epithelial

- adj. relating to the layer of cells that covers the majority of the body's surfaces

The majority of cells in the lung are **epithelial** cells.

neuron

bud

mucus

amygdala

- one of two parts of the almond-shaped neural structure that are linked to emotions, especially fear and pleasure, memory, and the sense of smell

thalamus

n. a midline, interbrain structure that forms a major part of the brain's sensory and motor pathways, receiving signals from various body parts and sending them to appropriate parts of the cerebral cortex for processing

synonym: sensory gateway, brainstem

neocortex
