synonym: bacterium, microbe, pathogen

(1) antibiotic-resistant **germ**, (2) a **germ-free** environment The **germ** of his idea came from watching birds flying in flocks.

sweetheart

 an affectionate term for a person, often a romantic partner, who is loved or cherished

synonym: darling, beloved, love

(1) **sweetheart** deal, (2) **sweetheart** romance I can always rely on my **sweetheart** to lift my mood when feeling down.

mute

adj. silent; not speaking or unable to speak; not expressed or articulated

synonym: silent, unspoken, voiceless

(1) mute button, (2) mute sound

The actor played a **mute** character and had to rely on facial expressions to portray his emotions.

quadriplegia

- n. paralysis of all four limbs and the torso, usually resulting from injury to the spinal cord in the neck region
- (1) **quadriplegia** patients, (2) **quadriplegia** care

 After the accident, he had **quadriplegia** and could not move his arms or legs.

fascinate

v. to attract and hold the attention of someone deeply and irresistibly

synonym: captivate, intrigue, mesmerize

(1) **fascinate** the public, (2) **fascinate** the young The magic tricks **fascinated** the children.

amaze

v. to fill with wonder, surprise, or admiration

synonym: astound, surprise, stagger

(1) amaze and entertain visitors, (2) amaze everyone

The magician's tricks **amazed** the audience.

robotic

adj. of or relating to mechanical robots; (robotics) the interdisciplinary branch of computer science and engineering with the practical use of robots

synonym: automated, mechanical, laborsaving

(1) **robotic** arm, (2) **robotic** guide operation

The surgeon removed the tumor using **robotic** video assistance.

willow

 a deciduous tree or shrub that is often found near water, characterized by long, flexible, and slender branches and narrow leaves

synonym: sallow, osier, saugh

(1) weeping **willow**, (2) **willow** overhanging the bank Under the **willow** tree, they had a lovely picnic in the shade.

surrogate

- adj. acting as a substitute or replacement for someone or something else; having a similar function or purpose synonym: substitute, replacement, deputy
- (1) **surrogate** pregnancy, (2) **surrogate** decision

 The **surrogate** mother gave birth to a healthy baby for the couple who couldn't conceive independently.

shave

v. to remove body hair with a razor; to cut the price of something

synonym: trim, cut down, prune

(1) **shave** my head, (2) **shave** cheese

That supermarket tried to **shave** certain costs by saving electricity.

unthinkable

adj. too unlikely or shocking to imagine or acceptsynonym: impossible, inconceivable, outlandish

(1) an **unthinkable** coincidence, (2) in **unthinkable** trouble That accident was something **unthinkable** with my long experience.

drone

 a low continuous humming noise; someone who takes more time than necessary; a pilot-less aerial vehicle that is operated by remote control

synonym: hum, whirr, idler

(1) **drone** flight, (2) the speaker's **drone**

He heard a **drone** of sirens roar from the neighboring town.

bedridden

adj. unable to move or leave one's bed for a prolonged period of time due to illness, injury, or disability

synonym: immobile, bedfast, paralyzed

(1) bedridden with illness, (2) long-term bedridden

The **bedridden** patient required round-the-clock care from a team of doctors and nurses.

hoop

- n. a circular band or ring, often made of metal or wood, used as a toy, a part of the equipment, or a decoration synonym: ring, circle, band
- hoop earring, (2) basketball hoop
 The circus clown jumped through a fiery hoop as the

audience gasped in amazement.

oculist

 a medical professional who specializes in the treatment of diseases and disorders of the eye; an ophthalmologist or an optometrist

synonym: optician, eye doctor, ophthalmologist

(1) skilled oculist, (2) pediatric oculist

My grandmother visited the renowned **oculist** for her annual eye examination.

rift

 a break or fissure in a relationship, organization, or physical structure; a large crack in the ground, rock, or other surfaces

synonym: split, break, gap

(1) rift between friends, (2) geological rift

Their disagreement caused a rift in their friendship.

walrus

a large marine mammal that belongs to the seal family,
 Odobenidae, known for its long tusks, large body size,
 and ability to live in the Arctic regions

synonym: seal, sea lion, marine mammal

(1) walrus mustache, (2) walrus habitat

The Arctic walrus lounged on the beach, basking in the sun.

immerse

v. to become fully involved in a particular activity; to dip or submerge in a liquid, especially so that they or it are entirely covered

synonym: dip, inundate, submerge

(1) **immerse** the cloth in the dye, (2) completely **immerse** the ingredient

He **immersed** himself in his research.

excite

- v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate
- (1) **excite** the crowd, (2) **excite** rebellion The news of her promotion **excited** her.

acuity

 the ability to perceive or discern with a high degree of accuracy and sensitivity; sharpness or keenness of senses, especially vision or hearing

synonym: sharpness, clarity, precision

(1) mental acuity, (2) hearing acuity

The optometrist tested my visual **acuity** by asking me to read various-sized letters on a chart.
