## odd

## mathematics

 the science dealing with the logic of quantities, shapes, spaces, and arrangement

synonym: arithmetic, calculation, calculus

He has a flair for mathematics.

#### molest

v. to harass, bother, or annoy someone, often sexually; to touch or handle someone in an unwelcome or inappropriate way

synonym: harass, harm, abuse

The organization campaigns for stricter penalties for those who **molest** children.

#### circulate

v. to move continuously or freely around a place or closed system

synonym: flow, disperse, rotate

The fan **circulates** the air in the room quickly.

## aggressive

 adj. behaving in an angry, energetic, or threatening way towards another person; tending to spread quickly

synonym: assertive, combative, threatening

(1) an **aggressive** war, (2) an **aggressive** tumor An **aggressive** tide wrecked the ship.

#### forceful

adj. having or showing great strength or energy

synonym: powerful, strong, energetic

(1) forceful argument, (2) take forceful action

She spoke with a **forceful** tone and made her point clear.

#### abusive

adj. involving or characterized by harmful or offensive treatment, language, or behavior; using physical, emotional, or verbal force to control or harm someone else

synonym: cruel, oppressive, hurtful

(1) abusive behavior, (2) abusive parent

The teacher's **abusive** language towards the students was unacceptable.

## pants

 an item of clothing that covers the lower part of the body and each leg separately, typically with a waistband and two legs

*synonym*: trousers, breeches, slacks

(1) woolly pants, (2) pajama pants

I always wear **pants** when I go outside, even in the summer.

#### masturbation

 the act of sexually stimulating oneself by touching or rubbing one's genitals, typically resulting in orgasm or sexual release

synonym: onanism

(1) manual **masturbation**, (2) the act of **masturbation**Many physicians agree that the practice of **masturbation** is a natural and healthy way to explore and take pleasure in one's body.

## motorcycle

 a two-wheeled vehicle that is driven by an engine and has no pedals

*synonym*: bike, motor

(1) motorcycle gangster, (2) electric motorcycleHe had his motorcycle license revoked for drunken driving.

recover

- v. to return to a former condition, health, mind, or strength synonym: come back, convalesce, heal
- (1) **recover** a loss, (2) **recover** approval ratings She is still **recovering** from a shot to her shoulder.

#### trauma

 an emotional wound or shock often has long-lasting effects caused by a highly upsetting or shocking experience

synonym: agony, injury, ordeal

(1) psychic **trauma**, (2) **trauma** care Many civilians have suffered **trauma** as a result of the war.

## injury

 n. harm done to a person's or an animal's body caused by an accident or an attack

synonym: wound, damage, hurt

(1) without injury, (2) a fatal injury

My accidental injury got better right away.

# colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

(1) collaborate with colleagues,(2) former colleagueI decided to seek counseling on the advice of my colleague.

#### seldom

adv. not often; rarely

synonym: rarely, hardly, infrequently

(1) **seldom** try to walk, (2) **seldom** fluctuate
He **seldom** went out to socialize, preferring to spend evenings at home.

#### encounter

v. to face something, particularly something unpleasant or difficult, while attempting to do something else; to meet, especially unexpectedly

synonym: meet, run into, come across

(1) **encounter** a crisis, (2) **encounter** a storm I'm prepared to **encounter** challenges throughout this adventure.

#### chill

 a feeling of coldness that makes one shiver; (verb) to make cool or cooler

synonym: coldness, coolness, (verb) freeze

(1) the **chill** of autumn, (2) feel a slight **chill** His swear words cast a **chill** on the party.

rap

 a type of music characterized by a strong, repetitive beat and lyrics that often focus on social and political issues; a reproach for some lapse or misdeed

synonym: hip-hop, emceeing, MCing

(1) rap music, (2) get a rap

The new **rap** album is getting a lot of attention.

#### penetrate

v. to pass into or through something, often by overcoming resistance

synonym: pierce, stab, go through

(1) **penetrate** a cell, (2) **penetrate** quickly into the skin Western ideology slowly **penetrates** through the eastern

countries.

#### blunt

adj. having a dull or rounded edge or point; not sharp;straightforward in speech or manner, often to the point of being rude or insensitive

synonym: dull, obtuse, insensitive

(1) blunt criticism, (2) blunt force

The **blunt** knife made it difficult to cut through the tough steak.

rod

 a long, thin, straight piece of wood, metal, or other material used for support, as a weapon, or for punishment

synonym: stick, wand, staff

He used a fishing **rod** to catch the biggest fish of the day.

gag

v. to prevent or restrict speech or expression, often through force or intimidation; to bind or cover the mouth to prevent speech; to cause someone to retch or choke; (noun) a device that is placed over someone's mouth to prevent them from speaking or making noise; an order that prohibits a person or group from discussing a particular topic or sharing certain information with others

*synonym*: muzzle, silence, suppress

#### unconscious

adj. in the state of lacking awareness and the capacity for sensory perception, especially as the result of a head injury or illness

synonym: comatose, paralyzed, senseless

(1) **unconscious** bias, (2) a person who is **unconscious** I know his **unconscious** habit that he touches his face when he lies.

## plunge

v. to dive quickly and steeply downward; to thrust or throw into something; (noun) a steep and rapid fall

*synonym*: dive, drop, thrust

(1) **plunge** into the water, (2) **plunge** a dagger through his heart

The company's profits **plunged** after the recall of their new product.

## horrific

adj. causing horror or disgust; gruesome and terrifyingsynonym: terrifying, alarming, shocking

## absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterlysynonym: completely, utterly, definitely

## terrify

- v. to frighten someone very much synonym: unnerve, scare, horrify
- (1) **terrify** people, (2) the threats **terrify** him It would be best not to **terrify** your associates into doing complex tasks.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

#### frustrate

v. to hinder or prevent efforts, plans, or desires from doing, succeeding, or being fulfilled; to make someone feel

upset or annoyed because they are unable to change or achieve something

synonym: hinder, thwart, dishearten

(1) **frustrate** the advancement, (2) **frustrate** other team members

The coach explained a strategy to **frustrate** the opponent's schemes to the players.

## utterly

adv. completely or absolutely

synonym: absolutely, completely, perfectly

(1) utterly changed, (2) utterly ignorant

We are **utterly** opposed to any form of terrorism.

## helpless

adj. unable to take care of oneself or to do things without help

synonym: defenseless, powerless, susceptible

(1) helpless baby, (2) helpless victims

I feel so helpless without you.

## ignore

 $\nu$ . to intentionally not listen or pay attention to

synonym: neglect, disregard, shun

(1) **ignore** her advice, (2) **ignore** a ban

Since independence, the area has been completely **ignored**.

## protest

a strong expression of disagreement, disapproval, or opposition

synonym: objection, disapproval, challenge

(1) hold a **protest**, (2) a silent **protest** 

He left the party in **protest** at its radical political stance.

## repress

v. to restrain or control by force; to suppress feelings or memories

synonym: suppress, control, curb

(1) cannot **repress** laughter, (2) **repress** gene expression He **repressed** the memories of his traumatic childhood.

#### alien

 a person who comes from a different country, race, or group; a form of life assumed to exist outside the Earth or its atmosphere

synonym: foreigner, unfamiliar, unknown

(1) alien fungi, (2) resident aliens

**Alien** species have drastically altered the ecosystem in this area.

#### unthinkable

adj. too unlikely or shocking to imagine or acceptsynonym: impossible, inconceivable, outlandish

(1) an **unthinkable** coincidence, (2) in **unthinkable** trouble That accident was something **unthinkable** with my long experience.

## politician

 a person who is a member of a government or law-making organization, especially as an elected member of parliament, etc.

synonym: congressperson, lawmaker, legislator

(1) a **politician** in the ruling party, (2) a corrupt **politician**The **politician** lost his position in the end due to the scandal.

## responsible

adj. answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management

synonym: accountable, answerable, liable

She's a **responsible** pet owner who ensures her dog gets enough exercise and a healthy diet.

## insensitive

adj. not showing or feeling concern for the needs and feelings of others

synonym: unfeeling, unaware, indifferent

## prominent

*adj.* important, well-known, or noticeable *synonym*: notable, distinguished, prominent

The media frequently interviewed **prominent** scientists.

## violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

*synonym*: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

## parliament

*n*. a legislative body, especially the one that represents the people of a country or state

synonym: congress, assembly, legislature

(1) disband **parliament**, (2) event of a hung **parliament**. He was a member of **parliament**.

## spiritual

adj. relating to or affecting the human spirit or soul as opposed to material or physical things

synonym: otherworldly, ethereal, transcendental

(1) constant **spiritual** striving, (2) **spiritual** leader

The meditation class was focused on finding inner peace and cultivating a more **spiritual** connection with the universe.

#### defendant

 a person or party who is accused of a crime or who is being sued in a court of law

synonym: accused, prisoner, litigant

(1) **defendant** in court, (2) the **defendant's** testimony The **defendant's** lawyer argued that his client was not responsible for the crime.

## gender

n. the range of characteristics of femininity and masculinity and differentiating between them, especially when considering social and cultural differences rather than differences in biology

synonym: sexuality

(1) gender-blind policies, (2) dual genderCultural norms strongly influence gender expectations.

#### extensive

adj. covering a large area; having a wide range synonym: ample, comprehensive, vast

(1) **extensive** experience, (2) have **extensive** vocabulary The incident attracted **extensive** media coverage throughout the world.

## decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering optionssynonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

## spontaneous

- adj. happening or being done naturally, often unexpected way, without being made to happensynonym: willing, impulsive, intuitive

## hasty

adj. done or acting with excessive speed or urgency and without sufficient thought or consideration

synonym: rushed, impulsive, prompt

## journalism

 the profession or activity of writing or reporting news for publication or broadcast

synonym: reporting, news media, writing

(1) **journalism** ethics, (2) tabloid **journalism**She plans to study **journalism** in college and become a reporter.

## platform

n. the raised flat space close to the track at a train station where passengers get on or off the train; (technology) a computational or digital environment in which a piece of software is executed

synonym: stage, podium, forum

(1) an arrival **platform**, (2) a digital **platform** for enterprise The speaker mounted the **platform** and started to speak.

### frustration

- n. the feeling of being upset or annoyed as a result of being unable to change or achieve something
- synonym: disappointment, discouragement, dissatisfaction

#### trail

 a path or track roughly through a countryside, mountain, or forest area, often made or used for a particular purpose; (verb) to lag or linger behind

synonym: footpath, track, course

The storm left a **trail** of destruction behind it.

#### mainstream

 the ideas, opinions, beliefs, etc., that are considered normal or accepted by most people

synonym: prevailing, average, common

(1) join the **mainstream**, (2) **mainstream** political beliefs His thinking is **mainstream** in the country's culture.

#### invite

v. to ask someone to come or join; to offer an opportunity or possibility for something to happen or take place

synonym: ask, request, summon

#### release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge
- (1) **release** a prisoner, (2) **release** CO2 into the air

#### emotion

- n. a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from one's situation, mood, or relationships with otherssynonym: feeling, sentiment, passion

#### attend

- v. to be present at an event, to go to a place synonym: go, be present, accompany

## march

- v. to walk militarily with stiff, regular steps synonym: parade
- (1) **march** against the war, (2) **march** east The troops **marched** shoulder-to-shoulder.

## candlelight

- n. light provided by a candle or candlessynonym: lamp light, oil light, firelight
- (1) **candlelight** dinner, (2) **candlelight** vigil The room was dimly lit by soft **candlelight**.

## vigil

 a period of wakefulness maintained for any reason, typically for prayer, meditation, or watchkeeping; a period of observation or surveillance, especially for security or safety reasons

synonym: watch, observance, monitoring

(1) **vigil** for peace, (2) night **vigil**The mother kept a **vigil** by her sick child's bedside all night.

#### cousin

n. the child of your aunt or uncle

*synonym*: relative

(1) cross- cousin marriage, (2) cousin's family

I used to play with my younger male **cousins** when I was a little girl.

## complain

 to say dissatisfaction or annoyance about something or somebody

synonym: gripe, claim, denounce

(1) **complain** about a job, (2) call and **complain** frequently Our users are often **complaining** about the slow application.

## difficulty

- n. a condition or state that causes problemssynonym: hardship, complication, problem
- (1) the degree of **difficulty**, (2) **difficulty** in breathing He has **difficulty** exercising because of a back injury sustained in an accident.

#### reaction

 a response that reveals a person's feelings or attitude;
 (in chemistry) a process in which one or more substances are changed into others

*synonym*: response, reply, answer

(1) chemical **reaction**, (2) trigger a **reaction**There was a chemical **reaction** of the lime with the groundwater.

#### confuse

v. to mistake one thing for another; to make somebody hard to understand

synonym: confound, obscure, disorient

(1) **confuse** the listener, (2) **confuse** fantasy with reality Her remarks **confused** the debate.

#### vicious

adj. having or showing a desire to cause harm to others;having the nature of vice

synonym: malicious, spiteful, malevolent

(1) **vicious** attack, (2) **vicious** deflationary spiral
The **vicious** dog barked and growled at anyone who came near its territory.

## hypocrite

 a person who claims to have certain beliefs or values but acts in a way that contradicts those beliefs or values; a person who pretends to be virtuous or moral but behaves in an unethical or deceitful way

synonym: pretender, two-faced, insincere

- (1) environmental **hypocrite**, (2) religious **hypocrite**She accused her boss of being a **hypocrite** for advocating for workers' rights while mistreating his employees.
- a person who has been harmed, injured, or otherwise negatively affected by a particular action, circumstance, or event

synonym: prey, target, sufferer

(1) **victim** support, (2) **victim** compensation

The **victim** of the crime deserves justice and support to recover from the trauma.

## apologist

victim

 a person who offers a defense or justification of a particular belief, idea, or action; someone who defends or supports a cause or person, often in the face of criticism or opposition

synonym: defender, supporter, advocate

- (1) conservative **apologist**, (2) religious **apologist**Some people see him as an **apologist** for authoritarian regimes.
- the reason or incentive that drives a person to act in a certain way

synonym: reason, incentive, drive

murder motive, (2) an unworthy motive
 The detective tried to uncover the motive behind the crime.

# discuss v. to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

synonym: talk about, converse, debate

(1) discuss options, (2) discuss solutions

# motive

We need to **discuss** the next steps for the project during our meeting tomorrow.

## liberty

 the state of being free within society from oppressive restrictions imposed by authority on one's way of life, behavior, or political views

synonym: freedom, autonomy, independence

(1) personal liberty, (2) liberty as a right

The founding fathers fought for the **liberty** of the American people.

## unfamiliar

adj. not known or recognized; not experienced or encountered before

synonym: unknown, strange, foreign

(1) the **unfamiliar** surroundings, (2) around **unfamiliar** people

She was **unfamiliar** with the city and got lost while trying to find her way back to the hotel.

## upload

 to transfer digital data or files from a local computer or device to a remote server or network; the act of transferring such data or files

synonym: transfer, load up

(1) upload files, (2) upload documents to the portalI need to upload these pictures to my computer to edit them.

#### recount

- v. to describe what happened or to narrate a story synonym: narrate, tell, report
- (1) **recount** the adventure, (2) **recount** a conversation with him

They **recount** events that have already occurred.

## firsthand

adv. from the source; directly; (adjective) received directly from a source

synonym: direct

(1) hear customer's voices firsthand, (2) conduct firsthand

#### research

The manager tried to hear customers' voices firsthand.

#### harassment

n. the act of repeatedly annoying, tormenting, or persecuting someone in a way that is threatening or unwelcome, often relating to issues of race, gender, or other identities

synonym: bullying, persecution, intimidation

(1) sexual **harassment**, (2) emotional **harassment**The company has a zero-tolerance policy for **harassment** in the workplace.

entitle

v. to give someone the right to have or do something; to give a title to someone or something

synonym: allow, permit, enable

(1) **entitle** him to a pension, (2) **entitle** the company to use the logo

The employee was **entitled** to a week of vacation time.

gaze

v. to stare at something or someone for an extended time, usually out of surprise or adoration, or because you are thinking about something else

synonym: stare, gawk, look

(1) **gaze** steadily at his face, (2) **gaze** absently out a window The youngster was **gazed** at by the beast.

slice

 a flat, often thin, piece of bread, meat, cheese, etc., that has been cut from a larger piece; a wound made by cutting

synonym: piece, portion, slit

(1) a **slice** of the company's revenue, (2) **slice** a tomato thin The children complained because one **slice** of cake was slightly larger than the other.

#### heaven

 n. (of various religious and mythological traditions) a place or state of existence considered to be the abode of the divine, the afterlife, or a higher realm of being; a state of great happiness, contentment, or beauty

synonym: paradise, nirvana, utopia

(1) ascend to **heaven**, (2) **heaven** on earth

He felt like **heaven** when he tasted the delicious chocolate

cake.

the place thought to be where bad people go and are punished after death, often depicted as being located beneath the earth; an extraordinarily unpleasant or difficult place

*synonym*: inferno, agony, misery

(1) run like **hell**, (2) **hell** broke loose

The battlefield became hell on earth.

stalk

hell

to follow or track someone or something closely and quietly, usually to cause harm or surveillance; to move slowly and quietly to avoid detection; (noun) the main stem of a plant that supports leaves, flowers, and fruit; the stem or main axis of a support structure or framework

synonym: follow, creep up on, (noun) stem

(1) **stalk** of celery, (2) **stalk** from the room

The hunter quietly **stalked** the deer for hours before taking the shot

grope

to feel one's way by touching, typically because one cannot see

synonym: fumble, feel, pat

(1) **grope** after the truth, (2) **grope** for an answer He was forced to **grope** in the dark for the light switch.

viral

- adj. relating to or caused by a virus
- (1) fight viral infections, (2) detect a viral code This device can more accurately detect **viral** pathogens.
- the ability to say or write things or ideas in a clever and n. humorous way

wit

synonym: humor, comedy, funniness

(1) the wit of man, (2) full of wit

He has the wit to keep talking about this topic.

#### outburst

 a sudden, violent, and uncontrolled expression of emotion, usually anger or excitement; a sudden release of energy or feeling

synonym: outcry, eruption, explosion

(1) outburst of applause, (2) violent outburst

My boss's sudden **outburst** shocked and scared me.

#### outcome

n. the result or effect of an action, event, etc.

synonym: result, consequence, effect

(1) improved student **outcomes**, (2) a desirable **outcome** They awaited news of the **outcome** of the election.

#### whatsoever

adv. not at all; no matter what

synonym: in any way, at all, in any respect

(1) **whatsoever** it be, (2) without impact **whatsoever** He refused to do anything **whatsoever** to help her.

## doubt

*n*. a feeling of being uncertain about something, especially about how good or accurate it is

synonym: distrust, suspect, mistrust

(1) dispel **doubts**, (2) no **doubt** about the news **Doubt** is the start, not the end, of intelligence.

#### observer

 a person who watches or notices someone or something but has no active part in it

synonym: spectator, onlooker, watcher

(1) a shrewd **observer**, (2) an **observer** in the region According to the theory of relativity, time is different for each **observer**.

#### embarrass

v. to cause someone to feel awkward, worried, or ashamed synonym: disconcert, unsettle, agitate

(1) **embarrass** political enemy, (2) **embarrass** my project He looked for an opportunity to **embarrass** that actor in public.

#### disbelief

 the feeling of not being able to believe or accept that something is true or real

synonym: doubt, mistrust, incredulity

(1) **disbelief** in the authority, (2) ask in **disbelief** His reaction was one of complete **disbelief**.

### defend

v. to protect someone or something from attack, criticism, danger, etc.

synonym: protect, guard, support

(1) **defend** my country, (2) **defend** against a threat International law allows each nation to **defend** itself when its rights and interests are illegally violated.

## journalist

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

synonym: reporter, newsperson, press

(1) a China-based **journalist**, (2) **journalist** on a magazine Foreign TV crews and **journalists** can go as they please in various locations during the Olympics.

## suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

(1) **suddenly** attacked by an enemy, (2) die **suddenly** Who answers **suddenly** knows little.

#### vulnerable

adj. capable of being hurt or influenced physically or mentally

synonym: susceptible, exposed, weak

(1) a **vulnerable** bridge, (2) **vulnerable** parts of the body Infants and pregnant women are particularly **vulnerable**.

#### unsettle

to make somebody feel anxious or upset, especially because of an unstable or problematic situation

synonym: aggravate, annoy, disturb

(1) **unsettle** the nervous system, (2) **unsettle** his conviction This nationwide strike may **unsettle** the country's economy.

## permission

consent or authorization given by someone in authority or by the owner of something, allowing someone to do something or allowing something to occur

synonym: approval, consent, authorization

(1) grant **permission**, (2) **permission** for permanent residence

I asked my boss for **permission** to leave early for a doctor's appointment.

## independence

- freedom from another's or others' control or influence *synonym*: freedom, liberty, autonomy
- (1) financial **independence**, (2) **independence** ceremony There is nothing more valuable than independence and freedom.

## environment

the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

(1) environment affairs, (2) chaotic environment Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's environment.

## judge

a person who makes decisions in a court of law; (verb) to determine the result of or form a critical opinion of something

synonym: arbiter, justice, (verb) deduce

- (1) judge a competition, (2) an associate judge The strict **judge** ruled in favor of the plaintiff in the case.
