aid

things sent to help countries in need, notably food or money; support

synonym: helper, resource, assistance

#### consecutive

adj. following in a sequence or order without interruption or break; occurring one after another

synonym: successive, sequential, uninterrupted

(1) **consecutive** holidays, (2) suffer **consecutive** defeats The athlete won three **consecutive** championships in her sport.

#### overcome

to succeed in controlling or dealing with something, such as a problem or difficulty; to defeat or overwhelm someone

synonym: beat, confound, overwhelm

- (1) **overcome** opponents, (2) **overcome** all difficulties He tried to **overcome** a bad reputation and win the election.
- a response that reveals a person's feelings or attitude; n. (in chemistry) a process in which one or more

*synonym*: response, reply, answer

accent

a distinctive way of pronouncing the words of a language that shows which area, country, or social group a person comes from; particular importance or significance

synonym: articulation, inflection, pronunciation

vulnerable

adj. capable of being hurt or influenced physically or mentally

synonym: susceptible, exposed, weak

(1) a **vulnerable** bridge, (2) **vulnerable** parts of the body Infants and pregnant women are particularly **vulnerable**.

assist

v. to help someone in doing anything

synonym: help, support, aid

(1) assist a patient, (2) assist his goal

Please **assist** her with the furniture relocation.

charity

 an organization that helps people in need, especially by providing food, shelter, or money; a kindly and sympathetic attitude toward people

synonym: philanthropy, benevolence, generosity

(1) charity work, (2) ask charity

She volunteers at a local **charity** every weekend to help those in need.

deserve

v. to be worthy of or entitled to something, especially something good or valuable

synonym: merit, earn, justify

(1) <b>deserve</b> respect,	(2) deserve this prize
The employee deserv	ved the promotion for their hard work
and dedication.	

### afford

- v. to have enough money or time to be able to buy or do something
- (1) **afford** to buy a new car, (2) **afford** a high travel cost He cannot **afford** a holiday.

#### override

v. to use one's authority or power to cancel or disregard something, especially a decision or rule made by someone else

synonym: overrule, annul, nullify

(1) **override** the system, (2) **override** a veto The CEO decided to **override** the decision made by the lower-level managers.

### aim

- v. to try or plan to get or achieve somethingsynonym: aspire, direct, target
- (1) **aim** at a specific target, (2) **aim** to be a nurse We **aim** for an overseas expansion.

### strive

- v. to try very hard to do, achieve, or obtain something synonym: preserve, endure, persist
- (1) **strive** hard to get, (2) **strive** for excellence They **strived** to make their dream come true.

## dignity

 the quality of being worthy of esteem or respect; high office or rank or station

synonym: grace, elegance, nobility

(1) respect for human **dignity**, (2) retain everyone's **dignity**. The failure destroyed his trust and personal **dignity**.

### aspiration

 a strong desire to achieve something; the action or process of drawing breath

synonym: ambition, inhalation, intake

(1) no **aspiration** for fame, (2) **aspiration** into the lungs He has an **aspiration** to become a doctor.

### government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

### oversea

adj. situated or operating beyond national boundaries; in, from, or to foreign countries

*synonym*: foreign, abroad, international

(1) **oversea** shipments, (2) for **oversea** use

The company enhanced **oversea** operations to tap into new markets.

### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

gap

 a conspicuous disparity or difference separates something such as a figure, people, their opinions, situation, etc.

synonym: opening, lacuna, spread

#### millennium

- a span of 1000 years, or the 1000th anniversary (plural: millennia)
- (1) past **millennium**, (2) **millennium** bottle of wine Our world is in the third **millennium**.

### develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

### ambitious

adj. having a great desire to attain achievement, power, or wealth

synonym: enterprising, challenging, earnest

(1) achieve **ambitious** goals, (2) with an **ambitious** eye Their company has been in business for a short time but has **ambitious** goals.

### eradicate

 to get rid of or destroy something completely, especially something bad

synonym: destroy, eliminate, exterminate

(1) **eradicate** the deficit, (2) **eradicate** racial discrimination We are trying to **eradicate** this disease from the world.

#### extreme

adj. very great in amount or degree

synonym: farthermost, outermost, fierce

extreme sports, (2) extreme weather events
 Solar gravity creates extreme pressures and temperatures.

### ambition

- n. a strong wish to do or achieve somethingsynonym: purpose, aim, endeavor
- (1) an **ambition** for political power, (2) boundless **ambition** Greed and **ambition** composed his personality.

#### halve

v. to divide something into two equal parts; to reduce something by half its original amount or size

synonym: reduce by half, cut in half, split

(1) halve the price, (2) halve the workload

I need to **halve** the recipe to make just enough for two people.

#### context

the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical **context**, (2) legal **context** It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

### auditorium

a room or building used for concerts, plays, or other public performances

*synonym*: hall, theater, amphitheater

- (1) open-air auditorium, (2) auditorium annex The **auditorium** seating was filled with people waiting for the concert to begin.
- an arrangement of objects or people side by side in a line; (verb) to propel a boat through the water using oars synonym: line, sequence, layer
- (1) criminal on death **row**, (2) a **row** of cherry trees He was the leader of the demonstrators and spoke out against the war in the front row.

#### settle to reach an agreement of disagreement synonym: inhabit, occupy, decide

#### investor

*n.* someone who puts money or capital into something to gain financial returns

synonym: financier, banker, stockholder

(1) **investor** lawsuit, (2) a real estate **investor** Institutional **investors** refrained from buying stocks amid the booming economy.

#### react

- v. to take action in response to something
- *synonym*: respond, reply, oppose
- (1) **react** at a high temperature, (2) **react** against his way of thinking

### policy

a set of rules, guidelines, principles, or procedures that govern decision-making or action, often used in the context of business or government; a course of action or plan of action adopted or followed by an organization or individual to achieve a goal or objective

synonym: strategy, plan, guideline

(1) health **policy**, (2) foreign **policy** 

The company's new **policy** on remote work has made it a more inclusive workplace.

### economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

(1) **economy** of scale, (2) **economy** class

The **economy** of the country is struggling due to the recent political instability.

### innocent

adj. not guilty of a crime, offense, etc.; not having an evil mind or knowledge

synonym: blameless, honest, harmless

(1) an **innocent** child, (2) thousands of **innocent** people My husband was found **innocent** of any crime.

### appreciate

- v. to value and acknowledge the worth of someone or something; to be grateful for something or someone
   synonym: acknowledge, admire, enjoy
- (1) **appreciate** her feedback, (2) **appreciate** the value We would **appreciate** an early reply.

### disappoint

v. to fail to meet someone or their hopes or expectations; to make someone feel sad

synonym: sadden, dismay, frustrate

(1) **disappoint** the audience, (2) don't **disappoint** me She worked very hard not to **disappoint** her boss's expectations.

### scribble

- v. to write or draw carelessly and in a hurry synonym: scrabble, scrawl, jot
- (1) **scribble** on paper, (2) **scribble** notes The words were **scribbled** in pencil.

### classic

adj. judged or deserving to be regarded as one of the best or most important of its kind over a period of time; of a well-known type

synonym: definitive, traditional, typical

(1) a **classic** experiment, (2) Chinese **classic** literature He displayed the **classic** symptoms of depression.

### excite

- v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate
- (1) **excite** the crowd, (2) **excite** rebellion The news of her promotion **excited** her.

#### launch

to send or propel something into the air or space using a device such as a rocket, missile, or spacecraft; to make something available or on sale for the first time synonym: start, initiate, begin

(1) **launch** a spaceship into orbit, (2) **launch** a big attack The company is set to **launch** its new product line next month.

### unlimited

adj. without any limits or restrictions synonym: unrestricted, boundless, limitless

(1) **unlimited** liability, (2) **unlimited** resources

An **unlimited** data plan is a popular option for heavy internet users.

#### chase

v. to pursue something or someone to catch or capture them; to go after something vigorously or with determination; (noun) a pursuit or a hunt; a narrow groove or channel cut into a surface, often used for decorative purposes

synonym: pursue, hunt, track

(1) chase a dream, (2) wild goose chaseThe police officer chased the suspect through the crowded

streets until they finally caught him.

### exchange

to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

*synonym*: trade, swap, interchange

(1) **exchange** rate, (2) **exchange** a few friendly words My sister and I frequently **exchange** books, as we love reading.

stick

v. to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

synonym: pierce, adhere, stay

(1) stick a key in a lock, (2) fire stick

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

### relief

 a feeling of happiness and relaxation that comes when something burdensome is removed or reduced

synonym: remedy, consolation, alleviation

(1) tax relief, (2) sigh of relief

He devoted his life to establishing a humanitarian **relief** fund.

### sanctity

 n. the quality of being sacred, holy, or blessed; the state of being pure, untainted, or inviolable; the ultimate importance or reverence attributed to something

*synonym*: holiness, sacredness, purity

(1) sanctity of life, (2) violate the sanctity

The **sanctity** of human life is a fundamental principle of many religions.

#### reassure

v. to cause someone to feel sure; to give or restore confidence

synonym: comfort, soothe, bolster

(1) **reassure** anxious patients, (2) **reassure** market The pilot tried to **reassure** the customers that the planes were safe.

asset

 something or someone that is useful or valuable quality, skill, etc.; valuable property

synonym: aid, resource, equity

(1) frozen **assets**, (2) liquid **assets** of the company

A sense of humor is an invaluable **asset** in this job.

### encourage

v. to give someone support, confidence, or hope; to persuade someone to do or continue to do something by making it easier for them and making them believe it is a good thing to do

synonym: facilitate, persuade, stimulate

(1) **encourage** a sense of affinity, (2) **encourage** antisocial

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They **encouraged** customers with a premium for loyal patronage.

### physically

adv. in a way related to a person's body or appearance rather than their mind

(1) **physically** and mentally, (2) stay **physically** fit Having a **physically** healthy physique is essential for a great life.

### unprecedented

adj. never having been seen, done, or known before synonym: novel, outstanding, unparalleled

(1) **unprecedented** boom, (2) **unprecedented** business opportunity

**Unprecedented** amounts of heckling and slogan-shouting took place throughout the event.

#### trillion

- n. the number 1,000,000,000,000; a million million
- (1) trillion cubic feet, (2) many trillions of dollarsOne light year is nearly 6 trillion miles.

### circulation

n. the movement of blood through the body or of a fluid through a system; the number of copies of a newspaper or magazine that are sold

synonym: flow, movement, dissemination

(1) lymphatic **circulation**, (2) **circulation** of money

The **circulation** of the magazine has been steadily declining.

### utterly

adv. completely or absolutely

synonym: absolutely, completely, perfectly

(1) utterly changed, (2) utterly ignorant

We are utterly opposed to any form of terrorism.

### unthinkable

adj. too unlikely or shocking to imagine or accept synonym: impossible, inconceivable, outlandish

(1) an unthinkable coincidence, (2) in unthinkable trouble

That accident was something **unthinkable** with my long experience.

#### remarkable

*adj.* worthy of attention because unusual or special *synonym*: outstanding, exceptional, extraordinary

(1) **remarkable** achievement, (2) the **remarkable** breadth of knowledge

The election was a **remarkable** success for the Whigs.

#### inflation

a general and progressive increase in prices;
 (cosmology) a theory of the exponential expansion of space in the early universe; the act of filling something with air

*synonym*: increase, swelling, boom

(1) **inflation** control, (2) global **inflation**Investment in index funds can often be a hedge against **inflation**.

bond

 a close emotional connection between two or more people; a certificate of debt that a government or corporation issues to raise money

synonym: bind, adhesion, attachment

(1) **bond** as a family, (2) global **bond** market They had formed a friendship **bond**.

### equity

- n. the value of the shares issued by a company synonym: fairness
- (1) private **equity** firm, (2) **equity** capital market That company is cautious when it comes to **equity** investment.

#### scare

- v. to frighten a person or animal, or to become frightened synonym: frighten, spook, intimidate
- (1) **scare** off her attacker by screaming, (2) **scare** the birds away

We hit the ground to **scare** out the rabbits.

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#### confidence

n. the feeling or attitude that one can trust or rely on the abilities or good qualities of someone or somethingsynonym: self-trust, certainty, belief

(1) **confidence** as a teacher, (2) boost my **confidence** Skill and **confidence** are an unconquered army.

### threat

 a strong indication or likelihood of harm, danger, or adverse consequences; an expression of intent to inflict harm or injury on someone or something, often made as a means of coercion or intimidation

synonym: menace, danger, hazard

(1) economic **threat**, (2) environmental **threat**The **threat** of severe weather prompted the city to issue an evacuation warning.

### secondly

adv. used to introduce the second point or item in a list or series of statements, considerations, etc.

synonym: in the second place, next, subsequently

(1) **secondly** connected, (2) **secondly**, it is important Firstly, we will discuss the budget; **secondly**, we will go over the schedule.

### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) **statistics** for cancer, (2) official **statistics**The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

### mango

 tropical fruit with smooth, juicy flesh and a large, hard seed in the middle

synonym: fruit, tropical fruit

(1) ripe mango, (2) fresh mango

She cut the **mango** into small pieces and added them to the salad.

### **fundraise**

 to collect or solicit funds or donations, typically for a charity, nonprofit organization, or political campaign,

often through events, campaigns, or online platforms synonym: appeal, raise, solicit

- (1) **fundraise** a charity fund, (2) **fundraise** for a new shelter The school is planning to **fundraise** to purchase new books for the library.
- to make somebody fill with the desire, confidence, or enthusiasm, especially to do something creative *synonym*: boost, encourage, enlighten
- (1) **inspire** a feeling of curiosity, (2) **inspire** him to write a novel

The unique style of this martial arts **inspired** many action film producers.

### donation

- a voluntary gift of money, service, or ideas that are given to a person or an organization, or the act of giving them synonym: contribution, gift, subsidy
- (1) make a **donation**, (2) political **donation** He made a generous **donation** to the charity.

adj. resolute or unwavering in decision-making or action; strong or secure in structure, make, or composition; reliable, trustworthy, or dependable; (noun) a business or company

synonym: stable, secure, steadfast

(1) firm grip, (2) accounting firm

The **firm** deadline for submitting the project is tomorrow, so we need to work efficiently to finish on time.

### charitable

adj. giving money, food, or help free to those who are poor or in need; full of love and generosity

synonym: generous, helping, giving

(1) charitable organizations, (2) charitable deeds He is always **charitable** to the poor.

inspire

### firm

#### contribution

n. the act of giving something, especially money, to a particular cause or organization; a voluntary gift as of money or service or ideas made to some worthwhile cause

synonym: donation, gift, offering

### employee

- n. a person who is hired to work for a business or organization in exchange for wages or salary; a worker synonym: worker, staff, personnel

### brilliant

adj. extremely clever, skilled, or impressive synonym: luminous, intelligent, clever

### conversation

n. an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

### absence

 the fact or condition of being away from a place where they are typically anticipated to be

synonym: dearth, scarcity, lack

absence from work, (2) a leave of absence
 Another critical factor of child poverty is the father's absence.

### grand

adj. important and large in size, scope, or extent synonym: impressive, great, ambitious

(1) a **grand** meal, (2) **grand** bargain

This year's **grand** gathering will be held in Canada.

### scheme

an organized and often large-scale plan or arrangement for doing something

*synonym*: strategy, blueprint, plan

(1) a pilot scheme, (2) draw out a scheme

They carefully executed the well-planned **scheme** they had prepared over the years.

### mandate

- n. an official or authoritative instruction or command; a commission or authority to carry out a particular tasksynonym: command, instruction, authority
- (1) **mandate** obligation, (2) an Imperial **mandate**The **mandate** given to the new government is to improve the economy.

### risky

adj. involving the possibility of danger, failure, or loss synonym: dangerous, perilous, scary

(1) change **risky** behavior, (2) a **risky** enterprise It is extremely **risky** to sail in such a storm.

### involve

- v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something elsesynonym: implicate, include, engage
- (1) **involve** a lot of paperwork, (2) **involve** a high degree of risk

The investigation **involves** several government agencies and is expected to take several months.

### mitigate

v. to make less severe or less intense; to alleviate or lessen the adverse effects of something

synonym: alleviate, relieve, reduce

(1) **mitigate** risk, (2) **mitigate** a natural disaster Efforts to **mitigate** the effects of climate change require a coordinated and sustained effort by governments, businesses, and individuals.

### definition

 a concise explanation of the meaning of a word, phrase, or symbol

synonym: description, connotation, meaning

(1) a precise **definition**, (2) the **definition** of a word Parallel lines are, by **definition**, lines on the same plane that never cross.

### obvious

*adj.* easy to see, discover or understand *synonym*: apparent, conspicuous, evident

(1) **obvious** reasons, (2) his conclusion was **obvious** There are **obvious** differences between the two wine-producing regions.

### currency

- n. a system of money in general use in a particular countrysynonym: money, tender, cash

### depreciation

### gamble

### proportion

 a part, share, or amount of something considered in comparative relation to a whole

### incentivize

v. to make someone want to do in a particular way by offering them a reward

synonym: encourage, motivate

### modest

 adj. having or showing a humble estimate of one's merits, importance, etc.; free from vanity, egotism, boastfulness, or great pretensions
