conscious

- an organ having nerve endings that respond to stimulation such as heat or cold and makes the body react in a particular way

stimming

n. a behavior often exhibited by individuals on the autism spectrum characterized by repetitive bodily movements or sounds, such as hand flapping or rocking, often used as a form of self-regulation or sensory stimulation

engine

 a machine that converts thermal energy to mechanical work; something that has an important role used to achieve a purpose

synonym: motor, locomotive, driver

combination

a collection of things that have been combined; an assemblage of separate parts or qualities

synonym: blend, hybrid, compounding

glutathione

- n. a tripeptide molecule composed of the amino acids glutamic acid, cysteine, and glycine produced naturally in the body, which is a powerful antioxidant that plays a crucial role in the body's defense against free radicals and supports the immune system
