boredom

a state of weariness, restlessness, or impatience that arises from not being interested or engaged in an activity, task, or situation

synonym: ennui, tedium, monotony

involve

to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

synonym: complicated, convoluted, complex

daydreaming

 the act of thinking about something that you would prefer to be doing or have happened to you

synonym: reverie, cloud-castle, imagination

(1) stimulate **daydreaming**, (2) the mental process of **daydreaming**

unconventional

weave

synonym: braid, unite, contrive

documentary

 a film or a radio or television program that gives facts and information about a subject; of or derived from official documents

synonym: film, broadcast, doco

photograph

 a picture or image that is produced by a camera; a visual representation or record of a person, object, or scene that has been captured electronically or on film

fellow

wander

nomadic

hobo

swirl

fierce

adj. severe and violent in a way that is frightening *synonym*: ferocious, convulsive, forceful

creative

 adj. relating to or involving the use of skill and original and unusual ideas to create something

synonym: imaginative, innovative, inventive

(1) **creative** writing, (2) barren of **creative** spirit

All the supervisor has to do is assign tasks that make his subordinates more **creative**.

predecessor

 a person who held a position or office before the current holder

synonym: antecedent, forerunner, precursor

(1) the words of a **predecessor**, (2) **predecessor** model

The new CEO is the **predecessor** of the former CEO.

nomad

 a member of a group of people who move from place to place rather than living in one place all the time; a wanderer; a person with no fixed abode

synonym: wanderer, traveler, rover

steel

 a strong metal alloy made up of iron with typically a few tenths of a percent of carbon used for making things that need a strong structure

asphalt

 a black, sticky substance that is used to surface roads, roofs, and other structures made from a mixture of sand, gravel, and a petroleum-based material called bitumen

artery

hop

highway

a main road, especially one connecting major towns or cities

a group or society

degree

a unit of measurement for angles, temperature, or level of proficiency or achievement; a rank or level of academic or professional attainment

synonym: level, qualification, diploma

(1) bachelor's **degree**, (2) **degree** centigrade She received her **degree** in psychology from the university.

exchange

to give something and receive something else in return, ν. often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or

tradition

traded

synonym: trade, swap, interchange

glimmer

dropout

n. a person who leaves school, college, or a training program before completing it

economy

prism
