#### scream

v. to give a loud, high shout suddenly, especially because of fear, anger, excitement, etc.; to utter or declare in a very loud voice

synonym: cry, shout, yell

- v. to physically or socially separate someone or something from other people or things

*synonym*: separate, sequester, insulate

isolate a compound, (2) isolate a patient
 You should not isolate them from the community.

#### outsider

isolate

 a person who is not part of a particular group, community, or society; someone who is considered to be on the periphery or outside of established social circles

synonym: stranger, foreigner, alien

(1) **outsider** perspective, (2) **outsider** artist Living in a foreign country can make you feel like an **outsider** at times.

#### extract

n. a short passage taken from a book, piece of music, etc.; a substance obtained from something through a specific process; (verb) to obtain from something or to remove something by effort or force

synonym: excerpt, quote, distillation

(1) a brief **extract** from the book, (2) botanical **extract** Anesthetize the gum before **extracting** the teeth.

### mechanical

adj. operated by a machine, relating to or concerned with machinery or tools

synonym:

utility

electrify

to make a machine or system work by using electricity;
 to make someone extremely enthusiastic about or interested in something

synonym: wire, amaze, astonish

oxygen

- the chemical element with the symbol O that is present in air and water and is necessary for people, animals, and plants to live

strike

- v. to wallop somebody or something with the hand, fist, or weapon; to have an emotional or cognitive impact upon synonym: hit, impact, influence
- strike up a conversation, (2) strike a blow
   we strike to achieve more wages and safer working conditions.

### pension

waltz

 a regular payment to a person made by the government or a private company that is intended to allow them to subsist without working

synonym: allowance, annuity, grant

- (1) a disability **pension**, (2) public **pension** funds Because of the country's poor economic prospects, the number of **pension** defaulters has been increasing.
- a ballroom dance in triple time that originated in Vienna and is characterized by a flowing, graceful style and a strong accent on the first beat of each measure

synonym: ballroom dance, tango, foxtrot

The dancers practiced the steps of the **waltz** meticulously to perfect their performance.

### anomaly

 something or someone that deviates from what is expected or normal, often in a way that is difficult to explain or understand

*synonym*: abnormality, irregularity, deviation

(1) **anomaly** detection, (2) global temperature **anomaly** The sudden drop in the stock market was an **anomaly** that puzzled many investors.

### puzzling

adj. confusing or difficult to understand; mysterioussynonym: baffling, confusing, enigmatic

The detective found the clues **puzzling** and couldn't solve the case immediately.

X-ray

n. a type of electromagnetic radiation that has a wavelength shorter than visible light allowing hidden objects such as bones and organs inside the body to be photographed

synonym: roentgenogram, photon radiography

The doctor ordered an X-ray to see if there was any damage

to the bones.

#### puzzled

adj. confused or uncertain because you do not understand something

synonym: confused, perplexed, bewildered

#### vermiculite

 a hydrated laminar mineral, commonly resembling mica that expands greatly on heating, used in insulation, horticulture, and as a medium for seed germination

synonym: perlite, expanded mica

- (1) asbestos-containing **vermiculite**, (2) **vermiculite** mining The **vermiculite** insulation in our attic needs to be removed due to safety concerns.
- n. the top layer of Earth in which plants grow synonym: earth, ground, mud

#### insulate

### playground

#### skate

rink

 a flat, typically enclosed surface used for skating or other recreational activities such as roller skating, ice hockey, or curling

toxic

*adj.* of or relating to or caused by a poison; poisonous *synonym*: poisonous, harmful, contaminated

asbestos

n. a set of naturally occurring fibrous minerals that were previously used in various building materials, including insulation, roofing, and fireproofing, but later found to be carcinogenic and cause respiratory diseases

synonym: mineral fiber, chrysotile

(1) **asbestos-related** diseases, (2) **asbestos** removal **Asbestos** exposure can lead to serious respiratory problems.

puzzle

*n.* a situation that is difficult to follow or solve; a game, problem, or toy that tests a person's ingenuity or

knowledge; (verb) to cause someone to feel confused because of something difficult to understand

synonym: plight, maze, (verb) perplex

(1) crossword **puzzle**, (2) mathematical **puzzle**This jigsaw **puzzle** is challenging because there are no pictures.

#### amaze

- v. to fill with wonder, surprise, or admiration synonym: astound, surprise, stagger
- (1) **amaze** and entertain visitors, (2) **amaze** everyone The magician's tricks **amazed** the audience.

### annoying

- adj. making someone feel slightly angrysynonym: aggravating, bothersome, irksome
- (1) **annoying** banner ad, (2) **annoying** habit The phone call is an **annoying** interruption.

#### insist

 to say something clearly or demand something forcefully, especially when other people disagree with or oppose what you say

synonym: demand, assert, claim

(1) **insist** on a clear answer, (2) **insist** over and over He **insisted** that she pay her debt to the last penny.

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

(1) **communal** swimming pool, (2) **communal** combination of funds

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

### eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

*synonym*: finally, someday, ultimately

(1) eventually become obsolete, (2) eventually succeed

The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

#### bunch

n. a grouping of several similar things which are growing or fastened together

synonym: group, assemblage, bundle

(1) a **bunch** of trees, (2) a **bunch** of schoolgirls

One bad apple spoils the whole **bunch**.

### bumper

n. a device, typically made of rubber or metal, that projects from the front or rear of a vehicle and absorbs impact in the event of a collision; a metal bar on a vehicle used to push objects out of the way

synonym: buffer, guard, fender

(1) **bumper** crop, (2) **bumper** sale

The **bumper** of my car was dented in the accident.

#### stick

v. to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

*synonym*: pierce, adhere, stay

(1) **stick** a key in a lock, (2) fire **stick** 

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

### display

v. to exhibit or show something to others, often to attract attention or demonstrate its features, properties, or value

synonym: show, exhibit, present

(1) display merchandise, (2) display artwork

We need to **display** our products in an attractive way to attract customers.

#### advent

 the arrival or beginning of something; the coming of Jesus Christ at his birth

synonym: coming, arrival, approach

(1) **advent** calendar, (2) celebrate the **advent** of spring

The **advent** of the internet has dramatically changed the way we communicate.

### definitely

adv. without any question and beyond doubt; clearlysynonym: absolutely, certainly, indeed

(1) **definitely** become a problem, (2) say **definitely** The paper is **definitely** worth reading thoroughly.

### argue

v. to express differing opinions or points of view, often in a heated or contentious manner; to present a case or reasoning to persuade or convince others

synonym: debate, dispute, quarrel

(1) argue a case, (2) argue passionately

The couple began to **argue** over which restaurant to go to for dinner.

### nevertheless

adv. in spite of that; yet

synonym: nonetheless, yet, still

(1) keep working **nevertheless**, (2) **nevertheless**, she persevered

She was tired and hungry, but **nevertheless**, she persevered.

#### victim

 a person who has been harmed, injured, or otherwise negatively affected by a particular action, circumstance, or event

synonym: prey, target, sufferer

(1) **victim** support, (2) **victim** compensation

The **victim** of the crime deserves justice and support to recover from the trauma.

#### industrious

*adj.* hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort *synonym*: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) **industrious** worker, (2) **industrious** student

He was known to be very industrious and would often work

late into the night.

### accident

n. an unfortunate event, especially one causing damage or injury

synonym: calamity, casualty, chance

cause an accident, (2) injury in a car accident
 The accident partially destroyed my vehicle.

### inhabitant

- n. a person or an animal that lives in a particular placesynonym: dweller, occupant, resident
- (1) the early **inhabitants** of Europe, (2) **inhabitant** tax His family is the oldest **inhabitant** of the island.

### discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important discovery.

### mortality

- n. the quality or state of being subject to deathsynonym: fatality
- (1) **mortality** due to cancer, (2) lower infant **mortality** This disease has a high **mortality**.

### grandchild

- n. a child of someone's son or daughtersynonym: offspring, descendant, progeny
- (1) **grandchild-grandparent** relationship, (2) **grandchild** development

The grandparents take care of their **grandchild** while the parents are at work.

### ignorance

 n. lack of knowledge or information about a particular subject or fact

#### blind

#### willful

- adj. deliberate or intentional; done on purpose; characterized by stubborn determination or self-willsynonym: stubborn, obstinate, headstrong

  The **willful** child refused to listen to any instructions from his parents.

### concept

- n. an idea or principle associated with something abstractsynonym: idea, notion, vision
- (1) learn new concepts,(2) concept carOne such rapidly growing concept is quantum cryptography.

#### deem

- v. to consider or decide something in a particular way synonym: believe, consider, suppose
- (1) **deem** socially responsible, (2) **deem** wrong or inappropriate

Regarding earthquakes, some commercial buildings were **deemed** unsafe.

#### mortgage

- n. a loan secured by the collateral of a specific property, such as a house, that is repaid over a set period of time with interest; the legal agreement governing this loan
   synonym: home loan, loan, lien

#### afford

- to have enough money or time to be able to buy or do something

### manipulate

- v. to influence or control something or someone to your advantage, often in an unfair or dishonest way synonym: control, exploit, abuse

### ignore

- v. to intentionally not listen or pay attention to synonym: neglect, disregard, shun
- (1) **ignore** her advice, (2) **ignore** a ban Since independence, the area has been completely **ignored**.

### Catholic

- adj. universal and including many different types of things; related to or associated with the part of the Christian Church that has the Pope as its leader
- (1) **catholic** in his tastes, (2) the **Catholic** Church Sociologists are now interested in **catholic** world peace.

#### church

 a building or institution dedicated to religious worship or activities; a Christian religious organization or denomination

synonym: chapel, cathedral, synagogue

(1) church bell, (2) small church

The **church** on the corner is hosting a free community meal tonight.

#### abuse

- n. the use of something in an incorrect or harmful mannersynonym: misuse, misconduct, vilification
- (1) the problem of drug **abuse**, (2) victim of sexual **abuse** Our company has an audit team that monitors directors for **abuse** of authority.

### runup

n. the period leading up to a specific event, such as an election, deadline, or project completion; the act of running up to something, as in a race or competition

synonym: approach, buildup, ramp-up

(1) interest-rate **runup**, (2) the **runup** in a stock price The store experienced a **runup** in sales during the holiday season.

### epic

 a long and eventful or heroic history, story, poem, or film; (adjective) very imposing or impressive

synonym: legendary, mythical, classical

(1) heroic epic, (2) epic battle

The military **epic** between the two armies was one for the history books.

### institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

(1) **institutionalize** a system, (2) **institutionalize** customary laws

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

#### academic

adj. associated with schools, colleges, and universities, especially studying and thinking, not with practical skillssynonym: educational, scholarly, theoretical

(1) **academic** probation, (2) an **academic** discussion

An excellent historian must possess an **academic** mentality.

### corporation

 a large company or group of companies that are controlled together by law as a single unit

synonym: business, company, enterprise

(1) a public **corporation**, (2) **corporation** assets Four companies were amalgamated into a single **corporation**.

### duplicate

v. to make or be an exact copy of something; to reproduce something

synonym: copy, replicate, reproduce

(1) **duplicate** my efforts, (2) **duplicate** his action I need to **duplicate** this document before I send it.

### silent

adj. without any or little sound synonym: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) silent reading, (2) give silent consent

The politician remained **silent** despite intense media scrutiny.

### germ

 a very tiny living that causes the disease; a piece of something such as an organism, concept, etc., capable of growing into a new one or part of one

synonym: bacterium, microbe, pathogen

(1) antibiotic-resistant **germ**, (2) a **germ-free** environment The **germ** of his idea came from watching birds flying in flocks.

#### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

(1) disease prevention, (2) disease control

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

#### circumstance

the specific conditions or events that surround a particular situation or occurrence

synonym: condition, context, environment

(1) circumstance of birth, (2) circumstance of injury

She explained the **circumstances** surrounding the accident.

#### retaliation

 the act of seeking vengeance or revenge in response to a perceived wrong or harm suffered, usually to cause harm to the person or group responsible for the initial act

synonym: retribution, revenge, vengeance

(1) **retaliation** tactics, (2) **retaliation** against discrimination The company faced heavy **retaliation** from its competitors after releasing a controversial product.

#### futile

adj. incapable of producing any useful result; pointless synonym: useless, worthless, ineffective

(1) **futile** talk, (2) make a **futile** protest

It was **futile** to try and fix the broken vase, as it was too badly damaged.

### protest

a strong expression of disagreement, disapproval, or opposition

synonym: objection, disapproval, challenge

(1) hold a protest, (2) a silent protest

He left the party in **protest** at its radical political stance.

#### recurrent

adj. occurring again, repeatedly, or frequently; returning synonym: continual, repeated, frequent

(1) **recurrent** problem, (2) **recurrent** miscarriage

The patient has been experiencing **recurrent** headaches for weeks.

#### encounter

v. to face something, particularly something unpleasant or difficult, while attempting to do something else; to meet, especially unexpectedly

synonym: meet, run into, come across

(1) encounter a crisis, (2) encounter a storm

I'm prepared to **encounter** challenges throughout this adventure.

#### whistleblower

n. a person who reveals or reports illegal, unethical, or immoral activities, primarily in the workplace or government, that are not publicly known but harm the public interest or other people

*synonym*: informant, snitch

(1) anonymous whistleblower, (2) government

#### whistleblower

The government has laws in place to protect **whistleblowers** from retaliation.

### profound

- adj. extremely great; sensed or experienced very strongly;displaying a high level of knowledge or comprehensionsynonym: deep, unsounded, far-reaching
- (1) a **profound** book, (2) the **profound** depths of the sea My mother's illness had a **profound** impact on us all.

### mythology

a collection of myths (= traditional stories accepted as history) or the study of myths

synonym: folklore, legend, fable

tale from mythology, (2) ancient mythology
 tale from mythology

#### crazy

- adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry
- synonym: insane, absurd, bizarre
- (1) **crazy** about cars and racing, (2) a **crazy** scheme The rain and thunder are **crazy** today.

#### loyal

- adj. giving or remaining firm and constant support to a person, institution, product, etc.;
- *synonym*: dedicated, devoted, faithful
- (1) a **loyal** friend, (2) become a **loyal** customer Enemy armies are **loyal** to their monarch.

#### conservative

- adj. holding traditional views and values and opposed to change or innovation
- synonym: traditional, reactionary, cautious
- (1) a **conservative** society, (2) **conservative** about production

He always makes a **conservative** estimation when predicting future sales.

#### dedicate

 to give all of your energy, time, etc., entirely to a specific person, activity, or cause; to set apart for a particular purpose or use

*synonym*: consecrate, devote, commit

(1) **dedicate** a few hours, (2) **dedicate** a chapter to the subject

He **dedicated** his life to helping others.

#### crush

v. to press it firmly, usually with your hands or a tool, so that it becomes flat or smaller

synonym: destroy, demolish, pulverize

(1) crush coffee beans, (2) crush a revolt

The car was completely **crushed** in the accident.

### pride

 a feeling of deep pleasure or satisfaction derived from one's achievements

synonym: vanity, conceit, egotism

(1) **pride** of a company, (2) hide his **pride** 

She took great **pride** in her work, always striving for perfection.

### photograph

 a picture or image that is produced by a camera; a visual representation or record of a person, object, or scene that has been captured electronically or on film

*synonym*: photo, picture, snapshot

(1) **photograph** album, (2) **photograph** memories I found an old **photograph** of my grandparents from their wedding day.

#### shock

 a strong feeling or physical reaction to a sudden and unexpected event or experience, especially something unpleasant

*synonym*: amazement, surprise, stunner

(1) death from shock, (2) shock-resistantHe got an electric shock at work.

#### obedient

adj. willing to do what someone in authority tells you to do synonym: compliant, submissive, dutiful

(1) grow to be obedient, (2) obedient dog

The **obedient** dog followed its owner's commands.

#### bliss

n. extreme happiness or joy

synonym: delight, euphoria, happiness

(1) ignorance is **bliss**, (2) ultimate **bliss** 

The first two years of her marriage were sheer **bliss**.

### surgeon

 a doctor who is trained to perform medical operations that involve cutting open a person's body

synonym: sawbones, doctor

an excellent brain surgeon, (2) army surgeon
 a skilled surgeon that has many years of training and experience.

### prompt

v. to make someone decide to or try to do something, or to make something happen

synonym: actuate, inspire, incite

(1) **prompt** a feeling of hunger, (2) **prompt** a debate That incident **prompted** a nationwide chain reaction regarding the crackdown on illegal groups.

#### relation

 the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

*synonym*: association, linkage, connection

(1) **relation** between cause and effect, (2) **relation** of inclusion

The industrial **relations** laws were passed with little to no alteration.

### refusal

 the act of showing or saying that one is not willing to do or accept something

synonym: denial, rejection, turndown

(1) meet with a **refusal**, (2) **refusal** of inspection

### She gave a firm refusal.

### military

adj. relating to or characteristic of members of the armed forces; of or relating to war or warfare

synonym: armed, martial, warlike

(1) a military operation, (2) a military leader

The **military** academy was known for its strict discipline and training.

### recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

(1) **recognize** talent, (2) **recognize** achievement It's important to **recognize** your strengths and weaknesses.

### acknowledge

v. to accept or admit the existence, reality, or truth of something; to accept that someone or something has a particular authority or quality; to express obligation, thanks, or gratitude for someone's help, commitment, etc.;

synonym: accept, agree, declare

(1) **acknowledge** the deed, (2) **acknowledge** his help He never **acknowledged** his fault.

#### traumatic

adj. relating to or caused by injury, especially emotional injury

synonym: distressing

(1) traumatic event, (2) traumatic brain injury

The experience was so **traumatic** that it left a lasting impact on the survivor's mental health.

### syndrome

- a group of signs and symptoms that occur together and are characteristic of a particular condition or disorder
- *synonym*: disorder, condition, complication
- syndrome of dementia, (2) acute syndrome
   The patient was diagnosed with a rare genetic syndrome.

### psychology

- n. the scientific study of mind and behavior
- (1) **psychology** experiment, (2) **psychology** of crowd She had a master's degree in **psychology**.

#### medical

adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

*synonym*: health, disease, treatment

(1) a **medical** opinion, (2) temporary **medical** treatment The **medical** team worked quickly to save the patient's life.

#### assist

- v. to help someone in doing anything
- synonym: help, support, aid
- (1) assist a patient, (2) assist his goal

Please assist her with the furniture relocation.

#### hard-won

adj. achieved with great effort, perseverance, or sacrifice;
 earned or gained only after overcoming significant
 obstacles or challenges

synonym: challenging, hard-fought, difficult

(1) hard-won victory, (2) hard-won peace

After years of hard work, she finally achieved her **hard-won** success.

### censorship

n. the act or process of suppression or restriction of any portions of books, films, news, etc. that are judged obscene, politically unacceptable, or a threat to security

synonym: restriction, suppression

(1) clear **censorship** by the Education Ministry, (2) form of **censorship** 

Newspapers were subjected to **censorship** a few days later.

### ethnicity

 the cultural characteristics of a particular group, such as language, religion, and traditions, that distinguish them from other groups

synonym: race, culture, heritage
