regime

democracy

 a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so

synonym: self-government, republic, commonwealth

(1) **democracy** advocate, (2) principles of **democracy Democracy** often entails inclusive capitalism as well.

republic

 a state or country in which the people and their elected representatives hold supreme power and which has an elected or nominated president rather than a monarch synonym: democracy, federation, commonwealth

(1) **republic** democracy, (2) the **republic** of art The United States is a federal presidential constitutional **republic**.

federal

adj. relating to a central government or national authority; refers to government policies, laws, or programs that are implemented at a national level rather than a state or local level

synonym: national, central, governmental

inherit

 to receive money, property, or a title from someone after they have died

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

archives

- a collection of historical documents or records providing information about a place, institution, or group of people synonym: records, documents, repository

dissolution

n. the act of breaking up or dissolving something, often referring to a contract, a relationship, or a substance; the process of disintegrating or decomposing over time; the ending or termination of a group or organization

synonym: disintegration, decay, breakup

historic

adj. famous or significant in history, or potentially so synonym: memorable, momentous, historical

surveillance

 the act of carefully monitoring a person suspected of a crime or a place where a crime may be committed or expected

synonym: administration, overseeing, control

function

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

wiretap

v. to secretly listen to a people's conservation or get their information by connecting a listening device to their phone line

conception

 a general idea or belief of what something or someone is like or should be; an understanding of a situation or a principle

origin

- n. the first existence or beginning of somethingsynonym: root, source, ancestor

locate

emergency

 a sudden unforeseen crisis usually involving danger that requires immediate action

security

n. the state of being free from danger, risk, or harm; measures taken to protect against threats or attacks; a financial asset, such as a stock or bond that derives value exclusively from the ownership interest or claim to a particular underlying asset or obligation

scrupulous

intelligence

 the ability to learn, comprehend, or make judgments or conclusions based on reasons

synonym: brains, brightness, cleverness

imaginable

adj. capable of being imaginedsynonym: conceivable, plausible, possible

tap

arrest

 a lawyer or official who conducts legal proceedings against someone accused of a crime; a person who brings a criminal case to court on behalf of the state or government

preliminary

adj. serving as a preparation for something more important or extensive; introductory; taking place before the main event or decision

investigation

n. the act or process of thoroughly examining a crime, problem, statement, etc., to uncover the truth

interrogate

regiment

 a large military unit, usually consisting of several battalions and commanded by a colonel or higher-ranking officer; a strict or organized system or routine

protest

a strong expression of disagreement, disapproval, or opposition

synonym: objection, disapproval, challenge

uprising

 a public rebellion, especially against an established government or authority

synonym: revolt, rebellion, insurgency

(1) stage an **uprising**, (2) violent **uprising**

The anti-government **uprising** was successful in overthrowing the regime.

concentration

n. the ability to focus all your time and energy on one thing without thinking about anything else.

synonym: attention, engagement, assiduity

(1) **concentration** of armaments, (2) his research area of **concentration**

This exam requires excellent concentration to pass.

smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of **smartphones**.

invention

 the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation; the act of inventing

synonym: creation, design, innovation

(1) the **invention** of new techniques, (2) common **invention** Necessity is the mother of **invention**.

survey

 an investigation of the opinions, behavior, etc. of a particular group of people, made by asking people questions

synonym: study, examination, poll

(1) a comprehensive **survey**, (2) recent **survey**That **survey** shows that people are accepting the tax increase to some extent.

chancellor

 a senior official or administrator, particularly in a university or government; the person who is the head of the government in some European countries, such as Germany

synonym: official, administrator, head

(1) **Chancellor** of the Exchequer, (2) associate **chancellor** The **chancellor** of the university made an important announcement regarding the budget.

shadow

n. a dark area or shape cast by an object blocking the passage of light; an area in darkness or shade; a reflected image or copy of something; a person, activity, or influence that follows or accompanies someone or something closely and persistently, often in a secretive or ominous manner

synonym: shade, silhouette, outline

(1) **shadow** cast, (2) **shadow** puppetry

photograph

 a picture or image that is produced by a camera; a visual representation or record of a person, object, or scene that has been captured electronically or on film

depart

jar

quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

contrast

- v. to put in opposition to show or emphasize differences synonym: differ, vary, counterpoint

vertical

- adj. upright or perpendicular to a horizontal surface or line synonym: perpendicular, upright, plumb
- (1) **vertical** takeoff, (2) **vertical** axis
 The ladder leaned against the **vertical** surface of the building.

empathy

- n. the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situationsynonym: compassion, sympathy, tenderness
- (1) full of **empathy**, (2) **empathy** for patients **Empathy** is also necessary to understand history.

observation

- the act or activity of carefully examining or monitoring something or someone
- synonym: watching, notice, reflection
- (1) class **observation** day, (2) **observation** instrument In the hospital, she will remain under constant **observation**.

smuggle

- v. to import or export something or someone without paying appropriate customs duties, often illegally
- (1) **smuggle** drugs, (2) **smuggle** herself out of a country He was able to **smuggle** a gun inside the prison.

forbidden

- adj. not permitted or allowed by rules or lawssynonym: prohibited, banned, illegal

typical

- adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

minister

a person appointed to or a job of a head of a government department

synonym: bishop, official, ambassador

unofficial

 adj. not authorized or recognized by an authority or organization; informal; not having an official status or position

synonym: informal, unauthorized, off-the-record

(1) **unofficial** sources, (2) **unofficial** statement

The election commission did not yet confirm the **unofficial** results of the election.

collaborate

v. to work with someone else to produce or achieve something

synonym: cooperate, unite, get together

(1) **collaborate** with the police, (2) **collaborate** on a press release

She agreed to **collaborate** with him in creating new artwork.

constantly

adv. all the time

synonym: continuously, always, frequently

(1) a **constantly** innovative enterprise, (2) a **constantly** varying mind

The mobile application industry is **constantly** changing.

spy

 a person who is employed or trained to observe or gather information in secret, often for military or political purposes; a person who secretly or illegally gathers information about a private individual or organization

synonym: agent, undercover operative

(1) spy cameras, (2) digital spy tools

The government recruited a **spy** to gather information on a suspected terrorist cell

recruit

 to persuade someone to work for a company; to find new members for an organization, the armed forces, etc.

synonym: raise, enroll, enlist

recruit a good worker, (2) recruit a new hire
 The colonial government recruited militia support when civil

war broke out.

educate

v. to provide or receive instruction or training over a period of time at a school, university, etc.

synonym: instruct, teach, train

(1) educate student, (2) educate public

The school's mission is to **educate** young children and prepare them for the future.

sophisticated

adj. having a great deal of worldly experience and knowledge of people's behavior, culture, and fashionsynonym: refined, cultured, worldly

(1) **sophisticated** look, (2) a **sophisticated** lifestyle Marketing strategies are growing more **sophisticated**.

guideline

 a general rule or principle that provides guidance to appropriate behavior; a piece of advice or instructions that tell you how something should be done or what something should be

synonym: policy, direction, protocol

(1) an education **guideline**, (2) **guideline** for clinical trial This book will be a practical **guideline** when coding.

convince

v. to persuade someone or make someone believe that something is true

synonym: persuade, win over, convert

(1) **convince** her to go with us, (2) **convince** an opponent I am considering what I should do to **convince** him.

betray

v. to reveal or deliver to an enemy by treachery or disloyalty; to reveal something unintentionally

synonym: fail, denounce, display

(1) betray a friend, (2) betray confidence

He felt **betrayed** when his best friend revealed their secret to the enemy.

fellow

adj. someone who has the same job or interests as you, or is in the same class, profession, or situation as you

synonym: buddy, mate, affiliate

(1) junior fellow, (2) nice fellow

He is the kind of **fellow** who only works for his success.

whistleblower

n. a person who reveals or reports illegal, unethical, or immoral activities, primarily in the workplace or government, that are not publicly known but harm the public interest or other people

synonym: informant, snitch

(1) anonymous **whistleblower**, (2) government **whistleblower**

The government has laws in place to protect **whistleblowers** from retaliation.

coop

- v. a farm building or enclosure for housing poultry synonym: birdcage, enclosure, cage
- (1) fly the coop, (2) chicken coop

The farmer put a **coop** over the hens.

conviction

 a strong belief or opinion, especially one that is based on principles or evidence; (criminal law) a final judgment of guilty in a criminal case and the punishment that is imposed

synonym: belief, certainty, faith

(1) moral **conviction**, (2) **conviction** for murder She spoke with **conviction** about the importance of education.

bond

 a close emotional connection between two or more people; a certificate of debt that a government or corporation issues to raise money

synonym: bind, adhesion, attachment

(1) **bond** as a family, (2) global **bond** market They had formed a friendship **bond**.

dissident

 a person who opposes the policies or actions of a government or other authority, often publicly and openly;
 a rebel or revolutionary

synonym: dissenter, rebel, protester

(1) **dissident** activities, (2) outspoken **dissident**The government's security forces constantly monitored the **dissident** politician.

elect

v. to choose someone for a specific position by voting for them; to decide or choose to do something

synonym: select, choose, prefer

(1) **elect** the school board, (2) **elect** death

Every five years, the provincial governors are **elected**.

prime

adj. main or most important; basic; (prime number, noun) a natural number greater than 1 that cannot be formed by multiplying two smaller natural numbers (e.g., 2, 3, 5, 7, 11 and 13)

synonym: excellent, exceptional, premium

After a thorough investigation, she has been named as the **prime** suspect.

broad

adj. very wide; general

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

church

 a building or institution dedicated to religious worship or activities; a Christian religious organization or denomination

synonym: chapel, cathedral, synagogue

recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

(1) recognize talent, (2) recognize achievementIt's important to recognize your strengths and weaknesses.

novel

 an extended fictional work in prose; usually in the form of a story; (adjective) original and of a kind not seen before

synonym: fiction, story, (adjective) innovative

(1) historical **novel**, (2) **novel** effect

The **novel** has largely gotten positive feedback.

apparently

adv. based on what you have heard or read synonym: evidently, obviously, supposedly

(1) **apparently** simple, (2) **apparently** unrelated The police **apparently** believed this explanation was plausible.

advance

v. to go or move forward; to develop in a positive way synonym: progress, boost, come along (1) **advance** the technology, (2) **advance** a cooperative relationship

Scientific knowledge will **advance** significantly with the power of AI.

surround

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop
- (1) **surround** a town, (2) a stone wall **surrounds** the palace On three sides, mountains **surround** the settlement.

totalitarian

- adj. of or relating to a system of government in which a single political party has complete control and power synonym: dictatorial, authoritarian, oppressive
- (1) **totalitarian** ideology, (2) **totalitarian** state

 The government was criticized for having a **totalitarian** regime.

mistrust

v. to have doubts or suspicions about the honesty or sincerity of someone

synonym: doubt, suspect, question

(1) **mistrust** a young man, (2) **mistrust** the government He **mistrusted** her apology because of her past lies.

widespread

adj. existing or happening in various places or among many people

synonym: across-the-board, overall, general
