# symptom

 any sensation or change in body or mind that is experienced by a patient and is associated with a particular disease

clinic

 a building or hospital department where people can go for medical care or advice, especially of a particular condition

# improve

v. to make or become better

*synonym*: enhance, ameliorate, enrich

#### illustrate

v. to provide pictures, photographs, diagrams, etc. in a book or something for explanation

synonym: demonstrate, explain, exemplify

(1) **illustrate** a key point, (2) **illustrate** a story

# patient

 a person who is receiving medical treatment, care, or attention from a healthcare professional, such as a doctor, nurse, or therapist; a personal quality or characteristic

*synonym*: client, recipient, subject

patient in the hospital, (2) patient with weight loss
 The doctor carefully examined the patient's medical history.

#### chronic

adj. being long-lasting and recurrent or characterized by long suffering; habitual

*synonym*: established, regular, constant

(1) risk of **chronic** disease, (2) **chronic** alcohol consumption

**Chronic** hyperglycemia is a trigger for a variety of serious diseases.

# headache

n. pain in the head; someone or something that causes anxiety or trouble

*synonym*: concern, difficulty, problem

(1) **headache** accompanied by fever, (2) bit of a **headache** This pill will relieve your **headaches** immediately.

# episode

 a happening or story that is distinctive in a series of related events; an abrupt short period during which someone suffers from the effects of a physical or mental illness

synonym: event, chapter, seizure

(1) end of the first **episode**, (2) **episode** of vertigo I want to put that **episode** of my life behind me.

# emergency

 a sudden unforeseen crisis usually involving danger that requires immediate action

synonym: crisis, trouble, difficulty

(1) **emergency** action, (2) acute **emergency**. The president declared a state of **emergency**.

#### norm

n. something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standard synonym: criterion, mean, standard

(1) **norm** of action, (2) cultural **norm** 

The systems we have developed has accepted as industry **norms**.

#### medication

 a drug or other form of medicine that treats, prevents, or alleviates the symptoms of the disease

synonym: cure, drug, medicine

(1) antibiotic **medication**, (2) **medication** by mouth

The pharmacist not only prescribes the **medication** but also guides its proper use.

# primary

adj. first or highest in rank, order, or importance; most fundamental or essential; pertaining to the initial or introductory stage of something, such as a school year or election cycle

synonym: chief, main, fundamental

The **primary** cause of the accident was due to the icy road conditions.

# persist

- v. to continue to do and refuse to stop something despite difficulties or opposition, even if it appears unreasonable synonym: endure, continue, carry on

#### worsen

- v. to become or make something worsesynonym: languish, degenerate, degrade

#### instruction

 detailed direction, order, etc., on how to do or use something

*synonym*: education, direction, guidance

#### relief

 a feeling of happiness and relaxation that comes when something burdensome is removed or reduced

*synonym*: remedy, consolation, alleviation

#### encounter

v. to face something, particularly something unpleasant or difficult, while attempting to do something else; to meet, especially unexpectedly

# medical

adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

#### assistant

someone who helps or supports someone else to do a job

synonym: aide, helper, associate

#### routine

 a usual or habitual way of doing things; a set sequence of steps, part of a larger computer program

synonym: habit, custom, procedure

#### chief

#### mold

n. a hollow container used to give shape to liquid or soft substance, which then becomes solid in the same shape as the container; a soft, green, or gray growth that forms on stale food or objects exposed to warm, moist air for too long synonym: cavity, cast, mildew

(1) a casting **mold**, (2) **mold** allergy

Mushrooms and **mold** are fungi.

leak

v. to allow liquid or gas to get in or out from a hole or crack in a pipe or container

cockroach

 a flat, brown or black, chiefly nocturnal insects sometimes found in the home

synonym: roach

chart

 a visual display of information such as a diagram, lists of figures, etc.; a map designed to assist navigation by air or sea

synonym: diagram, graph, map

(1) a weather **chart**, (2) a statistical **chart** This pie **chart** represents our market share.

handle

- v. to deal with a situation, problem, or strong emotion synonym: control, manage, deal with
- (1) **handle** a precious object, (2) **handled** the incident We all should learn how to **handle** stress.

privilege

 a special right or advantage that only one person or group of people has, usually because they are rich and powerful in a society

synonym: benefit, authorization, advantage

(1) a breach of **privilege**, (2) **privilege** of membership In the Middle Ages, the right to hunt in the wild was the **privilege** of royalty and nobility.

# dignify

to make something worthy of respect or honor; to elevate or give importance to something that may otherwise be considered insignificant

synonym: elevate, ennoble, honor

(1) dignify the role, (2) dignify the occasion It's important to **dignify** other people's opinions and not dismiss them without consideration.

#### formidable

- adj. causing fear, apprehension, or awe; difficult to deal with or overcome; capable of inspiring respect or admiration synonym: daunting, intimidating, fearful

#### presence

the fact or state that someone or something exists, occurs, or is present

- to beat with a strong, regular rhythm, as a pulse or a heart

synonym: pulse, beat, pound

lift

to raise something to a higher position or level; to pick up something or somebody and move them to a different position

synonym: raise, elevate, move up

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

#### crease

 a line or mark made by folding or wrinkling a surface or material; a slight ridge or fold in fabric or paper caused by pressing or folding

synonym: fold, wrinkle, ridge

(1) crease in fabric, (2) deep crease

The shirt had a noticeable **crease** along the sleeve from being folded.

#### medicinal

adj. of or relating to the treatment or cure of diseasesynonym: curative, therapeutic, healing

(1) **medicinal** chemistry, (2) traditional **medicinal**The **medicinal** properties of this herb have been known to

help with various ailments.

# allergic

adj. having or caused by an allergy

synonym: hypersensitive, supersensitive, susceptible

(1) allergic children, (2) allergic to pollen

The infection triggered a high fever and allergic reactions.

#### salute

v. to show respect or recognition for someone or something, often by making a gesture or performing an action; to greet or acknowledge someone in a formal or ceremonious way

synonym: greet, acknowledge, acclaim

# allergy

 a hypersensitivity disorder of the immune system, characterized by an exaggerated response to certain allergens, such as pollens, foods, and drugs synonym: hypersensitivity, reaction

(1) food allergy, (2) allergy treatment

The **allergy** test helped to determine the cause of her symptoms.

rub

v. to move one's hand or an object over the surface of something with pressure

synonym: scrub, massage, stroke

(1) rub shoulders, (2) rub a glass window

She **rubbed** the sore spot on her leg to ease the pain.

rid

v. to make someone or something free of unwanted or unpleasant tasks, objects, or person

synonym: do away with, free, clear

(1) get **rid** of the rats, (2) **rid** the body of waste products We must **rid** ourselves of pollution.

telltale

adj. revealing or betraying information or evidence; serving as a sign or indicator of something

synonym: revealing, indicative, suggestive

examine

v. to study or consider a person or object attentively and thoroughly to learn something about them

synonym: study, probe, analyze

migraine

 a severe headache typically felt as a throbbing pain on one side of the head

synonym: headache, cephalalgia, hemicrania

(1) suffer from **migraine**, (2) **migraine** attack
She gets **migraines** whenever she's under a lot of stress.

#### sinus

a cavity in a bone, especially in the bones of the head,
 or a similar cavity or channel in a plant or animal

synonym: cavity, pocket, air space

(1) chronic **sinus** infections, (2) paranasal **sinus** The **sinus** pressure was causing me a lot of pain.

# congest

v. to make something blocked or crowded so as to hinder or prevent freedom of movement or flow of liquidsynonym: clog, choke, crowd

(1) **congest** in a vein, (2) **congest** a highway The roads to the airport were heavily **congested**.

# relate

 to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

synonym: connect, link, associate

(1) **relate** a story, (2) **relate** a message

He tried to **relate** his experience to the group, but they couldn't understand.

#### relieve

v. to make something burdensome, unpleasant, or painful less severe

synonym: alleviate, ease, assuage

(1) relieve his thirst, (2) relieve stress

The medicine **relieved** his headache, and he felt much better.

# diagnose

v. to determine or distinguish the nature of a problem or an illness through a careful analysis

synonym: identify, analyze, interpret

(1) **diagnose** the problem, (2) **diagnose** with CT scans This device is used to **diagnose** brain cancer and other tumors.

refer

v. to direct someone's attention, thoughts, or questions to another source or person; to mention, cite, or allude to

something as evidence or support

synonym: cite, allude, mention

(1) refer to a book, (2) refer to a map

# specialize

v. to become an expert in a specific career field, study, or business

*synonym*: narrow down, particularize

(1) **specialize** in child care, (2) **specialize** in market research

The restaurant has chefs who **specialize** in beef.

# landlord

a person or organization that rents a room, a house, an office, etc.

synonym: lessor, owner, proprietor

(1) suit against the **landlord**, (2) the **landlord** of an inn He complained about the price of tenant pays to the **landlord**.

# improvisation

n. the act of making something up on the spot or creating or performing something without preparation

synonym: spontaneity, ad-lib, extemporization

(1) **improvisation** on stage, (2) jazz **improvisation** He created a beautiful piece of music using only **improvisation**.

#### shuttle

 a vehicle or boat that regularly moves between two places; bobbin that passes the weft thread between the warp threads

synonym: ferry, transport, convey

(1) space shuttle, (2) shuttle service

The **shuttle** bus will take you to the airport in 15 minutes.

#### remarkable

adj. worthy of attention because unusual or special synonym: outstanding, exceptional, extraordinary

(1) **remarkable** achievement, (2) the **remarkable** breadth of knowledge

The election was a **remarkable** success for the Whigs.

#### asthma

n. a chronic respiratory disease characterized by wheezing, coughing, and difficulty breathingsynonym: bronchial, bronchitis, respiratory ailment

He always had to carry an inhaler due to his severe asthma.

# coincident

adj. happening or operating in the same place or at the same time

synonym: concurrent, accompanying, coextensive

# routinely

adv. on a regular or habitual basis; in a manner that is customary or expected

synonym: habitually, regularly, customarily

(1) **routinely** check, (2) **routinely** scheduled maintenance They **routinely** conduct fire drills to ensure everyone in the building knows what to do in an emergency.

# unfortunately

adv. by bad luck; unluckily

synonym: regrettably, unluckily, alas

(1) **unfortunately** caught in a shower, (2) even more **unfortunately** 

The treatments were done but, **unfortunately**, were unsuccessful.

#### insecure

adj. not firm or firmly fixed; likely to fail or give way, or not assured of safety

synonym: uncertain, unsure, unconfident

an insecure future, (2) insecure attachment
 Children in an unstructured environment often feel insecure.

#### transport

- n. a system for moving people or products from one location to another using automobiles, roads, and so on synonym: shipment, transit, conveyance
- (1) **transport** facilities, (2) access to public **transport** Enhanced rail **transportation** is crucial for our business.

#### barrier

 a fence or other obstruction that makes it hard to move or get in; any condition that makes it difficult to make progress or to achieve an objective

synonym: border, barricade, fence

(1) cost barrier, (2) information barrierThe police placed a barrier across the street to halt traffic.

# obesity

n. the condition of being significantly overweight, typically defined as having a body mass index (BMI) of 30 or greater.

synonym: overweight, corpulence, fattiness

(1) **obesity-related** diseases, (2) suffer from **obesity** The prevalence of **obesity** has increased significantly in recent years.

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

*synonym*: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

#### upstream

adj. in the direction against a stream's current; (adverb) toward the source or beginning of a stream, river, or process

*synonym*: upriver, up-current

(1) swim upstream, (2) upstream direction

The company is investing heavily in **upstream** research and development.

# parable

 a short allegorical story designed to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson

synonym: allegory, fable, tale

(1) parable story, (2) biblical parable

Jesus quoted **parables** to teach important lessons to his disciples.

#### rescue

v. to save someone or something from a dangerous or difficult situation

synonym: save, extricate, retrieve

(1) **rescue** a dying dog, (2) **rescue** a company from bankruptcy

The fire department arrived just in time to **rescue** the family from the burning building.

#### drown

v. to die or cause to die by being unable to breathe underwater

synonym: douse, drench, overwhelm

(1) **drown** in a bath, (2) I was **drowned** in work Floods have the potential to **drown** any subsurface animals easily.

#### waterfall

 a point in a river or stream where water falls from a high place, for example, over a cliff or rock

synonym: cascade, falls, rapids

(1) scenic waterfall, (2) a waterfall with a fall of ten feet Years of river erosion have formed the uniquely shaped waterfall basin.

#### raft

 a flat structure, usually made of logs or planks, that can be used for transport or as a platform for swimmer

synonym: flatboat, boat, barge

(1) a raft for carrying horses, (2) a life raft

The rubber **raft** was swept out to sea.

#### usher

 a person who shows people to their seats in a theater or church or who guides them through a building synonym: guide, escort, conductor

(1) act as **usher**, (2) **usher** theater

The uniformed **usher** showed the guests to their seats.

#### coordinate

v. to bring the different parts of the activity and the people into an organized, ordered, or efficient relationship; (adjective) of equal importance, rank, or degree

synonym: organize, harmonize, ordinate

(1) **coordinate** a special project, (2) a **coordinate** clause We want to **coordinate** a schedule for the investigation.

#### branch

 a division of a tree or woody shrub that grows out from the trunk or a main stem; a division of some larger or more complex organization

synonym: limb, twig, bough

(1) branch office, (2) a branch pipe

The **branch** of the tree had fallen and blocked the road.

#### nowhere

adv. not in, at, or to any place; not anywhere

(1) **nowhere** else to go, (2) come out of **nowhere** I've been thinking all day and getting **nowhere**.

#### spot

- n. a particular location or place; a small round or roundish area, differing in color or feels from the surface around itsynonym: dot, mark, place
- (1) beauty **spot**, (2) a **spot** on his honor This remote **spot** is rarely visited.

#### trauma

 an emotional wound or shock often has long-lasting effects caused by a highly upsetting or shocking experience

synonym: agony, injury, ordeal

(1) psychic trauma, (2) trauma care

Many civilians have suffered trauma as a result of the war.

# surgeon

 a doctor who is trained to perform medical operations that involve cutting open a person's body synonym: sawbones, doctor

an excellent brain surgeon, (2) army surgeon
 a skilled surgeon that has many years of training and experience.

nurse

 a healthcare professional who is trained to provide care for the sick or injured; (verb) to try to cure by special care or treatment of an illness or injury

synonym: healthcare worker, caregiver, medic

(1) **nurse** practitioner, (2) a volunteer **nurse**The night shift **nurse** checked my vital signs before administering the medication.

dire

adj. extremely serious or urgent; critical, grave, or disastrous synonym: serious, critical, desperate

(1) suffer **dire** poverty, (2) **dire** situation

The **dire** economic straits called for immediate action.

strait

*n.* a narrow stretch of water or sea connecting two larger bodies of water or seas

synonym: narrows, channel, passage

(1) strait passage, (2) strait channel

The ship navigated through the **strait** with great care.

clinician

a practitioner, especially of medicine or psychology, who has direct contact with patients

*synonym*: psychiatrist, therapist, doctor

(1) experienced **clinician**, (2) from a **clinician's** perspective Some **clinicians** believe that psychological characteristics alone may cause mental disorders.

diabetes

- a medical condition in which the body cannot produce enough insulin to control the glucose levels in the blood
- juvenile diabetes,
   diabetes patient
   father was tested for diabetes.

# hypertension

 a medical condition characterized by abnormally high blood pressure in the arteries, often leading to an increased risk of heart disease, stroke, and other health problems

synonym: high blood pressure

(1) **hypertension** rate, (2) arterial **hypertension**To lower **hypertension**, it is important to maintain a healthy diet and exercise regularly.

# checkup

 an examination of a person's health by a medical professional, typically including a physical examination, laboratory tests, and diagnostic imaging

synonym: examination, diagnosis, consultation

(1) regular checkup,(2) health checkupI am going to the doctor for my annual checkup.

vaccine

 a substance that is put into the body and protects them from disease by causing them to produce antibodies (= proteins that attack harmful bacteria, viruses, etc.)

synonym: vaccinum

(1) development of **vaccines**, (2) an oral **vaccine**The mRNA **vaccine** was approved in less than a year because it did not contain the fragments of the target virus.

#### mobilize

v. to make something ready for action or use; to organize people or resources for a particular purpose

synonym: activate, rally, marshal

mobilize cooperation, (2) mobilize a stiff joint
 The military mobilized troops to the border.

obvious

*adj.* easy to see, discover or understand *synonym*: apparent, conspicuous, evident

(1) **obvious** reasons, (2) his conclusion was **obvious** There are **obvious** differences between the two wine-producing regions.

#### colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

(1) collaborate with colleagues,(2) former colleagueI decided to seek counseling on the advice of my colleague.

# procedure

 a way of doing something, especially the official or well-known way

synonym: action, approach, course

(1) undergo a surgical **procedure**, (2) standard **procedure**The pilot and flight attendant ran through the check-out **procedure**.

# argue

v. to express differing opinions or points of view, often in a heated or contentious manner; to present a case or reasoning to persuade or convince others

*synonym*: debate, dispute, quarrel

(1) argue a case, (2) argue passionately

The couple began to **argue** over which restaurant to go to for dinner.

# absolutely

*adv.* without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly *synonym*: completely, utterly, definitely

(1) **absolutely** against, (2) **absolutely** obsessed with the girl

I am **absolutely** opposed to his idea because of morality.

# genetic

adj. of or relating to genes (= parts of the DNA in cells) or the science of genes

synonym: hereditary, genetical, inborn

(1) have **genetic** testing, (2) a **genetic** disorder Understanding protein folding is a vital step in deciphering the

genetic code.

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the **structure** of a machine, (2) **structure** and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

environment affairs, (2) chaotic environment
 Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's environment.

#### fabric

 cloth or other material produced by weaving wool, cotton, silk, etc., used for making clothes, covering furniture, etc.

synonym: cloth, material, goods

(1) a hand-loomed **fabric**, (2) **fabric** of creation

These synthetic **fabrics** are used in military vests because of their excellent abrasion resistance.

weave

v. to make cloth, a carpet, a basket, etc., by repeatedly crossing a single thread through two sets of long threads at a right angle to them

synonym: braid, unite, contrive

(1) **weave** on a loom, (2) **weave** a story The girl **weaves** a garland for her friend.

#### administrator

 a person or organization responsible for managing and directing the affairs of a business, institution, government agency, or other organization; someone who administers, regulates, or supervises

synonym: manager, executive, supervisor

(1) school **administrator**, (2) network **administrator** The university's **administrator** announced new policies regarding campus safety.

#### combine
