### develop

### patient

 a person who is receiving medical treatment, care, or attention from a healthcare professional, such as a doctor, nurse, or therapist; a personal quality or characteristic

*synonym*: client, recipient, subject

(1) patient in the hospital, (2) patient with weight loss

The doctor carefully examined the **patient's** medical history.

### therapy

 the act of caring for someone through medication, remedial training, etc.

synonym: antidote, medicine, treatment

(1) therapy for a patient, (2) field of gene therapyI underwent aversion therapy for my addiction to alcohol.

#### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

(1) disease prevention, (2) disease control

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

#### untreated

 adj. not given medical care or treatment; not subjected to chemical or physical treatment

synonym: raw, unprocessed, coarse

(1) an **untreated** disease, (2) dispose of **untreated** formalin solution

Heat stroke is the result of **untreated** heat exhaustion.

### approve

v. to think that someone or something is favorable, acceptable, or appropriate; to officially accept a plan, request, etc.

synonym: accept, authorize, agree

(1) **approve** a measures, (2) unanimously **approve** a resolution

My boss wouldn't **approve** of the plan.

#### multitude

n. a large number of things or people

synonym: mass, assembly, hive

#### clinical

- adj. of or relating to the examination and treatment of patients rather than theoretical or laboratory studiessynonym: dispassionate, analytic, scientific
- (1) **clinical** surgery, (2) participate in **clinical** trials She received special **clinical** training at the hospital.

### predict

- to state beforehand that something will happen in the future, mainly based on knowledge or experience
   synonym: forecast, anticipate, foresee
- (1) **predict** the future, (2) **predict** when she will arrive It's notoriously challenging to **predict** birth rates.

### dispose

to put things or people in a particular manner or position;
 to incline someone towards a specific activity or mood;
 throw or cast away

synonym: get rid of, arrange, set

(1) **dispose** battleships for a battle, (2) **dispose** of a used product

Generally speaking, the child is innately **disposed** to learn a language.

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) **function** properly, (2) immune **function**The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

rip

- v. to tear something or be torn violently or suddenly synonym: tear, cut, slit
- (1) **rip** a notebook apart, (2) **rip** a hole in the roof During transit, the stuff may **rip** off the luggage tag.

#### native

adj. connecting with or describing someone's birth country or place of birth, or someone born in a specific country or place

synonym: endemic, domestic, aboriginal

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

### complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

*synonym*: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

### biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things

### dynamic

adj. having a lot of energy, ideas, and enthusiasm, and a strong personality; of or relating to dynamics (= the branch of physics and engineering concerned with the forces that cause motions of bodies)

synonym: energetic, active, vital

#### constant

*adj.* happening repeatedly or all the time *synonym*: ceaseless, stable, unchanging

#### mechanical

adj. operated by a machine, relating to or concerned with machinery or tools

synonym: machinelike, automated, automatic

(1) a mechanical style of writing, (2) the influence of mechanical action

#### architect

a person whose job is to design plans to be used in making something, such as buildings

synonym: creator, designer, planner

### engineer

a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining n. something such as machines, structures, or software

synonym: architect, creator, builder

#### institute

#### organ

a part of the body of an animal or plant that has a n. particular purpose and performs a specific job

#### organ system.

### chip

#### tremendous

adj. very great in degree or extent or amount or impact; extremely good

synonym: enormous, giant, immense

(1) **tremendous** amount, (2) **tremendous** popularity We had a **tremendous** time yesterday.

#### interact

- v. to communicate or react with somebodysynonym: cooperate, combine, collaborate
- (1) **interact** directly with customers, (2) **interact** with one another

lab

 a workplace for the conduct of scientific research; a laboratory

*synonym*: workshop, laboratory, research chamber

(1) lab instrument, (2) medical lab

The Prime Minister will pay a courtesy visit to the Nobel

#### laureate's lab.

#### recreate

v. to make something that existed previously happen or appear to exist again

synonym: renovate, vivify, revive

(1) **recreate** a single country, (2) **recreate** the feeling of the 1920s

She **recreated** the atmosphere of the pre-war age with her stage setting.

### **functional**

adj. designed for or capable of a particular activity, purpose, or task; practical or ready for use or service

synonym: applicable, practical, usable

(1) field of **functional** medicine, (2) **functional** deafness The mobile phone was still **functional** even after being dropped.

### represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

### biochemical

adj. relating to the chemical processes and substances that occur within living organisms

synonym: molecular, biological

(1) **biochemical** reaction, (2) complex **biochemical Biochemical** research is essential to understanding the complex chemical reactions in living organisms.

#### strain

 a force or pressure that stretches or pulls something, sometimes causing damage; (biology) a group of organisms within a species that differ in trivial ways from similar groups

synonym: pressure, tension, breed

(1) strain our eyes, (2) a strain of bacillus

Dictators of the past often had the erroneous idea of a pure racial **strain**.

### technique

n. a particular way or art of doing something that needs skill

*synonym*: approach, procedure, strategy

(1) a **technique** in martial arts, (2) the **technique** applied to construction

Jockey's superior **technique** brought him victory.

#### manufacture

v. to make goods in large numbers, usually in a factory using machines

synonym: create, fabricate, assemble

(1) **manufacture** an enzyme, (2) **manufacture** a product The majority of synthetic vitamins are **manufactured** from oil.

#### industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort synonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) **industrious** worker, (2) **industrious** student He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the **structure** of a machine, (2) **structure** and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

#### relevance

 the state or degree of being closely connected or appropriate to the matter at hand

synonym: pertinence, applicability, connection

(1) have no relevance, (2) relevance category

The **relevance** of this information to the current situation needs to be investigated.

#### fluid

- n. a substance that can flow and is not solid
- synonym: liquid, aqua, sap
- (1) plenty of fluids, (2) fluid assets

She was diagnosed with a **fluid** buildup in her lungs.

#### flexible

- adj. able to change or be changed to suit new conditions or situations; able to bend easily
- synonym: adaptable, elastic, pliable
- (1) flexible schedules, (2) a flexible wire

You can be more **flexible** and creative in your approach.

#### membrane

- n. a soft, thin layer that forms animal or vegetable tissue synonym: tissue layer
- (1) cell **membranes**, (2) nuclear **membrane**

Loud noises might harm the fragile ear **membrane**.

#### underneath

- adv. under or below something else
- synonym: below, under, beneath
- (1) **underneath** the surface of the water, (2) **underneath** the laughter

The penny fell **underneath** the piano.

### capillary

- a tube of small internal diameter; any of the minute tubes that carry blood
- (1) a capillary tube, (2) capillary action

There are many capillary vessels in the gills of fish.

#### vessel

- n. a ship or large boat
- synonym: boat, ship, craft
- (1) blood **vessels**, (2) naval **vessels**

The **vessel** arrived in port the following day.

#### stretch

v. to make or be capable of making anything longer or broader without hurting or breaking

*synonym*: lengthen, prolong, extend

(1) **stretch** along the coast, (2) **stretch** a story

Some herds have been observed to **stretch** hundreds of kilometers.

#### contract

 a legally binding agreement between two or more parties, setting out their rights and obligations to each other, typically in writing and enforceable by law

synonym: agreement, deal, arrangement

The company signed a **contract** with the supplier for the delivery of goods.

### liquid

 a substance, such as water or oil that flows freely and is neither a solid nor a gas

synonym: fluid

#### nutrient

 any substance that is essential for the maintenance and growth of living things

synonym: food, vitamin

(1) **nutrient** medicine, (2) a **nutrient** for hair

They used fast-acting **nutrients** on the flowers in the flower beds.

#### mimic

v. to imitate someone's speech, movement, or behavior, especially to make others laugh

synonym: mirror, imitate, ape

(1) **mimic** a human voice, (2) **mimic** numerous instruments He is very popular at school because he can **mimic** all the teachers' accents.

#### infection

 a condition in which pathogenic microorganisms or viruses have entered the body synonym: contagion, disease, transmission

(1) a bacterial **infection**, (2) treat the **infection** with antibiotics

Hospitals must meet various standards to prevent nosocomial **infections**.

#### bacteria

n. single-celled or noncellular spherical or spiral or rod-shaped organisms that exist in large numbers in the air, water, and soil, and also in living and dead creatures and plants, and are often a cause of disease

synonym: microorganism, microbe

(1) pathogenic **bacteria**, (2) harmless **bacteria Bacteria** prevalent in hospitals are often resistant to antibiotics.

defend

 to protect someone or something from attack, criticism, danger, etc.

synonym: protect, guard, support

(1) **defend** my country, (2) **defend** against a threat International law allows each nation to **defend** itself when its rights and interests are illegally violated.

invade

v. to enter aggressively into another's territory by military force for conquest and occupation

synonym: intrude, raid, overrun

(1) **invade** other tissues, (2) **invade** his privacy. I have no intention to **invade** your privacy.

#### inflammation

 a physical condition in which a part of the body becomes red, painful, hot, and often swollen, especially as a reaction to infection or injury

synonym: rash, hives, irritation

(1) reduce **inflammation** and pain, (2) **inflammation** of the lungs

The medicine soothes the pain of chronic **inflammation**.

### engulf

- v. to swallow up; to surround and cover completely synonym: swallow, submerge, inundate
- (1) **engulf** the politician, (2) **engulf** in water The fire quickly **engulfed** the entire building.

#### label

 a small piece of paper, fabric, or other material attached to an object and giving information about it; (verb) to assign to a category

synonym: tag, mark, identifier

- (1) a mailing **label**, (2) **label** a bag with my name The **label** on the food package lists the ingredients and nutritional information.
- v. to find or recognize something, especially something difficult to see, hear, etc.

synonym: catch, observe, notice

(1) **detect** a bad event, (2) **detect** smuggling across borders. The security camera has **detected** four intruders.

#### stick

detect

v. to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

synonym: pierce, adhere, stay

(1) stick a key in a lock, (2) fire stick

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

#### visualize

v. to form a mental image or concept of something; to make something visible

synonym: imagine, picture, envision

(1) **visualize** data, (2) **visualize** flying through space She tried to **visualize** the layout of the new house in her mind.

### wiggle

v. to move or cause to move up and down or from side to side in short and quick movements

synonym: wiggle, jiggle, squirm

(1) **wiggle** her lips, (2) **wiggle** with excitement

Her hips wiggle as she walks.

wit

 the ability to say or write things or ideas in a clever and humorous way

synonym: humor, comedy, funniness

(1) the wit of man, (2) full of wit

He has the wit to keep talking about this topic.

#### **fundamental**

adj. forming an essential base or core from which everything else develops or is affected

synonym: basic, essential, entire

(1) fundamental education, (2) fundamental rights

Human behavior has fundamental characteristics.

#### immune

adj. protected against a particular disease or toxin due to the presence of specific antibodies or sensitized white blood cells

synonym: resistant, unsusceptible, unaffected

(1) **immune** from criminal prosecution, (2) the cell of the **immune** system

The vaccination does not necessarily make you completely **immune**.

#### exciting

*adj.* causing a lot of interest or excitement *synonym*: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

(1) **exciting** football player, (2) **exciting** news

The findings of the experiment were both **exciting** and unexpected.

#### enormous

adj. extremely large or great synonym: huge, giant, gigantic

(1) **enormous** amount, (2) **enormous** potential Shakespeare's output of poetry was **enormous**.

#### airway

n. the air passage from the nose and throat to the lungs; a designated route followed by airplanes flying from one airport to another

synonym: air passage, air duct, skyway

(1) airway blockage, (2) airway beacon

When performing lifesaving, the first step is to secure the airway.

#### cilium

 a microscopic, hair-like cellular projection that is found on the surface of many cells in the body, helping them to move or trap debris

synonym: eyelash, flagellum

(1) cilium movement, (2) primary cilium

The microscopic analysis revealed a **cilium's** presence on the single-celled organism's surface.

#### mucus

 a slimy liquid produced inside the nose and other body parts for lubrication, protection, etc.

synonym: secretion, slime, saliva

(1) airway mucus, (2) nasal mucus

When the body temperature drops, mucus secretion fails.

### trap

 a piece of equipment or hole for catching animals or people; (verb) to catch animals or people and prevent them from escaping

synonym: catch, snare, pinfall

(1) set a trap, (2) trap an animal

The enemy fell right into the trap.

### particulate

adj. consisting of small particles, especially those that are suspended in a fluid or air

synonym: granular, dusty

(1) particulate size, (2) particulate pollution

Smoke from forest fires is causing an increase in **particulate** matter in the air.

matter i

#### virus

 a tiny infectious organic material that causes disease in people, animals, and plants

synonym: bacterium, germ, ailment

(1) spread of the virus, (2) a strain of virus

An infected person in the hospital will likely pass the **virus** to others.

### allergen

 a substance, such as pollen, dust mites, certain foods, or pet dander that can trigger an allergic reaction in susceptible individuals

synonym: irritant, trigger, substance

(1) airborne allergen, (2) seasonal allergen

Pollen is a common **allergen** that triggers hay fever in many people.

#### dam

 a wall constructed over a river to block the flow of water, mainly used to generate energy

synonym: barricade, barrier, embankment

(1) dam-building program, (2) dam collapsing

The break in the **dam** threatened the valley.

### cigarette

 a small cylindrical roll of finely cut tobacco leaves wrapped in paper for smoking

synonym: smoke, cigar, tobacco

(1) a mild cigarette, (2) a cigarette case

He lit a cigarette and leaned against the wall.

#### prop

n. a piece of wood, metal, etc., placed beneath or against something to support it or keep it in position; a system, institution, or person that gives help or support to someone or something

synonym: support, buttress, column

(1) emotional **prop**, (2) **prop** stick

We have finally lost our last **prop**.

#### bronchitis

n. an inflammation of the bronchial tubes, often resulting in cough, chest discomfort, and difficulty breathing, can be

caused by viral or bacterial infections, environmental irritants, or other factors

synonym: chest cold, respiratory infection, bronchial inflammation

(1) viral bronchitis, (2) chronic bronchitis

I have a terrible case of **bronchitis** and need to see a doctor.

#### involve

v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

synonym: implicate, include, engage

(1) **involve** a lot of paperwork, (2) **involve** a high degree of risk

The investigation **involves** several government agencies and is expected to take several months.

cyst

 a sac, cavity, or abnormal growth in the body that is typically filled with fluid or semisolid material; usually benign but can also be cancerous and require treatment

synonym: abscess, sac, lump

(1) cyst removal, (2) ovarian cyst

The patient was sent for an X-ray to determine the cause of the **cyst** in her abdomen.

**fibrosis** 

n. the formation of excess fibrous connective tissue in an organ or tissue, often associated with inflammation, scarring, or injury; a pathological condition that can affect various organs and tissues of the body, leading to impaired function and potential organ failure

synonym: scarring, hardening, fibrotic disease

fibrosis diagnosis, (2) pulmonary fibrosis
 The doctor diagnosed him with cardiac fibrosis, which put

gut

n. the long tube in the body of a person or animal through which food passes when it leaves the stomach; the mental strength or bravery required to do something difficult or unpleasant

synonym: belly, abdomen, courage

him at risk for heart failure.

### (1) the blind **gut**, (2) **gut** feelings

He told me a **gut-wrenching** truth about my parent's death.

#### intestinal

adj. relating to the intestines (= the part of the alimentary canal between the stomach and the anus) or bowel; located or occurring within the intestines or bowel

synonym: enteric, gut, digestive

(1) intestinal blockage, (2) intestinal bacteria

The patient experienced severe abdominal pain due to an **intestinal** infection.

### peristaltic

adj. relating to the rhythmic contraction and relaxation of muscles that create wave-like movements, particularly referring to the action of peristalsis, which is the movement of food through the digestive tract

synonym: contractile, rhythmic, pulsating

(1) **peristaltic** contractions, (2) **peristaltic** pump The intestines' **peristaltic** movement helps propel food through the digestive system.

#### trickle

 to flow or drip slowly and in small amounts; to happen or occur gradually or in small quantities

synonym: dribble, flow, seep

(1) **trickle** down my cheek, (2) **trickle** from his eyes Water was beginning to **trickle** into the basement after the heavy rain.

intestine

 a long, tube-like organ in the digestive system that is responsible for absorbing nutrients from food and eliminating waste products

synonym: gut, bowel, tract

(1) large intestine, (2) intestine wall

The small **intestine** is responsible for absorbing most of the nutrients from food.

#### irritable

adj. easily or frequently agitated, annoyed, or angered; prone to becoming tense or angry in response to minor

#### stimuli or events

*synonym*: cranky, grumpy, touchy

(1) irritable bowel syndrome, (2) irritable mood

Lack of sleep can make me **irritable** and easily annoyed.

#### bowel

the part of the alimentary canal below the stomach; the intestine, especially the lower intestine

synonym: intestine, gut, stomach

(1) **bowel** ailment, (2) whole-**bowel** irrigation

He had surgery to remove a portion of his small **bowel**.

### syndrome

- a group of signs and symptoms that occur together and are characteristic of a particular condition or disorder
- synonym: disorder, condition, complication
- (1) **syndrome** of dementia, (2) acute **syndrome**The patient was diagnosed with a rare genetic **syndrome**.

#### individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private individual, (2) individual freedom

As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

### debilitating

adj. weakening or damaging; causing a loss of strength, energy, or success

*synonym*: weakening, exhausting

(1) debilitating virus, (2) debilitating effect

His **debilitating** illness made it difficult for him to leave the house.

### pipeline

 a very long large tube that is usually underground and is used for carrying liquid or gas for long distances

synonym: channel, line

(1) a data **pipeline**, (2) **pipeline** facilities

Rebels sabotaged the main **pipeline** supplying oil.

#### interconnect

v. to connect similar things

*synonym*: interlink, complect, annex

(1) directly **interconnect** with those systems, (2) human activities **interconnect** with the environment

Our system can now **interconnect** with other databases.

#### virtual

adj. being actually such in almost every respect; existing in essence or effect though not in actual fact

synonym: practical

(1) a **virtual** image, (2) trading of **virtual** currencies She is the **virtual** president of the company.

#### excite

v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager

synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate

(1) excite the crowd, (2) excite rebellion

The news of her promotion **excited** her.

### sufficient

adj. adequate; enough for a particular purpose or requirement

synonym: acceptable, ample, satisfactory

(1) sufficient time, (2) self-sufficient economy

That candidate does not have **sufficient** means to win an election with certainty.

### prediction

*n*. the act of predicting the future by reasoning; a statement made about the future

synonym: forecast, anticipation, foretelling

make my predictions, (2) gloomy predictions
 These results muddled the prediction.

#### aerosol

 a substance enclosed under pressure and released as a fine spray, typically one used for medical purposes or cosmetic application

synonym: spray, mist, fog

(1) aerosol container, (2) aerosol can

She waited a few seconds after spraying the aerosol

#### asthma

- n. a chronic respiratory disease characterized by wheezing, coughing, and difficulty breathingsynonym: bronchial, bronchitis, respiratory ailment
- asthma attack, (2) asthma symptoms

#### inhale

- v. to breathe in air or a different substance, such as smoke synonym: breathe in, take in, draw in

#### doe

 a mature female of mammals of which the male is called a buck, such as a deer or a rabbit

synonym: rabbit, bunny, hare

#### toxic

- *adj.* of or relating to or caused by a poison; poisonous *synonym*: poisonous, harmful, contaminated

  This chemical compound is a thousand-fold more **toxic**.

### liver

- a large organ in the body, involved in many metabolic processes, such as detoxification of the organism, and the synthesis of proteins
- (1) liver disease, (2) fatty liver

The patient will undergo **liver** transplant surgery tomorrow.

#### metabolism

- the set of chemical reactions in cells or organisms that are necessary for life-sustaining
