## laparoscopy

n. a surgical procedure that involves the insertion of a thin, lighted instrument called a laparoscope through a small incision in the abdomen, allowing doctors to examine and diagnose internal organs or perform minimally invasive surgeries

*synonym*: endoscopy, keyhole surgery

## graduate

#### drill

 a tool or machine used for making round holes or driving fasteners; a training or practice

#### brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

#### excuse

#### neurosurgery

- *n.* medical operations conducted on the nervous system, including the brain, spinal cord, and individual nerves

#### skull

 a bone framework that surrounds the brain and gives the head its shape

#### stick

## epidural
