# birthplace

# syringe

# patent

### royal

adj. relating to or belonging to the king or queen or a member of their family

synonym: imperial, noble, aristocratic

# physician

- n. a medical doctor who practices medicine
- synonym: doctor, practitioner, medic
- (1) the advice of the **physician**, (2) consult with a **physician** She visited the local **physician** to seek treatment for her persistent headache.

#### identical

adj. being the exact same one

synonym: duplicate, exact, analogous

(1) pair of **identical** twins, (2) an **identical** equation Infant formulas are nutritionally almost **identical** to a mother's breast milk.

#### vaccine

 a substance that is put into the body and protects them from disease by causing them to produce antibodies (= proteins that attack harmful bacteria, viruses, etc.)

synonym: vaccinum

(1) development of **vaccines**, (2) an oral **vaccine**The mRNA **vaccine** was approved in less than a year because it did not contain the fragments of the target virus.

#### creditor

- n. a person, company, etc. to whom a debtor owes money(1) the creditor's claims, (2) bankrupt creditor

#### sanitation

span

n. the process of maintaining a clean and hygienic environment, particularly in public health and safety contexts; the practice of disposing of waste products in a safe and appropriate manner

# shortcoming

a lack or deficiency in a particular respect; a fault or defect

*synonym*: deficiency, fault, weakness

The company's main **shortcoming** was a lack of innovation.

#### narrative

 a story or a description of a series of events or process of telling a story

*synonym*: the tale, chronology, annals

(1) **narrative** poetry, (2) personal **narrative**The **narrative** handles multiple plot lines and has unpredictable ends.

#### obvious

*adj.* easy to see, discover or understand *synonym*: apparent, conspicuous, evident

(1) **obvious** reasons, (2) his conclusion was **obvious** There are **obvious** differences between the two wine-producing regions.

# phobia

- n. an extreme or irrational fear of a particular object, person, situation, or activity; a type of anxiety disordersynonym: fear, dread, terror
- (1) phobia treatment, (2) social phobiaShe has a phobia of spiders and always avoids them.

#### dislike

- v. to not like someone or somethingsynonym: disapprove, disfavor, deprecate

### vaccinate

- v. to treat with a vaccine, usually by injection, to produce immunity against a diseasesynonym: immunize, inject, inoculate

# problematic

*adj.* full of difficulties; difficult to deal with or solve *synonym*: inappropriate, inconvenient, worrisome

### rollout

 the introduction or implementation of a new product, service, or system, particularly one that has been planned and developed over a period of time

synonym: launch, release, deployment

#### relate

to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

synonym: connect, link, associate

He tried to **relate** his experience to the group, but they couldn't understand.

# injury

 harm done to a person's or an animal's body caused by an accident or an attack

synonym: wound, damage, hurt

(1) without **injury**, (2) a fatal **injury** 

My accidental **injury** got better right away.

#### contamination

n. the presence of something harmful or unwanted in a substance, material, or environment; the act of introducing harmful substances or materials into an environment or area

synonym: pollution, defilement, infection

(1) contamination levels, (2) soil contaminationThe contamination of the water supply led to widespread

illness in the community.

#### immune

 adj. protected against a particular disease or toxin due to the presence of specific antibodies or sensitized white blood cells

synonym: resistant, unsusceptible, unaffected

(1) **immune** from criminal prosecution, (2) the cell of the **immune** system

The vaccination does not necessarily make you completely **immune**.

# responsible

adj. answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management

synonym: accountable, answerable, liable

(1) **responsible** action, (2) **responsible** for a customer service

She's a **responsible** pet owner who ensures her dog gets enough exercise and a healthy diet.

#### chain

- a series of connected links or objects; a system or group of interconnected elements; a restraint or shackle
   synonym: series, string, link
- chain reaction, (2) supply chain
   The chain on my bike broke, leaving me stranded.

### tackle

- v. to try to deal with a complex problem or situation synonym: deal with, dive into, work on
- (1) **tackle** the issue, (2) help **tackle** climate change The government is determined to **tackle** sharp inflation.

# specimen

- n. an individual example or sample of something, typically used to represent a larger group or category
- synonym: example, sample, model

(1) **specimen** collection, (2) botanical **specimen**The biology teacher showed the students a frog **specimen** so they could examine its anatomy.

# microscope

- n. an instrument used to see objects or substances that are too small to be seen with the naked eyesynonym: lens, magnifier, eyepiece
- microscope slide, (2) electron microscope
   used an optical microscope to observe the small organisms in the water sample.

#### invisible

- adj. impossible or nearly impossible to see synonym: hidden, imperceptible, unseen
- (1) an **invisible** asset, (2) **invisible** stars

The phenomenon is **invisible** at optical wavelengths.

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) function properly, (2) immune function

The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

# technique

 a particular way or art of doing something that needs skill

*synonym*: approach, procedure, strategy

(1) a **technique** in martial arts, (2) the **technique** applied to construction

Jockey's superior technique brought him victory.

#### react

- to take action in response to something
- synonym: respond, reply, oppose
- (1) **react** at a high temperature, (2) **react** against his way of thinking

How did he **react** to your idea?

ion

- an atom or molecule that has a positive or negative electrical charge caused by its losing or gained one or more electrons
- (1) **ion** channel, (2) rechargeable lithium- **ion** battery

  The increased concentrat **ion** of hydrogen ions in an aqueous solution makes it more acidic.

etch

v. to carve, cut, or engrave (a design or text) into a hard surface; to corrode, erode or eat away at a metal surface using acid or another chemical substance to create a design or pattern

synonym:

engrave, inscribe, carve

(1) **etch** a metal plate, (2) **etch** a design into wood He used a sharp tool to **etch** his initials onto the metal.

### semiconductor

 a material or substance that can conduct electricity under certain conditions but not others, often used in electronic devices

synonym: chip, wafer

(1) **semiconductor** industry, (2) **semiconductor** device The company develops and sells **semiconductor** memory for use in computers and servers.

#### industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort synonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) **industrious** worker, (2) **industrious** student He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

roll

v. to move in a particular direction by turning over and over or from side to side

synonym: spin, swirl, wheel

(1) **roll** a ball, (2) **roll** down his cheeks
He was exhausted and **rolled** into bed as soon as he got home.

#### devise

v. to come up with an idea, plan, theory, etc., using your intelligence or imagination

synonym: create, concoct, invent

(1) **devise** a plan, (2) **devise** a literary plot

They had to **devise** a system that did not depend on fossil fuels.

#### device

 a piece of equipment, tool, or technology that serves a particular purpose or function, often mechanical or electronic

synonym: gadget, instrument, tool

(1) electronic **device**, (2) tracking **device**I always carry a backup **device** in case my phone runs out of battery.

# sophisticated

- adj. having a great deal of worldly experience and knowledge of people's behavior, culture, and fashionsynonym: refined, cultured, worldly
- (1) **sophisticated** look, (2) a **sophisticated** lifestyle Marketing strategies are growing more **sophisticated**.

### operate

- v. to work in a particular way; to supervise something synonym: work, use, employ
- (1) **operate** 24 hours a day, (2) manually **operate** a machine

This machine is too difficult to operate for me.

# immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately** 

A suspension order from the court is effective immediately.

#### breach

 a break or opening, often in a wall or barrier, which enables passage or entry; a violation or infraction of a law, agreement, or duty, often resulting in legal action or punishment

synonym: violation, infraction, trespass

(1) security breach, (2) breach of privacy

The company's data **breach** compromised thousands of customers' personal information.

#### release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge
- (1) **release** a prisoner, (2) **release** CO2 into the air The animal rights group worked to **release** the dolphins back into the wild.

#### discard

v. to throw something away or get rid of something that you no longer wanted or need

synonym: throw away, reject, abandon

(1) **discard** old beliefs, (2) **discard** the downloaded data He **discarded** the old torn shirt and bought a new one.

#### reuse

v. to use something again or more than once

synonym: reprocess, recycle, rehash

(1) **reuse** the materials, (2) **reuse** existing knowledge The supermarket encourages shoppers to **reuse** plastic bags.

# advantage

 a condition or circumstance that puts one in a favorable or superior position; a beneficial feature or asset that someone or something has

synonym: benefit, edge, asset

(1) score an **advantage**, (2) take **advantage** of his weak points

One of the main **advantages** of the new product is its increased efficiency.

# improvisation

- n. the act of making something up on the spot or creating or performing something without preparationsynonym: spontaneity, ad-lib, extemporization
- (1) **improvisation** on stage, (2) jazz **improvisation** He created a beautiful piece of music using only **improvisation**.

# delivery

n. the act of taking or sending something to a destination; the bringing of a baby during childbirth

synonym: sending, transporting, bringing

(1) an easy **delivery**, (2) special **delivery**The **delivery** truck arrived with the packages.

rid

v. to make someone or something free of unwanted or unpleasant tasks, objects, or person

synonym: do away with, free, clear

(1) get **rid** of the rats, (2) **rid** the body of waste products We must **rid** ourselves of pollution.

# immunogenicity

n. the ability of a substance, typically a vaccine or antigen, to induce an immune response in the body, which refers to the capacity of the substance to elicit the production of immune cells and antibodies, leading to an immune reaction and the development of immune memory

synonym: immunogen, antigenicity

(1) immunogenicity assay, (2) therapeutic immunogenicity

The scientists conducted extensive research to determine the **immunogenicity** of the new vaccine.

#### introduction

n. a preliminary explanation or remarks given before the start of a text, performance, or event; the act of bringing something new into existence or introducing something to a wider audience or new market

synonym: initiation, preamble, prologue

(1) **introduction** education, (2) self- **introduction**The **introduction** to the new class was informative and engaging.

antigen

- a substance that triggers the body's immune response (= the reaction for fighting infections) for defending the body, especially by producing antibodies (= proteins that identify and attack harmful bacteria, viruses, etc.)
- (1) detect antigen, (2) viral antigen

**Antigen** testing is less accurate than PCR testing but easier to perform.

germ

 a very tiny living that causes the disease; a piece of something such as an organism, concept, etc., capable of growing into a new one or part of one

synonym: bacterium, microbe, pathogen

(1) antibiotic-resistant **germ**, (2) a **germ-free** environment The **germ** of his idea came from watching birds flying in

#### flocks.

#### mount

v. to increase, go up, or advance gradually or continuously; to prepare and supply with the necessary equipment for execution or performance; to ride on something or someone

synonym: climb, increase, get on

(1) **mount** a hill, (2) **mount** a counterattack

They **mounted** pictures on the paper in preparation for the birthday card.

### intruder

 someone who enters a place or situation without permission or invitation; someone who interrupts or interferes in something

synonym: trespasser, intruder, interloper

(1) illegal **intruder**, (2) infrared **intruder** system

The homeowner called the police when they spotted an **intruder** in their backyard.

#### neutral

adj. not helping or assisting either side in a conflict, argument, etc.

synonym: impartial, uninvolved, halfhearted

permanently neutral country, (2) neutral colors
 A legislative speaker should always be neutral.

#### infection

 a condition in which pathogenic microorganisms or viruses have entered the body

synonym: contagion, disease, transmission

(1) a bacterial **infection**, (2) treat the **infection** with antibiotics

Hospitals must meet various standards to prevent nosocomial **infections**.

### argue

 to express differing opinions or points of view, often in a heated or contentious manner; to present a case or reasoning to persuade or convince others

synonym: debate, dispute, quarrel

(1) argue a case, (2) argue passionately

The couple began to **argue** over which restaurant to go to for dinner.

spot

- n. a particular location or place; a small round or roundish area, differing in color or feels from the surface around itsynonym: dot, mark, place
- (1) beauty **spot**, (2) a **spot** on his honor

This remote **spot** is rarely visited.

grid

 a pattern of regularly spaced horizontal and vertical lines; a system of high tension cables by which electrical power is distributed throughout a region

synonym: gridiron, battery grid, power system

(1) a grid design, (2) a wire grid

Grid pattern roads often appear in urban areas.

entirely

adv. completely

synonym: completely, fully, totally

(1) **entirely** satisfied with the meal, (2) he was **entirely** to blame

Later, his claim was found to be **entirely** false.

magenta

- a bright, purplish-red color named after a plant that was once used to produce a dye with a similar hue
   synonym: purple-red, fuchsia
- (1) magenta flowers, (2) magenta ink

The artist used **magenta** paint to make her painting pop with color.

jam

 a situation in which something becomes stuck because of a dense crowd of people, vehicles, etc.; a preserve of crushed fruit

synonym: difficulty, mess, preserve

(1) a traffic jam, (2) a jar of jam

The shredder in the print room often has paper **jams**.

#### stain

v. to discolor, defile, or tarnish something; (noun) a discoloration or dirty mark on a surface that is difficult to remove

synonym: discolor, tarnish, defile

(1) stain the carpet, (2) red wine stain

The allegations of corruption **stained** her reputation, and she struggled to regain public trust.

#### achieve

 to successfully complete a task or goal, often through hard work, perseverance, and dedication; to attain or accomplish something that one has set out to do

*synonym*: accomplish, attain, reach

(1) achieve success, (2) achieve milestones

I will work hard to achieve my goals and realize my dreams.

# penetration

n. the act or process of penetrating or entering something, often forcefully or with difficulty; the depth or extent to which something has been entered or understood

synonym: infiltration, entry, invasion

(1) penetration testing, (2) market penetration

The spy's mission was to gather intelligence on enemy territories through covert **penetration**.

#### reside

v. to live in a particular place, typically for a prolonged period of time

synonym: live, dwell, inhabit

(1) reside on the skin, (2) reside permanently

They **reside** in a beautiful old house in the countryside.

### invention

 the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation; the act of inventing

*synonym*: creation, design, innovation

(1) the **invention** of new techniques, (2) common **invention** Necessity is the mother of **invention**.

# exciting

adj. causing a lot of interest or excitement synonym: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

### systematic

adj. done or acting according to a determined set of systems or plans:

synonym: periodic, frequent, organized

# gamble

v. to take risky action in the hope of being successful; to play or game for money or other stakes

synonym: bet, venture, wager

#### obtain

- v. to get something, especially by making a great effort synonym: accept, acquire, receive
- (1) **obtain** a license, (2) **obtain** a bid Where can I **obtain** the application form?

#### influenza

 n. (formal for flu) a highly contagious viral disease that causes fever, severe aching, and catarrh and often occurs in epidemics

synonym: grippe, flu

(1) an epidemic outbreak of **influenza**, (2) **influenza** B strain

The research institute allocated a lot of money to study the cause and prevention of **influenza**.

slide

v. to move or cause to move smoothly along a surface without interruption

synonym: glide, drift, drop

horizontal

adj. parallel to the ground or in a baseline; being at the same level as all members of a group

synonym: even, lying, parallel

axis

 a real or imaginary straight line through a body or figure around which the object turns; a group of countries in special alliance

synonym: central, core, pole

(1) vertical axis, (2) a coordinate axis

The earth's **axis** of rotation is tilted 66.5 degrees to the ecliptic plane.

vertical

*adj.* upright or perpendicular to a horizontal surface or line *synonym*: perpendicular, upright, plumb

(1) vertical takeoff, (2) vertical axis

The ladder leaned against the **vertical** surface of the building.

indicate

to show, point out, or make known something, often through a sign or a symbol; to suggest or imply something without stating it directly

synonym: hint, suggest, show

(1) **indicate** a preference, (2) **indicate** an error

The data **indicates** that the company's profits have steadily increased over the past quarter.

threshold

n. the floor or ground that forms the bottom of a doorway and offers support when passing through a doorway; the smallest detectable sensation

synonym: anteroom, brink, verge

(1) the **threshold** between rooms, (2) high pain **threshold** She's on the **threshold** of adulthood.

curve

 a bend or angle in a line or surface that deviates from a straight or flat path; a gradual or smooth change in direction or shape

synonym: bend, arc, turn

(1) learning curve, (2) yield curve

The **curve** in the road was so sharp that I had to slow down to navigate it safely.

distinctly

adv. in a way that is clearly or noticeably different or separates from something else; in a way that is unmistakably or unequivocally defined or identifiable

synonym: clearly, obviously, unmistakably

(1) distinctly remember, (2) distinctly different

The **distinctly** floral scent of the perfume lingered in the air long after the wearer had left the room.

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

(1) **suddenly** attacked by an enemy, (2) die **suddenly** Who answers **suddenly** knows little.

brand

 a type of product, service, etc., made by a particular company and sold under a specific name; identification mark on the skin of livestock, criminals, etc., made by burning

synonym: trademark, label, symbol

(1) create a brand logo, (2) the brand of the new car

There's a new **brand** of hero in the movies now.

#### lever

 a handle used to operate a vehicle or a machine; a rigid bar resting on a pivot so that one end of it can be pushed or pulled easily

synonym: lifter, crowbar, bar

(1) a gear change **lever**, (2) **lever** for reform

This initiative will be a lever for increasing company sales.

# develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) develop a strategy, (2) develop a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

### malaria

- a severe disease caused by a parasite that is spread by the bite of an infected mosquito
- (1) **malaria** mosquitoes, (2) **malaria-endemic** area Many people in tropical countries die from **malaria** every year.

#### tuberculosis

- an infectious disease usually caused by tubercle bacteria that can attack many parts of a person's body, especially their lungs
- (1) died of **tuberculosis**, (2) a medicine for **tuberculosis Tuberculosis** used to be considered a fatal disease.

### adequate

adj. enough, acceptable, satisfactory for a particular purpose or need

synonym: enough, acceptable, able

(1) **adequate** parking facilities, (2) provide **adequate** funding

This argument is still not adequate.

#### candidate

- n. a person who is seeking or being considered for some kind of position, title, honor, or award; a job applicant synonym: applicant, nominee, contender

# lab

 a workplace for the conduct of scientific research; a laboratory

synonym: workshop, laboratory, research chamber

### attain

- v. to achieve or reach a goal or level of success synonym: accomplish, achieve, reach
- (1) **attain** success, (2) **attain** a complete victory

  She is determined to **attain** her degree in computer science.

#### maintain

 to continue to uphold or sustain; to keep in a particular state or condition; to assert or declare something to be true

synonym: preserve, uphold, sustain

(1) **maintain** order, (2) **maintain** good health I need to **maintain** my car regularly to prevent any major mechanical issues.

# requirement

- n. something that is needed or wantedsynonym: prerequisite, provision, condition
- (1) meet **requirement**, (2) school **requirement** What is the entry **requirement** for this course?

# refrigerate

 to cool or preserve food or other items by using a refrigerator or other cold storage device; to keep something at a low temperature to prevent spoilage or degradation

synonym: chill, cool, freeze

(1) **refrigerate** perishable, (2) **refrigerate** medicine We need to **refrigerate** the leftovers to keep them from spoiling.

# slightly

adv. in a small degree or extent; a little synonym: barely, narrowly, scarcely

(1) increase **slightly**, (2) **slightly** alkaline soils He moved his body **slightly** to the left.

#### extreme

adj. very great in amount or degreesynonym: farthermost, outermost, fierce

extreme sports, (2) extreme weather events
 Solar gravity creates extreme pressures and temperatures.

#### illustrate

v. to provide pictures, photographs, diagrams, etc. in a book or something for explanation

synonym: demonstrate, explain, exemplify

(1) **illustrate** a key point, (2) **illustrate** a story

#### stake

 a share or financial investment in something such as a business; a wooden or metal post set up to mark something

*synonym*: share, interest, post

### estimate

 to guess or calculate the cost, size, value, etc. of something

synonym: calculate, gauge, evaluate

prop
