nestle

- v. to settle comfortably or cozily into a place synonym: snuggle, cuddle, curl up
- (1) **nestle** deeper against him, (2) **nestle** in a cozy spot The cat **nestled** in my lap and fell asleep.

sew

v. to join, fasten, or repair two pieces of something by putting the thread through them with a needle

synonym: stitch, darn, tailor

(1) **sew** with thread, (2) **sew** a button

My mother taught me how to **sew**.

casualty

n. a person who has been killed or injured in a war, accident, or other disasters; a victim

synonym: victim, injured, fatality

(1) civilian casualty, (2) military casualty

Unfortunately, the driver was the only **casualty** in the car accident.

bisect

v. to divide or cut something into two equal parts, typically by a straight line or plane

synonym: split, divide, halve

(1) bisect a polygon, (2) bisect an angle

Using a ruler, she carefully **bisected** the line to find its midpoint.

slab

 a flat, rectangular piece of material, such as wood or concrete; often used to describe a large, heavy, or solid object or structure

synonym: slate, tile, paving stone

(1) a slab of chocolate, (2) marble slab

The construction workers poured a large **slab** of concrete for the foundation of the building.

untreated

adj. not given medical care or treatment; not subjected to chemical or physical treatment

synonym: raw, unprocessed, coarse

(1) an untreated disease, (2) dispose of untreated formalin

solution

Heat stroke is the result of **untreated** heat exhaustion.

desecrate

v. to treat a sacred or cherished object or place with disrespect or irreverence; to violate, damage, or defile something that is considered sacred or holy

synonym: violate, disrespect, profane

(1) **desecrate** a grave, (2) **desecrate** a holy site It is disrespectful to **desecrate** someone's place of worship or memorial.

divert

v. to change the course or direction of something, often away from a specific path or target; to entertain or amuse someone, often to distract them from a problem or concern; to appropriate something for a different purpose

synonym: distract, redirect, sidetrack

(1) **divert** attention, (2) **divert** an assault

Due to the road construction, we had to **divert** our course to get to the restaurant.

uncover

v. to remove the cover from something; to discover something previously unseen or hidden

synonym: disclose, reveal, unveil

(1) **uncover** a potential problem, (2) **uncover** the truth He continued his investigation and soon **uncovered** another crime.

sneaky

adj. behaving in a deceptive or underhanded way; characterized by stealth or secretiveness

synonym: sly, crafty, deceitful

The **sneaky** thief slipped into the house through an unlocked window.

riverbank

 the land along the edge of a river, often used for recreation or agricultural purposes synonym: riverside, embankment

plaza

a public square, marketplace, or similar open area in a town, especially in Spanish-speaking countries

synonym: park, square, center

Three young men were busking in the shopping **plaza**.

chaotic

adj. without any order or organization; extremely disorganized, unpredictable, and confusing

synonym: disorderly, cluttered, topsy-turvy

(1) the **chaotic** economic situation, (2) **chaotic** theory Change is also occurring in Turkey as a result of **chaotic** reform.

recycle

v. to sort and collect things to process them and produce valuable materials that can be used again

synonym: reclaim, reuse, reprocess

We largely **recycle** the circuit board of cell phones because they contain a lot of valuable metals.

authorship

synonym: writing, composing, penning

coalesce

sociopolitical

synonym: social, political, community-based

(1) sociopolitical issues, (2) sociopolitical unrest

The **sociopolitical** climate of the country has led to a rise in protests and demonstrations.

reimagine

v. to imagine or conceive of something in a new or different way

synonym: re-conceptualize, re-envision, re-create

(1) **reimagine** the future, (2) **reimagine** the possibilities The company is trying to **reimagine** its business model to stay competitive.

inhabitant
