

discourage

v. to make someone lose confidence, enthusiasm, or less willing to do something

synonym: dishearten, depress, demoralize

revolt

n. to take violent action against authority, especially government or ruler

asymmetrical

 adj. lacking symmetry or balance; unevenly or irregularly shaped; not corresponding in terms of quantity, size, or position

synonym: uneven, lopsided, crooked

awry

adv. in a wrong or crooked position; out of order; amiss synonym: amiss, askew, incorrect

The plans for the surprise party went **awry** when the cake was ruined.

overpay

synonym: overcompensate, overspend, lavish
