detergent

 a substance used for washing or cleaning, especially one that can remove dirt or stains effectively

synonym: soap, cleanser, disinfectant

(1) **detergent** solution, (2) laundry **detergent**I use environmentally friendly **detergent** when I wash my clothes and dishes.

recycle

v. to sort and collect things to process them and produce valuable materials that can be used again

synonym: reclaim, reuse, reprocess

(1) **recycle** the cardboard boxes, (2) **recycle** milk packaging into new paper

We largely **recycle** the circuit board of cell phones because they contain a lot of valuable metals.

incandescent

adj. emitting light as a result of being heated; shining brightly; passionate or enthusiastic

synonym: glowing, radiant, brilliant

electrify

v. to make a machine or system work by using electricity; to make someone extremely enthusiastic about or interested in something

synonym: wire, amaze, astonish

The product developed through years of research continues to **electrify** the market.

smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of **smartphones**.

grandkid

halogen

- synonym: non-metal, element, chemical

opportune

- adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purposesynonym: suitable, timely, practical

halve
