synonym: conservationist, naturalist

#### underlie

#### meme

n. a cultural idea, value, or pattern of behavior that is passed from one generation to another by imitation

rather than genetic means; (as an Internet meme) an image, a video, a piece of text, etc. that is remixed, copied, and circulated in a shared cultural experience online

synonym: buzzword, trend

(1) pronounce **meme**, (2) religious **meme** 

This cute dog's photo spread around the world as an Internet meme.

# footprint

- n. a mark of a foot, shoe, or animal's foot left on a surfacesynonym: footmark, imprint, impression
- (1) **footprints** in the snow, (2) the **footprints** of an earlier civilization

We choose transportation that has a smaller carbon footprint.

# explode

v. to burst or break open violently and noisily; to cause something to burst or break open

synonym: detonate, blast, rupture

(1) **explode** in anger, (2) **explode** in popularity The old building **exploded** in a fiery inferno.

#### radiate

v. to spread out or emit something, such as light or heat, in all directions

synonym: give off, scatter, beam

(1) **radiate** an aura, (2) **radiate** in all directions Roads **radiate** from the famous building in the center of the city.

#### reminiscent

adj. making you remember someone or something; relating to the recall of personal interests

synonym: evocative, remindful, redolent

(1) **reminiscent** of ancient times, (2) **reminiscent** smile His painting style is **reminiscent** of Monet's

# smashing

adj. very successful or impressive; causing something to be broken or destroyed

synonym:

great, wonderful, breaking

(1) a **smashing** blow, (2) give **smashing** results
The band's new album was a **smashing** success, reaching the top of the charts.

nod

 to lower and raise one's head, sometimes several times, as to show approval, agreement, greeting, or confirmation

synonym: respond, acknowledge, greet

nod at each other, (2) nod courteously
 She nodded quietly in response to the question.

#### interconnect

- v. to connect similar things
- *synonym*: interlink, complect, annex
- directly interconnect with those systems, (2) human activities interconnect with the environment
   Our system can now interconnect with other databases.

# storytelling

- n. the act or art of narrating or writing storiessynonym: narrating, relating, recounting
- (1) **storytelling** performance, (2) courtroom **storytelling** She was skilled in **storytelling** techniques, such as using different voices for other characters.

#### fractal

 a complex geometric pattern or shape that repeats itself on smaller and smaller scales, often occurring in nature or mathematical equations

synonym: pattern, design, geometry

(1) fractal pattern, (2) fractal art

The coastline of Norway is one of the most famous examples of **fractal** geometry in nature.

#### resonate

- v. to be filled with a deep echoing sound synonym: echo, reverberate, resound
- (1) deeply **resonate** with the consumers, (2) **resonate** in the same frequency

The sound **resonates** well in this theater.

### optimism

n. a feeling or the belief that good things will happen, or the quality of being full of hope and emphasizing the positive aspects of a situation

synonym: positiveness, sanguinity, bullishness

(1) sense of **optimism**, (2) political **optimism**There is considerable **optimism** that the economy will recover soon.

# bury

- v. to place a dead body in the ground, grave, or tomb synonym: entomb, sink, forget
- (1) **bury** in the earth, (2) **bury** emotion There is plenty of space to **bury** everyone.

#### emergent

adj. starting to exist or view, or to become known synonym: coming, appearing, developing

(1) **emergent** repair of an aorta, (2) an **emergent** republic Extensive areas of **emergent** plants are usually called marsh.

#### remix

 to compose a piece of media that has been altered or contorted from its original state by adding, removing, or changing elements of the item

synonym: recreate, recompose, alter

(1) **remix** a couple of tracks, (2) **remix** the album He **remixed** the tracks to give them a jazz feel.

#### hallmark

 a distinctive characteristic or attribute of a person or thing

*synonym*: symbol, authentication, indication

(1) the **hallmark** of a good scientist, (2) the **hallmark** of modern life

A clear and simple expression is the **hallmark** of good writing.

#### microbe

 a tiny living thing that can only be seen with a microscope and that may cause disease synonym: germ, microorganism, bacterium

(1) pathogenic **microbe**, (2) **microbes** sterilizer **Microbes** thrive on the surface of the human skin.

### synthesize

v. to combine a substance to make a more complex product or compound

*synonym*: incorporate, amalgamate

(1) **synthesize** molecules, (2) **synthesize** information The spider can **synthesize** multiple different silk proteins.

### stratosphere

 the second layer of the Earth's atmosphere, extending from about 7 to 50 kilometers above the Earth's surface, containing the ozone layer

*synonym*: upper atmosphere, ozone layer

(1) **stratosphere** layer, (2) **stratosphere** ozone The ozone layer, which protects us from harmful UV radiation, is in the **stratosphere**.

# disparate

adj. very different or distinct from something else and is not connected or comparable in any way

synonym: different, distinct, separate

(1) **disparate** impact, (2) physically **disparate** location The organization worked to bring together **disparate** groups in the community.

#### obsession

n. the state in which a person's mind is filled with thoughts of one single object or particular person

synonym: compulsion, fixation, enthusiasm

obsession with character, (2) national obsession
