# prodigious

synonym: extraordinary, remarkable, exceptional

The <b>prodigious</b> artist's w	vork was featured in a major
museum exhibition.	

sift

to put flour, sugar, etc. through a sieve (= a utensil consisting of a wire or plastic mesh in a frame) to remove lumps or large particles

synonym: filter, go through, sieve

(1) sift the candidates, (2) sift sand

The search engine helps **sift** information.

#### locomotive

 a powered rail vehicle used for pulling trains or railway cars; an engine that produces the necessary power for the train to move on the tracks

*synonym*: train, engine, motor

(1) locomotive engine, (2) diesel locomotive

The powerful **locomotive** chugged along the tracks, hauling a long line of freight cars.

#### decouple

v. to disconnect or separate something from something else that it was joined to or part of previously

synonym: disunite, disjoint, break up

(1) **decouple** a power supply, (2) **decouple** a space shuttle We have to **decouple** our foreign policy from ideology.

## unplanned

adj. not planned or intended; not having been prearranged or organized

synonym: spontaneous, impromptu, unforeseen

(1) an **unplanned** economy, (2) **unplanned** visit

The **unplanned** power outage caused much inconvenience.

#### downtime

 a period of time when a person or system is not active or operating, often due to technical issues or maintenance work

*synonym*: interruption, break, outage

unexpected downtime, (2) system downtime
 to schedule downtime for maintenance

work, causing a temporary shutdown in production

#### industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort synonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) **industrious** worker, (2) **industrious** student He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

#### inconvenient

adj. causing trouble or difficulty; not convenient or suitable synonym: troublesome, difficult, awkward

(1) face an **inconvenient** truth, (2) **inconvenient** for shopping

It was **inconvenient** for her to go out of her way to pick up the package.

#### helpless

adj. unable to take care of oneself or to do things without help

synonym: defenseless, powerless, susceptible

helpless baby, (2) helpless victims
 feel so helpless without you.

#### turnaround

n. the amount of time needed to prepare a vessel or ship for a return trip; a change or improvement in the condition, performance, or affairs of something

synonym: recovery, improvement, reversal

(1) miraculous **turnaround**, (2) **turnaround** strategy
The company's **turnaround** was a result of new management strategies.

### neurology

 the branch of medicine that deals with the diagnosis and treatment of disorders of the nervous system

synonym: brain science, nervous system, neuropathology

(1) cognitive **neurology**, (2) **neurology** department She is studying clinical **neurology** to become a brain surgeon.

#### cardiologist

- n. a medical doctor who specializes in the study and treatment of the heart and the circulatory systemsynonym: heart doctor, heart specialist, cardiac specialist
- (1) **cardiologist** appointment, (2) skilled **cardiologist**My grandfather is seeing a **cardiologist** to monitor his heart condition.

#### orthopedic

adj. relating to the branch of medicine concerned with the correction or prevention of deformities, disorders, or injuries of the skeletal system and associated muscles, joints, and ligaments

synonym: skeletal, musculoskeletal, bone-related

(1) **orthopedic** shoes, (2) **orthopedic** clinic The athlete visited the **orthopedic** surgeon to have her injured knee examined and treated.

#### instantaneous

adj. occurring or happening immediately or without delay; taking place in an instant or moment

synonym: immediate, prompt, rapid

(1) **instantaneous** reaction, (2) **instantaneous** message The new software provides **instantaneous** results, making it much more efficient than the previous version.

# inefficiency

n. the lack of ability or effectiveness in producing the desired results or outcomes; the quality of being wasteful or unproductive

synonym: ineffectiveness, inefficacy, inadequacy

(1) **inefficiency** in the system, (2) bureaucratic **inefficiency** The company's **inefficiency** in handling customer requests led to many complaints.

disrupt

v. to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by causing a problem or disturbance

*synonym*: interrupt, disturb, break into

(1) **disrupt** a well-ordered condition, (2) **disrupt** sleep I'm so sorry to **disrupt** you when you're pretty busy.

#### mechanize

v. to equip with machinery or automatic equipment; to replace human labor with machines or automation in industry or other processes; to make a job or a procedure more systematic or efficient by the use of tools or technology

synonym: automate, motorize, robotize

(1) **mechanize** operations, (2) **mechanize** agriculture The factory **mechanized** its production line to increase efficiency and reduce labor costs.

#### reorganize

v. to change to a more sufficient or suitable form of organization

synonym: rearrange, reconstruct, reshuffle

(1) **reorganize** a department, (2) **reorganize** his debts

The new CEO was appointed to **reorganize** their business.

#### grumpy

 adj. easily annoyed or irritable; inclined to complain or show dissatisfaction, often in an ill-tempered way

synonym: crabby, grouchy, irritable

(1) grumpy cat, (2) grumpy mood

The **grumpy** older man snapped at the children for playing too loudly.

# disapprove

v. to have or express an unfavorable opinion or judgment about something or someone

synonym: object, reject, condemn

(1) **disapprove** of the government, (2) publicly **disapprove** I **disapprove** of my friend's decision to drop out of school and pursue a career in music instead.

#### propel

v. to move, drive or push something forward or in a particular direction, often with a lot of force

synonym: drive, push, move

(1) propel growth, (2) propel the ship

An increase in employment helps **propel** economic growth.

#### forego

v. to precede or go before something in time or order; to give up, relinquish or do without something, usually by choice or obligation

synonym: antecede, precede, relinquish

(1) **forego** dessert, (2) **forego** the privilege

The company decided to **forego** the expensive advertising campaign and instead rely on word of mouth.

#### cybersecurity

n. the practice of protecting computers, servers, mobile devices, electronic systems, networks, and data from unauthorized access, use, disclosure, disruption, modification, or destruction

synonym: information security, cyber protection

(1) **cybersecurity** threat, (2) **cybersecurity** measures
As the use of technology continues to increase in everyday
life, **cybersecurity** awareness and education become even
more important

#### intellect

 the ability to think logically and comprehend information, especially at an advanced level

synonym: mind, brightness, cleverness

(1) enrich my **intellect**, (2) human **intellect**Your **intellect** is capable of distinguishing among similar objects.

# cyberattack

- n. an attempt to damage, disrupt, or gain unauthorized access to a computer system or networksynonym: cyber intrusion, hack, cyberterrorism

The hackers launched a devastating **cyberattack**, stealing sensitive information from the company's servers.

#### interconnect
