#### adventure

 a journey or a series of events that is unusual, exciting, or dangerous

*synonym*: experience, happening, incident

## investigate

v. to conduct a systematic or formal inquiry to identify and evaluate the facts of a crime, problem, statement, etc. to establish the truth

synonym: examine, analyze, look into

(1) **investigate** the matter, (2) **investigate** a data leak The committee **investigated** several apparent inconsistencies.

## journalist

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

synonym: reporter, newsperson, press

(1) a China-based **journalist**, (2) **journalist** on a magazine Foreign TV crews and **journalists** can go as they please in various locations during the Olympics.

### bewitch

v. to attract or interest someone a lot so that they cannot think in a sensible way

synonym: charm, enchant, fascinate

(1) hold the charm to **bewitch**, (2) **bewitch** him into a frog Her beauty **bewitched** him.

#### reckless

adj. marked by a lack of care about danger and the likely results of your actions

synonym: impetuous, irresponsible, thoughtless

(1) **reckless** driving, (2) in a **reckless** manner **Reckless** youth makes rueful age.

## scope

 the range of one's perceptions, thoughts, or actions, or a subject that

synonym: content, coverage, extent

(1) **scope** of a project, (2) have broad **scope** The **scope** of human thought is diverse.

## gradual

adj. happening slowly over a long period of time or distance; not steep or abrupt

synonym: incremental, gradational, piecemeal

(1) a gradual process, (2) a gradual change

The country experienced a **gradual** increase in population.

#### diminish

v. to reduce or be reduced in size, extent, or importance; to make something smaller, weaker, etc.

synonym: decline, dwindle, lessen

(1) diminish a reputation, (2) diminish swelling

As people get old, their energies may diminish.

#### scratch

 to cut or damage the surface of something or the skin with a sharp or pointed object

synonym: claw, rub, scrape

(1) **scratch** off a name, (2) **scratch** my signature Don't **scratch** your mosquito bites.

## ecology

- n. the study of the relationships between living organisms, including humans, and their physical environment
- (1) science of **ecology**, (2) the **ecology** of the island Many companies are now enthusiastically embracing the knowledge of **ecology** for sustainable development.

### bore

v. to make someone feel weary or uninterested, often by talking at length about uninteresting or mundane topics; to cause someone to feel bored or unengaged; (noun) a hole or tunnel drilled or dug into the ground, either for exploration or extraction of natural resources

synonym: bear, tire, weary

(1) **bore** diameter, (2) **bore** him with his stories

The lecture on quantum physics **bored** me to tears.

evolve

v. to develop gradually, or to cause the development of something or someone gradually

synonym: develop, mature, grow

(1) **evolve**, (2) **evolve** over the past decade Eyeless fish **evolved** in dark caves.

horn

n. a hard, pointed, often curved part that grows on the top of the heads of some animals, such as sheep and cows; a noisemaker or musical instrument that makes a loud noise when you blow through it

synonym: cornet, funnel, alarm

(1) a handle of horn,(2) horn of a vehicleHe enjoyed hearing the tootles of their horns with beer.

tusk

 a long, pointed tooth, usually found in animals such as elephants, walruses, or wild boars, which protrudes from the mouth and is used as a weapon or for digging

*synonym*: ivory, tush, horn

(1) **tusk** of an elephant, (2) **tusk-like** tooth

The ivory poacher was arrested for possession of illegal **tusks**.

fang

 a long, pointed tooth, typically in the upper jaw, used for biting and chewing, as in snakes and some other animals

synonym: tooth, canine, tusk

(1) fang mark, (2) poison fang

The vampire bared its **fangs** and growled.

claw

n. a curved, pointed appendage found on the foot or leg of an animal, used for gripping or grasping; a human hand with long, narrow fingers that are curved like a claw; a machine or tool with a claw-like opening used for gripping or lifting objects

synonym: paw, talon, nail

(1) claw marks, (2) claw hammer

The bear used its **claw** to catch a fish in the river.

possess

 to have or own something or to have as an attribute, knowledge, skill, etc.

synonym: keep, maintain, own

(1) **possess** a basic knowledge, (2) **possess** divine powers He **possesses** a good sense of humor.

courage

 n. the ability to face danger, difficulty, uncertainty, or pain without being overcome by fear or despair; the quality of being brave or courageous

synonym: bravery, valor, fearlessness

(1) mental courage, (2) inspire courage

It takes a lot of **courage** to stand up for what you believe is right.

aggression

 the act of attacking or assaulting; hostile or violent behavior

synonym: hostility, assertiveness, antagonism

(1) **aggression** by a hostile country, (2) naked **aggression** The dog's **aggression** made it difficult for its owners to take it for a walk.

## navigate

v. to plan and direct the way that a ship, plane, etc. will travel, often by using a map

synonym: guide, helm, voyage

(1) **navigate** the Pacific, (2) **navigate** through a document Our knowledge helps **navigate** our clients successfully.

## opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

#### constraint

 a limit or restriction on something, such as an action, behavior, or thought

synonym: limitation, restriction, bound

constraint on business activity, (2) strict time
 constraints

The budget **constraint** forced them to make difficult decisions.

## bump

v. to hit or knock against something hard, often with a dull sound; to meet with by accident

synonym: collide, hit, jolt

bump against a wall, (2) bump up prices
 She accidentally bumped into him in the crowded room.

### conquer

v. to bring under control by force or authority synonym: defeat, overpower, subdue

(1) **conquer** fatal disease, (2) **conquer** the world You must **conquer** your anxiety about driving.

#### uncertain

adj. not being sure of something; not being able to choose synonym: doubtful, skeptical, pending

(1) numerous **uncertain** factors, (2) take an **uncertain** attitude

She was **uncertain** about her friend's intentions.

#### dominant

adj. more important, influential, or easy to notice than anything else of the same type

synonym: chief, predominant, prevailing

(1) achieve a **dominant** share, (2) **dominant** force Her company soon won a **dominant** market share.

#### aim

v. to try or plan to get or achieve something

*synonym*: aspire, direct, target

(1) **aim** at a specific target, (2) **aim** to be a nurse We **aim** for an overseas expansion.

#### industrialize

- v. to organize the production of something into an industry
- synonym: motorize
- (1) **industrialize** service, (2) **industrialized** textile production

The nations of South East Asia will quickly **industrialize** and catch up with the West.

#### encounter

v. to face something, particularly something unpleasant or difficult, while attempting to do something else; to meet, especially unexpectedly

synonym: meet, run into, come across

(1) **encounter** a crisis, (2) **encounter** a storm I'm prepared to **encounter** challenges throughout this adventure.

#### unmet

adj. describing a need, goal, or expectation that has not been satisfied or fulfilled

synonym: unsatisfied, unfulfilled, unmatched

(1) unmet demand, (2) unmet needs

The **unmet** expectations of the customers led to a decrease in sales.

## privilege

 a special right or advantage that only one person or group of people has, usually because they are rich and powerful in a society

synonym: benefit, authorization, advantage

(1) a breach of **privilege**, (2) **privilege** of membership In the Middle Ages, the right to hunt in the wild was the **privilege** of royalty and nobility.

#### romanticize

to make something seem more attractive or appealing than it is, especially by exaggerating or idealizing its qualities; to view or present something in a romantic or sentimental way

synonym: idealize, glorify, sentimentalize

(1) **romanticize** the past, (2) **romanticize** the idea of love It is easy to **romanticize** a new job or opportunity, but it is important to remain objective and realistic about the challenges that come with it

## evolutionary

adj. relating to or denoting how living things develop or change from earlier forms

synonym: developmental, mutative, transformative

(1) ecology and evolutionary biology, (2) the evolutionary process

**Evolutionary** algorithms can find ways to optimize that humans do not anticipate.

## lifespan

the length of time for which a person, animal lives, or thing exists

synonym: duration, lifetime, continuance

- (1) **lifespan** extension, (2) **lifespan** retrieval curve Generally speaking, men have a shorter **lifespan** than women.
- to go after and try to catch wild animals to kill them for

food, sport, or profit synonym: chase, pursuit, quest

- (1) hunt a job, (2) hunt after knowledge Hounds **hunt** their prey by using their keen scent.
- the result or effect of an action, event, etc.

*synonym*: result, consequence, effect

### hunt

#### outcome

(1) improved student **outcomes**, (2) a desirable **outcome** They awaited news of the **outcome** of the election.

#### mortal

adj. subject to death; unrelenting and deadlysynonym: deathly, perishable, non-eternal

a mortal combat, (2) this mortal life
 humans are mortal and will eventually die.

## myopic

adj. near-sighted; lacking foresight or ability to plan;narrow-minded or lacking in perspectivesynonym: nearsighted, short-sighted, unforesightful

(1) **myopic** vision, (2) **myopic** thinking
His **myopic** view of the situation prevented him from seeing the bigger picture.

### stumble

- v. to miss a step and fall or nearly fall; to walk unsteadily synonym: bumble, struggle, misstep
- (1) **stumble** financially, (2) **stumble** through life She **stumbled** over the tree root.

## tip

 the top or extreme point of something slender or tapering, usually a mountain or hill; a piece of advice about something practical; a small amount of money given for services

synonym: edge, advice, gratuity

(1) the tip of a paintbrush, (2) give the waiter a tip.I will introduce some tips on learning English in this class.

#### spear

 a weapon with a long shaft and a sharp metal point used for battle, hunting, and fishing in the past

synonym: javelin, pike, lance

(1) hunting **spear**, (2) sharp-pointed **spear**Ancient people made **spears** with wood entirely.

#### enrage

v. to make someone extremely angry synonym: anger, incense, infuriate

### giant

adj. enormous; much bigger or more important than similar items usually are

synonym: big, gigantic, huge

(1) giant trees, (2) giant tech company

The **giant** jets gradually dominate the world's airlines.

#### aurochs

- an extinct species of wild oxen that inhabited Europe, Asia, and North Africa until the 17th century
- (1) extinct aurochs, (2) aurochs skeleton The cave paintings in Lascaux depict aurochs and other animals that were once native to Europe.

## predict

- to state beforehand that something will happen in the future, mainly based on knowledge or experience synonym: forecast, anticipate, foresee
- (1) **predict** the future, (2) **predict** when she will arrive It's notoriously challenging to **predict** birth rates.

## authenticity

- the quality of being real or genuine synonym: genuineness, originality, credibility
- (1) authenticity verification, (2) lack authenticity The museum's experts confirmed the authenticity of the painting.

## intelligible

- adj. capable of being understood or apprehended *synonym*: apprehensible, understandable, comprehensible
- (1) **intelligible** pronunciation, (2) **intelligible** to anyone He gave me an **intelligible** answer.

## concept

- an idea or principle associated with something abstract synonym: idea, notion, vision
- (1) learn new concepts, (2) concept car One such rapidly growing **concept** is quantum cryptography.

### unfamiliar

adj. not known or recognized; not experienced or encountered before

synonym: unknown, strange, foreign

(1) the **unfamiliar** surroundings, (2) around **unfamiliar** people

She was **unfamiliar** with the city and got lost while trying to find her way back to the hotel.

#### devote

v. to commit or dedicate oneself or one's time, effort, or energy to a particular task or purpose

synonym: commit, dedicate, apply

(1) **devote** all of my energies, (2) **devote** my own life He **devoted** himself to studying the history of ancient civilizations.

#### rewild

v. to restore an area of land to its natural state, especially by reintroducing locally extinct species

synonym: restore, return, rehabilitate

(1) rewild land, (2) rewild an area

The government is considering a plan to **rewild** certain areas by reintroducing native species and removing non-native ones.

#### definition

 a concise explanation of the meaning of a word, phrase, or symbol

synonym: description, connotation, meaning

(1) a precise **definition**, (2) the **definition** of a word Parallel lines are, by **definition**, lines on the same plane that never cross.

#### fascinate

to attract and hold the attention of someone deeply and irresistibly

synonym: captivate, intrigue, mesmerize

(1) **fascinate** the public, (2) **fascinate** the young The magic tricks **fascinated** the children.

#### mass

 a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or crowded together

synonym: abundance, crowd, mob

(1) a mass of molten rock, (2) critical mass

The **mass** of people who do not own property is politically impotent.

### ecosystem

- all the plants and living creatures in an area and the way they affect each other and the environment
- (1) marine **ecosystem**, (2) change the **ecosystem**Human conservation efforts often fail unexpectedly because they disturb the balance of the **ecosystem**.

## exciting

adj. causing a lot of interest or excitement synonym: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

(1) **exciting** football player, (2) **exciting** news

The findings of the experiment were both **exciting** and unexpected.

## discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important **discovery**.

## widespread

adj. existing or happening in various places or among many people

synonym: across-the-board, overall, general

(1) widespread use, (2) widespread fear of nuclear war In medieval times, death punishment was widespread and socially accepted.

## trophic

adj. of or relating to feeding and nutrition; of or relating to the relationships between organisms and their food sources

synonym: nutrient, nutritional, feeding

(1) **trophic** factor, (2) **trophic** transfer

The **trophic** level of an organism determines its position in the food chain.

### cascade

- n. a small waterfall or series of small waterfalls; a succession of stages or operations or processes or units
   synonym: waterfall, watercourse, step
- cascade connection, (2) transistor cascade
   The cascade of waterfalls in the national park was a breathtaking sight.

### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

- (1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process** The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.
- a series of connected links or objects; a system or group of interconnected elements; a restraint or shackle

synonym: series, string, link

(1) chain reaction, (2) supply chain

The **chain** on my bike broke, leaving me stranded.

#### tumble

chain

 to fall suddenly, often uncontrollably; to topple or turn over; to decline sharply and quickly in value, quality, or performance

synonym: fall, stumble, plummet

(1) **tumble** down the hill, (2) confidence **tumbles** as unemployment rates rose

The value of the currency **tumbled** against major international currencies.

#### classic

nation

adj. judged or deserving to be regarded as one of the best or most important of its kind over a period of time; of a well-known type

synonym: definitive, traditional, typical

- (1) a **classic** experiment, (2) Chinese **classic** literature He displayed the **classic** symptoms of depression.
- a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) **nation-state**, (2) a seafaring **nation** 

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

#### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) **statistics** for cancer, (2) official **statistics**The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

#### reintroduce

v. to bring back something that has been previously abolished or discontinued

synonym: bring back, restore, reestablish

(1) **reintroduce** species, (2) **reintroduce** capital punishment

The government is planning to **reintroduce** wolves to the national park to restore the balance of the ecosystem.

## slightly

adv. in a small degree or extent; a little synonym: barely, narrowly, scarcely

(1) increase **slightly**, (2) **slightly** alkaline soils He moved his body **slightly** to the left.

#### absent

adj. not present in a particular place at a particular time synonym: missing, away, not present

(1) absent-minded, (2) absent without leave

He was **absent** from the meeting and missed all the important updates.

### vegetation

 plants in general, particularly those indigenous to a particular region or spot

synonym: flora, leafage, foliage

(1) tropical vegetation, (2) dense vegetation

The **vegetation** in the area is quite diverse.

### graze

v. to feed on grass or other vegetation, especially by nibbling at it repeatedly; to break the skin of a body part by scraping

*synonym*: nibble, feed, scrape

(1) turn cattle out to **graze**, (2) **graze** the left shoulder The sheep **graze** on the green grass in the meadow.

#### remarkable

*adj.* worthy of attention because unusual or special *synonym*: outstanding, exceptional, extraordinary

(1) **remarkable** achievement, (2) the **remarkable** breadth of knowledge

The election was a remarkable success for the Whigs.

### trap

 a piece of equipment or hole for catching animals or people; (verb) to catch animals or people and prevent them from escaping

synonym: catch, snare, pinfall

(1) set a **trap**, (2) **trap** an animal

The enemy fell right into the **trap**.

### valley

 a long depression on the surface of the land, which typically contains a river

synonym: canyon, gorge, dale

(1) valley bottom, (2) basin-shaped valley

The valley had received a mild snowfall the previous week.

## gorge

 a deep narrow valley between hills or mountains, usually with steep sides and a river running through it synonym: canyon, gully, ravine

(1) cast the **gorge**, (2) the **gorges** of the Yangtse River We must pass through the narrow **gorge** with a stream running through it.

## immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately** 

A suspension order from the court is effective **immediately**.

## quintuple

- v. to increase or multiply by five; to make something five times as much or as many; (adjective) being five times as great or as many
- (1) **quintuple** their income, (2) **quintuple** angle
  The team aims to **quintuple** its sales by the end of the fiscal year.

### bare

 adj. not covered or clothed; lacking embellishment or decoration; mere or basic; undisguised or open; empty or devoid of something

synonym: naked, exposed, uncovered

(1) bare minimum, (2) bare essentials

She wore a simple dress with a bare neckline

## aspen

 a deciduous tree with smooth, white bark that often trembles or quakes in the wind; a type of skiing that involves quick, short turns on steep slopes

synonym: tree, hardwood

(1) aspen grove, (2) golden aspen leaves

The **aspen** trees turned a bright yellow in the fall, creating a beautiful sight.

#### willow

 a deciduous tree or shrub that is often found near water, characterized by long, flexible, and slender branches and narrow leaves

synonym: sallow, osier, saugh

(1) weeping **willow**, (2) **willow** overhanging the bank Under the **willow** tree, they had a lovely picnic in the shade.

#### cotton

- a plant that is grown in warm countries and bears bolls containing seeds with soft and long hairs that are made into textile fiber and thread for sewing
- (1) cotton cloth, (2) culture of cottonThe price of raw cotton continued to rise.

## songbird

- n. a bird with a musical call, such as a blackbird or thrush synonym: songster
- (1) migratory **songbird**, (2) tropical **songbird**Federal law protects the majority of **songbirds**.

## migratory

 adj. relating to or characterized by the movement of individuals or groups from one place to another, often for regular seasonal or environmental reasons

synonym: nomadic, wandering, roving

(1) migratory species, (2) migratory routeThe migratory birds flew thousands of miles to reach their

wintering grounds.

### greatly

adv. to an extraordinary extent or degree; very much synonym: enormously, broadly, grandly

(1) **greatly** affect the situation, (2) **greatly** support that player

They **greatly** admired our actions.

#### beaver

 a large, semiaquatic rodent with a wide, flat tail and webbed feet, noted for its ability to build dams and lodges

synonym: rodent

(1) beaver dam, (2) an eager beaver

The mountain **beaver** built a dam to block the stream.

## engineer

 a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining something such as machines, structures, or software synonym: architect, creator, builder

(1) a civil **engineer**, (2) **engineer** shortage

The **engineer** will repair my telephone tomorrow morning.

niche

 a specialized role or position that a species occupies within an ecosystem; a job or position particularly well suited to the person who occupies it

synonym: role, position, habitat

(1) **niche** market, (2) every **niche** of society

The species occupies a unique **niche** in the ecosystem as a top predator.

dam

 a wall constructed over a river to block the flow of water, mainly used to generate energy

synonym: barricade, barrier, embankment

(1) dam-building program, (2) dam collapsing

The break in the **dam** threatened the valley.

otter

- a semiaquatic mammal with a sleek, streamlined body, short legs, webbed feet, and dense, soft fur, found in and around freshwater and coastal areas
- (1) otter in the river, (2) sea- otter fur

The playful **otter** swam around the river, diving in and out of the water.

reptile

n. a cold-blooded animal that has dry, scaly skin and lays eggs on land, such as snakes, lizards, and turtles

synonym: lizard, serpent, snake

(1) reptile exhibition, (2) fossil reptile

Alligators are a type of reptile that live in swamps and rivers.

amphibian

a cold-blooded animal that can live both on land and in water

synonym: frog, toad, salamander

(1) **amphibian** species, (2) **amphibian** habitat Scientists are concerned about the rapid decline in

## amphibian populations around the world.

#### hawk

 a bird of prey typically having short rounded wings and a long tail; an advocate of an aggressive policy on foreign relations

synonym: militarist, jingo, aggressor

(1) cast off a hawk, (2) congressional hawk

That team signed a center forward who was a ball- hawk.

#### weasel

- n. a small carnivorous mammal with a long and slender body, short legs, and a long and narrow head, known for its ability to hunt rodents and small animals; someone who behaves in an untrustworthy, deceitful, or cunning manner
- (1) **weasel** words, (2) **weasel** her way out of doing the dishes

The **weasel's** long and slender body allows it to easily navigate small spaces.

## badger

n. a small, burrowing mammal with short legs and a distinctive striped face; a person or thing that persistently annoys or bothers someone; (verb) to pester or harass someone persistently, typically with a series of annoying requests, questions, or demands

synonym: nuisance, annoyance

(1) **badger** territory, (2) **badger** him with questions
The **badger's** thick fur and tough skin make it well-suited for digging and burrowing in rough terrain.

bald

adj. having no hair on the head; having a smooth, shiny scalp with no hair

synonym: hairless, smooth, bare

(1) bald head, (2) become bald

He is completely **bald**, having lost all his hair due to chemotherapy.

### eagle

 a large predatory bird with a hooked beak and broad wings, known for its keen eyesight and powerful flight; a symbol of strength and freedom in many cultures

*synonym*: bird of prey, raptor

(1) eagle feathers, (2) eagle eyes

The bald **eagle** symbolizes freedom and strength in the United States.

#### shrub

 a woody plant that is smaller than a tree and has several main stems emerging from the soil

synonym: bush, hedge, fern

(1) tree and **shrubs**, (2) small **shrub** 

These are **shrubs** with no trunks that rarely grow taller than 3 meters.

#### reinforce

v. to strengthen or support something, especially by adding another material to it; to make emotion, idea, etc. stronger

*synonym*: strengthen, fortify, support

(1) **reinforce** the military, (2) **reinforce** good behavior We should **reinforce** the troops at the front line.

calf

- n. a young cow, bull, or other domestic bovine animalssynonym: baby cow, heifer, yearling
- (1) baby calf, (2) a calf elephant

The newborn **calf** stood on wobbly legs, trying to find its mother's milk.

#### meander

v. to wander or roam aimlessly or leisurely; to follow a winding or circuitous course, as a river or road

synonym: wander, zigzag, twist

(1) **meander** down the river, (2) **meander** aimlessly We decided to **meander** through the park and enjoy the scenery.

### erosion

 the wearing away of rock, soil, or land by natural processes such as wind or water *synonym*: corrosion, weathering, decay

(1) erosion control, (2) wind erosion

The **erosion** of the coastline has accelerated due to rising sea levels.

riffle

to quickly flip or shuffle through the pages of a book, document, or stack of papers; to move or pass quickly and lightly through something

synonym: shuffle, flip, flick

- (1) **riffle** through papers, (2) **riffle** over pebbles and rocks The librarian quickly **riffled** the returned book's pages to ensure no notes were left inside.
- a group of people who follow a particular religious or philosophical belief system, especially one that is regarded as outside the norm or mainstream

synonym: group, faction, cult

(1) sect beliefs, (2) secret sect

The minority **sect** believed in a set of unconventional religious practices.

wildlife
