 beliefs and actions employed to influence supernatural beings and forces; any art or performance that invokes supernatural powers

synonym: fascination, illusion, wizardry

#### flute

 a musical instrument consisting of a metal, wood, or bamboo tube with a row of fingerholes and sometimes keys, played by blowing across a hole near one end

#### universe

### opera

*n.* a drama set to music, in which the words are sung rather than spoken

#### seminal

adj. highly original, influential, or innovative; containing the seeds or beginnings of future development or growth; (of medicine) of or relating to semen or the male reproductive system

synonym: influential, groundbreaking, original

(1) **seminal** research, (2) **seminal** duct

The book was a **seminal** work in psychology, influencing generations of researchers.

### myth

- n. an ancient story or set of stories accepted as history, especially explaining the worldview of a peoplesynonym: fable, legend, lore
- (1) the **myth** of an old religion, (2) perpetuate a **myth** With the financial bubble bursting, the **myth** of economic growth in investment banking collapsed.

#### retell

- v. to tell someone about something again or differently synonym: reiterate, repeat, restate

### turbulent

- adj. marked by a lot of sudden changes, confusion, or uncertainty; characterized by intense activity or agitationsynonym: chaotic, stormy, tumultuous

  The stock market has been **turbulent** lately, with prices fluctuating rapidly.

#### crucible

 a vessel made of ceramic, metal, or other materials used for melting or fusing substances at high temperatures; a difficult or trying experience that tests one's character or resilience

synonym: melting pot, cauldron, furnace

(1) electric **crucible** furnace, (2) fire **crucible** The scientific experiment required the use of a high-temperature **crucible**.

#### transformation

*n.* a complete change in form, nature, or appearance of someone or something

*synonym*: change, conversion, renewal

(1) the **transformation** of a tadpole into a frog, (2) cast a **transformation** spell

Understanding unitary **transformations** of a normal matrix require considerable mathematical sophistication.

### phoenix

 a mythical bird that is said to live for several hundred years before dying in flames and then rising again from its ashes; a symbol of rebirth, regeneration, or immortality

synonym: firebird, mythical bird, rebirth symbol

(1) phoenix rising, (2) phoenix feather

A local artist created the **phoenix** sculpture in the park.

#### char

v. to burn or scorch the surface of something with fire or heat, often intentionally; to cook or prepare food over an open flame; to blacken or discolor due to excessive heat or burning; (noun) a charred piece of wood or other material; (noun, of a computer) a character or symbol in a text or string of characters in computer programming

synonym: burn, scorch, singe

### fellowship

 an association of people who share common interests or goals, typically involving research, study, or a specific profession synonym: association, society, group

#### crater

 a huge bowl-shaped cavity in the earth or an object in space, usually created by an explosion or the impact of a meteorite

synonym: cavity, hole, pit

An enormous **crater** marks the area where the vast volcanic explosion occurred.

### ceremony

- n. a formal event or ritual, often religious or solemnsynonym: ritual, rite, observance

rite

 a formal or ceremonial act or set of acts performed in a traditional or prescribed way; a religious or spiritual ceremony or practice

### temple

 a place of worship, especially one that is associated with a particular religion or faith; the flat area on either side of the forehead

### gigantic

adj. extremely large

synonym: huge, enormous, immense

### electrify

v. to make a machine or system work by using electricity; to make someone extremely enthusiastic about or interested in something

synonym: wire, amaze, astonish

#### concert

### villager

### glint

v. to shine or sparkle with a brief, sudden light; to give a glimpse or hint of something; (noun) a quick or sudden flash of light, often reflecting off a surface

synonym: sparkle, shimmer, twinkle

#### warrior

 adj. containing a lot of carefully prepared and organized or many complicated and detailed parts

synonym: detailed, intricate, complicated

### extraordinary

adj. exceptional, unexpected, very unusual; surpassing the ordinary or usual

### involve

v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

synonym: implicate, include, engage

### eternal

adj. being without beginning or end; lasting forever synonym: endless, everlasting, undying

### disappear

v. to cease to exist or be visible

synonym: fade, evaporate, vanish

### prop

n. a piece of wood, metal, etc., placed beneath or against something to support it or keep it in position; a system, institution, or person that gives help or support to someone or something

#### lantern

a portable source of lighting, typically featuring a protective enclosure for the light source

#### balance

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

### imaginary

adj. existing only in someone's mind synonym: fictional, ideal, fantastical

### ideogram

n. a written or graphic symbol that represents an idea or concept directly, without using specific words or sounds, often used in languages like Chinese or Japanese, where characters represent complete ideas or objects rather than individual letters or sounds

synonym: symbol, character, glyph

#### stroke

 a medical condition in which poor blood flow to the brain causes cell death; the act of swinging or striking at a ball with a club, racket, etc.

#### bamboo

 a fast-growing plant that has long, hollow stems and is widely used as a building material, food source, and decorative element, especially in Asian cultures

### concept

#### mask

silk

### gazelle

 a slender, graceful antelope with long, slender legs and curved horns, native to Africa and parts of Asia

leap

### mechanics

#### savannah

 a mixed forest and grassland ecosystem where the trees are far enough apart that the canopy doesn't close

### apparent

*adj.* able to see or understand easily or clearly *synonym*: obvious, clear, conspicuous

adj. without any writing or printing; empty or devoid of ideas, information, or meaning; unable to remember or recall information

### string

 long, thin material used for tying things together, composed of several twisted threads

### spiritual

adj. relating to or affecting the human spirit or soul as opposed to material or physical things

#### sunrise

*n.* the time in the morning when the sun first appears in the sky

### clip

### prosper

#### governor

 the person who holds the highest executive office in a state or province

#### heaven

n. (of various religious and mythological traditions) a place or state of existence considered to be the abode of the divine, the afterlife, or a higher realm of being; a state of great happiness, contentment, or beauty

synonym: paradise, nirvana, utopia

(1) ascend to **heaven**, (2) **heaven** on earth

He felt like **heaven** when he tasted the delicious chocolate cake.

### shalt

v. an archaic form of "shall," which is used to indicate a command, a requirement, or a prediction

synonym: must, should, ought

### cramp

 a sudden, painful contraction or spasm of a muscle, typically in the leg or abdomen; a feeling of tightness or discomfort in a muscle caused by prolonged use or stress

### plague

 any epidemic disease with a high death rate; (also called pest) a serious, sometimes fatal, infection spread by rats that causes fever and swellings on the body

roar

nurture

v. to take care of, feed, and protect someone or something while they are growing and developing

grand

adj. important and large in size, scope, or extent synonym: impressive, great, ambitious

### gorgeous

### palace

 the residence of a high-ranking official such as a king, queen, etc.

synonym: mansion, manor, castle

### fade

- v. to vanish; to fade away; to lose color; to lose freshness synonym: languish, wither

### rack

 a framework or support structure used to hold or display objects; a set of interconnected shelves or compartments used for storage; a source of torture, distress, or mental anguish

synonym: shelf, stand, frame

#### rake

n. a garden tool with a long handle and curved, pointed teeth used for gathering fallen leaves, grass clippings, and other debris from lawns and gardens; a dissolute or immoral person, often one who pursues pleasure and debauchery to excess

### horizon


