# develop

to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

# introduction

n. a preliminary explanation or remarks given before the start of a text, performance, or event; the act of bringing something new into existence or introducing something

#### abstract

adj. based on general ideas, feelings, or qualities and not on any a physical or concrete existence

synonym: conceptual, theoretical, ideational

# consistent

adj. always behaving or happening in the same way, or having the same thoughts, standards, etc.

synonym: coherent, constant, compatible

# hypothesis

 a proposed idea or explanation that is based on a few known facts but has not yet been proven to be true or accurate

#### dramatic

adj. very sudden, very excellent, or full of action and excitement

synonym: striking, theatrical, breathtaking

adj. enormous amount; very heavy and solid

#### alternative

# archaeology

# steady

# eyesight

# degree

#### battlefield

- n. a place where a battle or conflict is foughtsynonym: warzone, front line, combat area

#### musket

 a long, smoothbore gun used in warfare from the 16th to 19th centuries, typically fired from the shoulder and loaded through the muzzle

rifle

# equip

 to provide a person or a place with the things that are needed for a particular purpose or activity

# responsible

adj. answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management

synonym: accountable, answerable, liable

She's a **responsible** pet owner who ensures her dog gets enough exercise and a healthy diet.

# artillery

n. large-caliber guns used in warfare, typically operated by a crew and mounted on wheels or in a fixed position; any military weapons, equipment, or vehicles that are operated by a special branch or unit of the armed forces

synonym: guns, cannons, ordnance

(1) artillery fire, (2) coastal artillery

The army brought in heavier **artillery** to break through the enemy defenses.

#### resistant

- adj. not affected by something, especially changes or new ideas; of or relating to immunity to disease or infectionsynonym: unsusceptible, immune, invulnerable

### deduce

# specification

 a detailed description of the characteristics, features, or requirements of something, typically a product or system; a written statement that outlines the standards, procedures, or requirements for a project or job

synonym: description, requirement, guideline

(1) functional **specification**, (2) engineering **specification**The project's **specifications** outlined the goals and requirements for the team to complete.

# logic

 a way of thinking or reasoning conducted or evaluated by strict validity principles; the study of correct reasoning or good arguments

synonym: reasoning, reason, ratiocination

(1) an indisputable **logic**, (2) a demonstration in **logic** There's no **logic** in his description.

#### rural

adj. of or relating to the countryside synonym: agrarian, country, rustic

(1) **rural** accents, (2) people in **rural** areas Many **rural** areas are still impoverished.

#### fellow

adj. someone who has the same job or interests as you, or is in the same class, profession, or situation as you

synonym: buddy, mate, affiliate

(1) junior **fellow**, (2) nice **fellow**

# absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterlysynonym: completely, utterly, definitely

# peck

v. to strike or bite someone or something repeatedly, usually with the beak or bill; to give a quick, small kiss or nibble

The wood **pecker** would peck at the tree high up in the branches.

camel

- a cud-chewing mammal used as a draft or saddle animal in desert regions
- (1) camel hair, (2) ride a camel

A **camel** has a hump on its back.

imply

v. to indicate the truth or existence of something without referring to it

synonym: hint, indicate, denote

(1) **imply** a strong correlation, (2) **imply** the presence of alien

The salespeople speak in technical terms to **imply** that they are more knowledgeable than the customer.

unwilling

adj. not ready or wanting to do something synonym: disinclined, involuntary, reluctant

(1) **unwilling** look, (2) in an **unwilling** voice They were **unwilling** to take any risks.

conduct

- v. to organize and carry out a particular activity synonym: behave, lead, carry on
- (1) **conduct** a background check, (2) **conduct** research Police will **conduct** random breath testing for drunk driving.

pole

one of two antipodal points where the Earth's axis of rotation intersects the Earth's surface; a long, slender, rounded rod, typically of wood or metal, used as a support or to hang something

synonym: rod, staff, shaft

(1) a fishing pole, (2) the plus pole

The North **Pole** is the northernmost point on Earth.

#### settle

- v. to reach an agreement of disagreement synonym: inhabit, occupy, decide
- (1) **settle** a dispute, (2) **settle** down in the town I don't want to **settle** for second best.

# testimony

 a formal written or spoken statement that something is true, especially one given in court; something that serves as evidence

synonym: affirmant, evidence, proof

synonym: decline, turn down, repudiate

# hunt

reject

v. to go after and try to catch wild animals to kill them for food, sport, or profit

# engage

v. to attract and keep someone's attention and interest; to participate in or obtain services of something

### illustration

 a picture or diagram in a book, magazine, or newspaper that is used to explain or decorate the text; the act or process of explaining something

# diploma

a document showing the completion of a course of study or a portion of the education program; a course of study at a college or university

synonym: credential, certificate, degree

# tertiary

adj. relating to or being the third in a series, rank, or order; of or relating to third-level education or training synonym: third-level, third-party, subordinate

(1) **tertiary** education, (2) **tertiary** sector The university offers both undergraduate and graduate programs, as well as a variety of tertiary courses.

# propose

- to make a proposal, declare a plan for something synonym: suggest, offer, recommend
- (1) **propose** the amendment, (2) **propose** changes I want to **propose** a toast in honor of our longstanding relationship.

# grade

- a particular level of quality, size, importance, etc. synonym: score, rate, degree
- (1) boys in the twelfth **grade**, (2) students at all **grade** levels Departments may set requirements for a higher grade point average.

# suppose

- to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

# legislature

 a body of elected or appointed representatives who make laws for a country or state

synonym: government, lawmaking group

(1) colonial **legislature**, (2) a prefectural **legislature**The people elect **legislature** members to represent their interests and make decisions on their behalf.

# county

an administrative division of a country or state, typically one of several comprising a larger division

synonym: district, region, territory

(1) **county** seat, (2) throughout the **county** 

The **county's** population has been increasing rapidly in recent years.

# employ

v. to give somebody a job and pay them for it; to make use of

synonym: hire, engage, use

(1) **employ** job seekers, (2) **employ** a new method When making arrests, police officers frequently **employ** excessive force.

# profession

an occupation or vocation requiring advanced education or specialized training

synonym: occupation, vocation, trade

(1) **profession** choice, (2) healthcare **profession**Being a doctor is considered a highly respected **profession**.

# technique

a particular way or art of doing something that needs skill

synonym: approach, procedure, strategy

(1) a **technique** in martial arts, (2) the **technique** applied to construction

Jockey's superior **technique** brought him victory.

#### flexible

adj. able to change or be changed to suit new conditions or situations; able to bend easily

synonym: adaptable, elastic, pliable

(1) flexible schedules, (2) a flexible wire

You can be more **flexible** and creative in your approach.

# upgrade

v. to improve the value or usefulness of something such as a machine, computer system, etc., or to replace it with something newer or of a higher standard

synonym: improve, boost, enrich

(1) **upgrade** a product, (2) **upgrade** work performance It's an excellent opportunity to **upgrade** our networking.

sleeve

- n. a part of a garment that covers all or part of an armsynonym: arm covering, armband
- (1) a wide sleeve, (2) sleeve lengthHe rolled up his sleeves to get ready to work.

# practitioner

 a person who works in a profession or occupation, such as a doctor, lawyer, or teacher

synonym: professional, expert, specialist

(1) **practitioner** of Buddhism, (2) **practitioner** of law She is a **practitioner** of traditional Chinese medicine.

# specialize

 to become an expert in a specific career field, study, or business

*synonym*: narrow down, particularize

(1) **specialize** in child care, (2) **specialize** in market research

The restaurant has chefs who **specialize** in beef.

# trustworthy

adj. reliable and dependable

synonym: reliable, dependable, honest

(1) trustworthy ally, (2) trustworthy source

People tend to believe trustworthy friends with their secrets.

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

(1) **communal** swimming pool, (2) **communal** combination of funds

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

# mortgage

 a loan secured by the collateral of a specific property, such as a house, that is repaid over a set period of time with interest; the legal agreement governing this loan

synonym: home loan, loan, lien

(1) **mortgage** payment, (2) fixed-rate **mortgage**They were able to purchase their dream home with a **mortgage** from the bank.

#### merchant

a person who buys and sells a large number of goods,
 especially one who imports and exports goods

synonym: dealer, trader, retailer

(1) merchant bank, (2) agricultural merchant

This shipping company has several hundred merchant ships.

### moral

adj. concerned with the principles of what is right and wrong, fairness, honesty, etc.

synonym: honest, ethical, conscientious

(1) moral hazard, (2) moral burden

Ethics deals with moral conduct.

#### remiss

adj. negligent or careless in performing a duty or task; failing to take proper care or give sufficient attention

synonym: negligent, careless, negligent

(1) remiss behavior, (2) remiss in his duties

Her **remiss** attitude towards her studies is why she falls behind in class.

# agile

adj. able to move quickly and easily, often in a way that is graceful and controlled

synonym: nimble, quick, flexible

(1) an agile mind, (2) agile in his movements

The **agile** development process allowed the team to make changes quickly.

# complicated

adj. involving a lot of different things or parts in a way that is difficult to understand or analyze

synonym: complex, convoluted, intricate

(1) a **complicated** process, (2) become increasingly **complicated** 

He did **complicated** pen-and-ink drawings in just a few days.

# bundle

 a group of things that are tied or wrapped together; a large amount or quantity of something; a package or parcel of things

synonym: package, parcel, bale

(1) **bundle** of papers, (2) travel **bundle** 

I tied up the **bundle** of newspapers and took them to the recycling center.

#### debt

- n. something, especially money, goods, or services owed by one person to another; the state of owing something synonym: liability, obligation, deficit
- (1) debt ceiling, (2) corporate debtHe became in debt after losing his job.

# profitable

adj. making or likely to make material gain or profit synonym: advantageous, beneficial, thriving

(1) a **profitable** job, (2) **profitable** trade

The Prohibition amendment made bootlegging profitable.

#### asset

n. something or someone that is useful or valuable quality, skill, etc.; valuable property

synonym: aid, resource, equity

# virtually

adv. almost completely

synonym: almost, basically, nearly

(1) **virtually** all countries, (2) **virtually** identical **Virtually** all the parties signed the contract.

# bribe

v. to try to make someone do something to gain one's favors or influence by giving a gift of money or other inducements

*synonym*: graft, corrupt

(1) bribe a politician, (2) bribe him with foodHe tries to bribe the ship's captain to export illegal products.

# vulnerable

adj. capable of being hurt or influenced physically or mentally

*synonym*: susceptible, exposed, weak

(1) a **vulnerable** bridge, (2) **vulnerable** parts of the body Infants and pregnant women are particularly **vulnerable**.

# faculty

an inborn or natural ability to hear, see, think, move,
 etc.; a department or group of the university concerned
 with a major division of knowledge

synonym: capability, talent, aptitude

(1) a member of the **faculty**, (2) the illative **faculty** of the mind

This university's computer science **faculty** is world distinguished.

# unexpected

*adj.* not anticipated or regarded as likely to happen *synonym*: surprising, unanticipated, incredible

(1) an **unexpected** visitor, (2) some **unexpected** events The **unexpected** rainstorm caused the collapse of the corral.

# philosophy

- the study of general and fundamental questions, such as those about existence, reason, knowledge, values, mind
   synonym: doctrine, attitude, creed
- (1) **philosophy** of education, (2) western **philosophy** Ethics is a branch of **philosophy**.

#### mere

adj. used to emphasize how insignificant or minor someone or something is

*synonym*: bare, minor, sheer

(1) mere acquaintance, (2) mere incident

He lost the election by **mere** votes.

# psychology

- n. the scientific study of mind and behavior
- (1) **psychology** experiment, (2) **psychology** of crowd She had a master's degree in **psychology**.

### debate

n. a formal discussion or argument of opposing viewpoints, often to persuade others to adopt a specific position; a public discussion, often on an issue of current interest, in which participants offer opinions and differing perspectives

synonym: argument, discussion, dispute

(1) debate topic, (2) debate competition

The **debate** over climate change continues to be a hot topic in politics.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

#### universal

adj. existing or affecting everywhere or everyone synonym: common, broad, worldwide

(1) **universal** life, (2) principles of **universal** design The picture earned near- **universal** acclaim from critics.

### argument

 a set of statements or reasons used to support or refute a proposition or theory; a verbal or physical fight or dispute

synonym: debate, discourse, discussion

(1) a blazing **argument**, (2) the **argument** against capital punishment

The **argument** between the two sides over the proposed policy was heated.

# grandparent

- a parent of one's father or mother
- (1) great- **grandparent**, (2) person of **grandparent** age She was close to her paternal **grandparents** and often spent summers with them.

#### racial

- adj. of or related to the race (= classification of humans into groups based on physical traits or social relations)
- synonym: ethnic, tribal, ethnical
- racial prejudice, (2) racial and ethnic backgrounds
   A minor racial conflict later led to a civil war.

#### bias

- a strong feeling in favor of or against one group of people, an idea, or thing, often not based on fair judgment
- synonym: inclination, partiality, predilection
- (1) **bias** against a big company, (2) have a **bias** toward socialism

She researched gender **bias** in politics.

### emotion

- a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from one's situation, mood, or relationships with others
   synonym: feeling, sentiment, passion
- (1) control my **emotion**, (2) afraid to show **emotion**Some **emotions** are common across cultures and backgrounds.

#### inferior

- adj. lower in rank, status, or qualitysynonym: lower, subordinate, secondary
- (1) an **inferior** poet, (2) **inferior** quality
  The new employee's work was **inferior** to that of the experienced workers in the team.

#### dumb

adj. lacking the power of speech, unable to speak; stupid, or lacking intelligence

synonym: mute, speechless, idiotic

#### attitude

- n. the way you think and feel about someone or somethingsynonym: mindset, perspective, philosophy
