hertz

the unit of frequency, equal to one cycle per second,
often used to describe the frequency of electromagnetic
waves or electronic signals

synonym: frequency, cycles per second

The human ear can detect sounds with frequencies ranging from 20 to 20,000 **hertz**.

flashlight

 a portable electric light with a handle and a switch that can be turned on and off

synonym: torch, lamp, beacon

lantern

a portable source of lighting, typically featuring a protective enclosure for the light source

synonym: lamp, beacon, flashlight
