#### mayhem

## subterfuge

 a deceptive stratagem, tactic, or plan used to hide one's true intentions or to deceive someone; a trick or ruse designed to mislead or disguise the truth

## politic

#### guerrilla

rabbi

#### intellect

## ingest

## analgesic

#### sniff

sham
