X-ray

# discovery

lung

- n. either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing

strain

## cigarette

## symptom

#### remission

 a period of time when a disease or condition is no longer present or active; a lessening or reduction of symptoms or intensity; forgiveness or pardon for sins or debts

#### sensitive

#### nucleotide

#### differentiate

## demonstration

#### biochemical

adj. relating to the chemical processes and substances that occur within living organisms

## pancreas
