# pollution

 the introduction of harmful substances or waste into the natural environment that causes adverse change

synonym: corrosion, deterioration, corruption

(1) environmental **pollution**, (2) high levels of air **pollution**The **pollution** is endangering the local plants and animals.

## separate

- v. to force, take, or pull apart; mark as different synonym: disunite, isolate, ramify
- (1) **separate** video into chapter, (2) **separate** cream from milk

We need to **separate** the aspect of his personality from the part of his competence when making an investment decision.

# struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

# perspective

a confident attitude toward something; a particular style of thinking about something

synonym: viewpoint, standpoint, outlook

#### forbid

#### entity

something that exists independently and has its own identity

synonym: body, object, existent

#### talent

n. a natural ability to be good at something; someone who has a natural ability to be good at something

synonym: endowment, aptitude, capability

#### mobilize

v. to make something ready for action or use; to organize people or resources for a particular purpose

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

adj. forming an essential base or core from which everything else develops or is affected

# complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory

The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

#### large-scale

adj. involving many people or things and involving a lot of change or activity

synonym: big, massive, grand

#### revenue

 the income that a government receives from taxes or that a company earns from its business

*synonym*: earnings, payment, remuneration

# philanthropic

adj. characterized by a desire to promote the welfare of others, especially by donating money or providing charitable aid; of or relating to the practice of philanthropy

#### donation

- a voluntary gift of money, service, or ideas that are given to a person or an organization, or the act of giving them

#### confront

v. to face, meet or deal with a problem or difficult situation or person

### scarcity

n. the state of being in short supply; a small and inadequate amount

synonym: lack, absence, dearth

# overwhelming

#### infinite

adj. unlimited or very great; impossible to measuresynonym: boundless, countless, limitless

#### scalable

adj. capable of being easily expanded or increased in size, number, or scale to meet changing demandssynonym: expandable, flexible, adjustable

#### sustain

v. to supply enough of what somebody or something needs to survive or exist; to accept as valid

# deploy

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

#### economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

# develop

#### economics

#### trade-off

#### classic

adj. judged or deserving to be regarded as one of the best or most important of its kind over a period of time; of a well-known type

# pollute

 to make an area or substance, such as land, air, water, etc., dirty or harmful to living things by adding waste matter or harmful chemicals

synonym: contaminate, corrupt, degrade

# profitable

adj. making or likely to make material gain or profit synonym: advantageous, beneficial, thriving

# simplistic

adj. oversimplified or lacking in complexity or depth; characterized by an attempt to explain something complex or multifaceted with overly vague or simple terms

synonym: basic, uncomplicated, elementary

(1) **simplistic** approach, (2) **simplistic** design

The politician's solution to the problem was too **simplistic** to

solve the underlying issue.

#### emission

- n. the act of production or sending out gas, heat, light, etc. synonym: emanation, radiation, discharge
- (1) global **emissions** of greenhouse gases, (2) the **emission** of light

There are five distinct emissions at five unique wavelengths.

#### efficient

adj. performing at the highest level of productivity with the least wasted effort or resources; capable of achieving maximum output with minimum wasted effort, time, or materials

synonym: productive, effective, competent

#### accident

an unfortunate event, especially one causing damage or injury

synonym: calamity, casualty, chance

#### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process**The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

# efficiency

- n. the state or quality of doing something well with no waste of input such as time or moneysynonym: effectiveness, efficacy, productivity
- (1) better fuel efficiency,(2) an energy efficiencyOur company must continue to strive for greater efficiency.

# employee

- n. a person who is hired to work for a business or organization in exchange for wages or salary; a worker synonym: worker, staff, personnel
- (1) **employee** benefits, (2) **employee** evaluation The **employee** handbook outlines the rules and regulations that all employees must follow.

#### treasure

 a valuable or desirable possession; something that is cherished or held dear; a collection of valuable objects or money that is hidden or protected

synonym: hoard, fortune, gem

treasure hunt, (2) treasure island
 The pirates searched for buried treasure in the dunes.

#### absent

adj. not present in a particular place at a particular timesynonym: missing, away, not present

(1) **absent-minded**, (2) **absent** without leave He was **absent** from the meeting and missed all the important updates.

#### interface

 n. (computer science) a program that controls a display for the user and that allows the user to interact with the system; (chemistry) a surface forming a common boundary between two things

synonym: junction, surface, UI

(1) **interface** between gas and liquid, (2) the user **interface** Detergent weakens the surface tension at the **interface** of two liquids.

# synergy

 the interaction of elements that, when combined, produce a total effect that is greater than the sum of the individual elements

synonym: cooperation, collaboration, partnership

(1) **synergy** collaboration, (2) **synergy** between businesses The new software program was designed to increase productivity by promoting employee **synergy**.

# opposing

adj. competing, fighting, or working against each othersynonym: disagreeing, dissenting, conflicting

(1) **opposing** counsel, (2) in an **opposing** direction We have no intention of **opposing** his idea.

#### ultimate

adj. furthest or highest in degree or ordersynonym: highest, maximum, foremost

(1) the **ultimate** goal in life, (2) the **ultimate** luxury Management must take **ultimate** responsibility for the accident.

#### chemical

adj. relating to or connected with chemistry;

synonym: chemic, synthetic

# (1) toxic **chemicals**, (2) a **chemical** compound The firm has grown into a large **chemical** manufacturing.

#### revolution

a large-scale attempt to overthrow the government of a country, often using violence or war;

synonym: coup, innovation, rebellion

(1) beginning of the industrial **revolution**, (2) a political **revolution** 

The **revolution** by the citizen resulted in a redistribution of wealth.

#### innovative

adj. introducing or using new methods, ideas, etc.

synonym: creative, ingenious, inventive

(1) use of **innovative** technology, (2) stylistically **innovative** works

The Prime Minister stressed the need to create **innovative** industries.

# irrigation

- the agricultural practice of supplying land with water through pipes or channels so that crops grow well
- (1) an **irrigation** ditch, (2) underground **irrigation** system Archaeologists found traces of agricultural **irrigation** channels at the historic site.

# drip

v. to fall in drops or make it fall in drops; (noun) liquid or moisture that falls in drops

synonym: drop, drizzle, trickle

# substantially

adv. to a great extent or degree

synonym: considerably, essentially, largely

(1) the price went up **substantially**, (2) the house was **substantially** built

The proportion of female engineers has **substantially** increased.

#### forestry

 the science, art, and practice of managing forests, including planting, cultivating, and caring for trees and conserving and developing natural forests

synonym: lumbering, timbering, arboriculture

(1) a forestry school, (2) sustainable forestry

The **forestry** industry plays a crucial role in the management and conservation of forests around the world.

### eucalyptus

 a genus of flowering trees and shrubs native to Australia that are known for their aromatic leaves and medicinal properties

synonym: gum tree, Australian tree

(1) eucalyptus oil, (2) eucalyptus leaves

The scent of **eucalyptus** is often used in aromatherapy to promote relaxation.

# yield

the total output of crops, profits, etc. that are produced;
 (verb) to produce or supply helpful something, such as a profit, an amount of food, or information

synonym: proceeds, harvest, output

(1) corn **yield**, (2) the **yield** on the bond

The company's stock gives a high yield.

#### hectare

- n. a unit of area equal to 10,000 square meters

# pulp

 a soft and moist mass of fibers or small pieces, typically produced by grinding, crushing, or shredding plant or wood material; a type of paper made from wood or plant pulp; the soft fleshy part of a fruit or vegetable

synonym: mush, fiber, paste

(1) pulp fiction, (2) orange pulp

The recipe called for squeezing the juice out of the fresh **pulp** and using it in the sauce.

#### expand

v. to increase or to make something greater in size, number, or importance

synonym: extend, grow, boost

# opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

v. to spread or distribute widely, especially information or ideas; to scatter or disperse

#### adapt

v. to make fit for or change to suit a new purpose or environment

synonym: adjust, acclimate, accustom

# capitalism

 an economic system based on the private ownership of the means of production and their operation for profit

synonym: commercialism

(1) advance **capitalism**, (2) under the umbrella of **capitalism** 

**Capitalism** also guarantees intellectual property rights and thus promotes innovation.

# compete

 to strive to achieve more success than someone or something

synonym: contend, contest, vie

(1) **compete** against a friend, (2) **compete** fiercely

#### trivial

adj. of little value or importancesynonym: insignificant, minor, unimportant

(1) a trivial man, (2) for trivial reasons

#### attribute

 to say or regard that something is the result of a particular thing; (noun) a quality or feature that someone or something possesses;

synonym: ascribe, blame, (noun) feature

# simultaneously

adv. at the same time

synonym: concurrently, coincidently, together

#### unleash

v. to suddenly release a strong force, emotion, etc. that cannot be controlled

synonym: discharge, free, release

# possibility

- n. a chance that something may happen or be truesynonym: chance, prospect, likelihood
