#### universe

 everything that exists, especially all physical matter, including planets, stars, galaxies, and all other forms of matter and energy synonym: cosmos, macrocosm

twit

a silly or foolish person; someone regarded as annoying or irritating

synonym: fool, idiot, imbecile

(1) celebrity **twit**, (2) neighborhood **twit**Please ignore that **twit** on social media; their opinions are irrelevant.

tap

v. to hit someone or something quickly, gently, and often repeatedly; to use existing resources, such as energy, knowledge, etc.

synonym: knock, exploit, use

(1) **tap** a new market, (2) **tap** keyboard with an index finger To expand the company, we must **tap** new human resources.

fictional

adj. imaginary and not real; of or related to literary fiction synonym: imaginary, invented, made-up

fictional character, (2) non-fictional text
 The names of the company are entirely fictional.

engage

v. to attract and keep someone's attention and interest; to participate in or obtain services of something

synonym: confront, employ, amuse

- (1) **engage** in environmental protection activities,

Many multinational companies are **engaged** in the reconstruction of that country.

evil

adj. profoundly immoral, cruel, and wicked; having or exerting a harmful effect on people

synonym: malign, corruption, immorality

#### congress

 a formal meeting of the representatives of different countries, constituent states, organizations, trade unions, political parties, or other groups

## democracy

n. a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so

synonym: self-government, republic, commonwealth

## engagement

 a mutual promise to marry someone; an agreement to do something, especially at a particular time

## homage

## parody

 a humorous imitation of a serious piece of literature or music designed to ridicule or criticize the original work

## mayor

an elected official who presides over a city or town government

synonym: governor, leader, chief executive

#### expletive

- a curse word or a swear word; a word or phrase used to convey strong emotions, such as anger or frustration synonym: curse, swear word, profanity
- (1) **expletive** language, (2) **expletive** pronoun When she stubbed her toe, she let out an **expletive** in pain.

## depart

- to go away or leave, especially to start a journey synonym: go away, leave, vacate
- (1) arrive and **depart** on time, (2) **depart** from the faith We **departed** before the temperature fell below zero.

foul

- adj. extremely unpleasant, dirty, or smelling bad synonym: nasty, loathsome, illegal
- (1) **foul** day, (2) **foul** language It was **foul** of him to betray his friend.

solid

- adj. hard or firm; characterized by good substantial quality synonym: stable, reliable, hard
- (1) **solid** ally, (2) **solid** employment measures The **solid-state** of water is called ice.

weird

- adj. extraordinary, unexpected, or difficult to explain synonym: bizarre, creepy, peculiar
- (1) a weird dress, (2) the state of being weird My computer has been acting weird recently.

## progression

- the act or process of changing to the next stage or phase or moving forward synonym: advancement, development, evolution
- (1) **progression** of civilization, (2) **progression** of disease The company has made great strides in its **progression** toward sustainability.

#### epic

a long and eventful or heroic history, story, poem, or film; (adjective) very imposing or impressive

synonym: legendary, mythical, classical

(1) heroic epic, (2) epic battle

The military **epic** between the two armies was one for the history books.

## protagonist

 the main character in a literary work, film, or other stories

synonym: hero, central figure, leading character

(1) protagonist of drama, (2) play a protagonist

The **protagonist's** triumph over adversity was the theme of this play.

#### dimension

 a measurable extent of a particular kind, such as width, height, or length

synonym: extent, measurement, size

(1) new **dimension**, (2) the crosswise **dimension**Overall **dimensions** are approximately 400x200mm.

#### narrative

 a story or a description of a series of events or process of telling a story

synonym: the tale, chronology, annals

(1) narrative poetry, (2) personal narrative

The **narrative** handles multiple plot lines and has unpredictable ends.

#### conclude

v. to come to an end or close; to reach a judgment or opinion by reasoning

*synonym*: complete, finish, decide

#### sink

to submerge or go down below the surface of a liquid or substance; to decline or deteriorate; to cause something to go down into a liquid substance or sink into something else

## journalist

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

## anonymous

## representative

#### absurd

#### criminal

## **hapless**

## lingo

the special vocabulary or terminology used by a particular group or profession

## sunglasses

 a pair of darkened glasses worn to protect the eyes from harsh sunlight or glare

synonym: shades, eyewear, specs

#### addition

 the act or process of adding something to something else; the process of adding numbers

synonym: accumulation, expansion, addendum

arch

 a curved structure with two supports that holds the weight of something above it, such as a bridge or the upper part of a building

synonym: turn, bow, arc

nonfiction

 a genre of literature that deals with the factual representation of real or historical events, people, or places; prose writing that presents or discusses true life events or experiences

This **nonfiction** book about the history of jazz is a must-read for music fans.

**twist** 

v. to bend or turn something into a certain shape

drone

 a low continuous humming noise; someone who takes more time than necessary; a pilot-less aerial vehicle that is operated by remote control

synonym: hum, whirr, idler

strike

- v. to wallop somebody or something with the hand, fist, or weapon; to have an emotional or cognitive impact upon synonym: hit, impact, influence

#### frame
