disperse

emit

synonym: dissipate, spread, scatter

epiphany

a moment of sudden and great realization or revelation; a Christian festival, held on 6 January, celebrating the visit of the three wise men to the infant Jesus

synonym: revelation, enlightenment, insight

devise

motorbike
