#### reindeer

 a large deer with branched antlers found in northern regions, often domesticated and used for transportation or as a source of food

synonym: caribou, elk, deer

#### mundane

### quaternion

 a mathematical concept consisting of a set of four numbers or quantities used to represent rotation or orientation in three-dimensional space, often used in computer graphics, robotics, and physics

synonym: quad, four, tetrad

(1) **quaternion** rotation, (2) **quaternion** algebra When working in computer graphics, using a **quaternion** representation can help prevent gimbal lock, a problem faced with Euler angles.

### displace

synonym: evict, exile, remove
