#### janitor

 a person whose job is to clean and maintain a large building, such as a school or a block of flats

synonym: keeper, guardian, custodian

#### decency

 behavior that is appropriate or suitable in a given context, especially in terms of social norms and moral standards

synonym: morality, propriety, decorum

(1) an offense against **decency**, (2) **decency** standards He always tried to act with **decency**, treating others with respect and kindness.

#### insecure

adj. not firm or firmly fixed; likely to fail or give way, or not assured of safety

synonym: uncertain, unsure, unconfident

(1) an insecure future, (2) insecure attachment Children in an unstructured environment often feel insecure.

#### masculinity

the qualities or attributes traditionally associated with n. men, such as physical strength, courage, assertiveness, and so on; the state of being male or manly

synonym: manliness, virility, machismo

- (1) masculinity norms, (2) toxic masculinity Research has shown that rigid ideas of masculinity can contribute to domestic violence and other forms of abuse.
- to imitate someone's speech, movement, or behavior, especially to make others laugh

synonym: mirror, imitate, ape

(1) **mimic** a human voice, (2) **mimic** numerous instruments He is very popular at school because he can **mimic** all the teachers' accents.

#### camouflage

mimic

an outward appearance that conceals the underlying essence of something; the way of concealing troops or military equipment so they cannot be seen against the surrounding environment

synonym: guise, mask, cloak

- (1) camouflage clothing, (2) work as camouflage They utilized branches of trees as **camouflage**.
- a person who uses strength or power to harm or intimidate those who are weaker; (verb) to intimidate, harass, or mistreat someone weaker or less powerful synonym: tormentor, intimidator, aggressor

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### bully

(1) bully bystander, (2) bully the weak

The schoolyard **bully** terrorized the other children and made their lives miserable.

#### segregate

barb

v. to separate or set apart from others, often based on race, gender, or some other characteristic

synonym: isolate, separate, divide

- (1) **segregate** by race, (2) **segregate** boys and girls The school board decided to **segregate** students by the ability to meet their needs better.
- n. a sharp projection or point, often on a plant or animal; a cutting remark or criticism that is meant to hurt or insult; a type of fishing lure that has small hooks and a brightly colored feather or hair

synonym: spine, barbed remark, sting

(1) barb wire, (2) aim a barb

The politician's words were full of **barbs** designed to hurt his opponent.

#### resonate

v. to be filled with a deep echoing sound

synonym: echo, reverberate, resound

(1) deeply **resonate** with the consumers, (2) **resonate** in the same frequency

The sound **resonates** well in this theater.

#### recycle

v. to sort and collect things to process them and produce valuable materials that can be used again

synonym: reclaim, reuse, reprocess

(1) **recycle** the cardboard boxes, (2) **recycle** milk packaging into new paper

We largely **recycle** the circuit board of cell phones because they contain a lot of valuable metals.

### capitalize

to write a whole letter or the first letter of the alphabet as a capital; to provide a company, etc. with the money; to take the chance to gain advantage from something

synonym: bankroll, finance, endow

(1) capitalize on an interest, (2) capitalize the 1st letter of a word

You must capitalize on your full of opportunities to become a professor.

to eject saliva or other liquid from the mouth synonym: expectorate, saliva, spew

> (1) spit a bullet, (2) spit a mouthful of saliva She tried to **spit** out the gum that she had been chewing.
