### propose

#### dissolve

#### schematic

### engineer

- a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining something such as machines, structures, or software synonym: architect, creator, builder

### patient

### specialize

eagle

 a large predatory bird with a hooked beak and broad wings, known for its keen eyesight and powerful flight; a symbol of strength and freedom in many cultures

The bald **eagle** symbolizes freedom and strength in the United States.

liver

- a large organ in the body, involved in many metabolic processes, such as detoxification of the organism, and the synthesis of proteins

eternal

- adj. being without beginning or end; lasting forever synonym: endless, everlasting, undying

cartilage

#### nick

#### crest

#### harvest

 n. yields of plants in a single growing season; the period of the year when gathering occurs on a farm

#### surgeon

 a doctor who is trained to perform medical operations that involve cutting open a person's body

synonym: sawbones, doctor

### transplant

v. to move or transfer something from one place or person to another; to take living tissue or an organ from one person, animal, part of the body, etc. and put it into or onto another

*synonym*: relocate, emigrate, graft

(1) **transplant** a heart, (2) **transplant** my family to America He tried to **transplant** the seedling into a larger pot.

#### vascular

adj. of or relating to blood vessels, especially the veins and arteries that carry blood throughout the body

synonym: circulatory, cardiovascular, arterial

(1) vascular disease, (2) vascular surgery

The doctor detected a blockage in the patient's **vascular** system.

### defect

*n.* an imperfection, shortcoming, or lack of something or someone

synonym: fault, blemish, flaw

(1) visual **defects**, (2) **defects** of character

**Defects** in the design could cause much worse issues.

#### tremendous

adj. very great in degree or extent or amount or impact; extremely good

*synonym*: enormous, giant, immense

(1) **tremendous** amount, (2) **tremendous** popularity We had a **tremendous** time yesterday.

#### recreate

v. to make something that existed previously happen or appear to exist again

synonym: renovate, vivify, revive

(1) **recreate** a single country, (2) **recreate** the feeling of the 1920s

She **recreated** the atmosphere of the pre-war age with her stage setting.

#### aftereffect

n. a consequence or result that follows after an event, experience, or action, sometimes with a delayed onset, often used to describe the lingering impact of traumatic experiences or medical treatments

synonym: consequence, aftermath, outcome

(1) **aftereffect** of an earthquake, (2) **aftereffect** of a drug I still experience **aftereffects** from the car accident I was in last year.

### simplify

v. to make something more straightforward, more understandable, or easier to do

synonym: streamline, clarify, elucidate

(1) **simplify** my life, (2) **simplify** the process Please **simplify** your explanation for the children.

rid

v. to make someone or something free of unwanted or unpleasant tasks, objects, or person

synonym: do away with, free, clear

(1) get **rid** of the rats, (2) **rid** the body of waste products We must **rid** ourselves of pollution.

fancy

v. to want to do or have something; (noun) something that many people believe but that is false, or that does not exist; imagination or fantasy

synonym: imagine, visualize, (noun) fantasy

(1) **fancy** a cup of coffee, (2) a flight of **fancy** I don't **fancy** acting in such an important role.

#### scaffold

 a temporary platform or structure used to support workers and materials during construction or maintenance work

synonym: platform, staging, framework

(1) scaffold construction, (2) go to the scaffold

The construction workers set up the **scaffold** to reach the top of the building.

#### enormous

adj. extremely large or great synonym: huge, giant, gigantic

(1) **enormous** amount, (2) **enormous** potential Shakespeare's output of poetry was **enormous**.

#### catalyst

 a person or thing that causes an important event to happen or changes the current situation rapidly; (chemistry) a substance that initiates or accelerates a chemical reaction without being changed itself

synonym: accelerator, stimulant, motivation

(1) a **catalyst** in the process of hydrolysis, (2) **catalyst** for reform

The global financial crisis acted as a **catalyst** to unite the country.

#### vivo

adj. alive or existing in a living organism or system; relating to or involving "live" organisms or systems, particularly in scientific research or experimentation

synonym: alive, living, animate

(1) vivo imaging, (2) in vivo research

The **vivo** colors of the flowers made the garden come alive.

#### bioreactor

 a device or system used to cultivate living cells, tissues, or organisms for industrial or research purposes

synonym: fermenter

(1) **bioreactor** engineering, (2) anaerobic **bioreactor**The scientists optimized the conditions in the **bioreactor** to increase the yield of the desired product.

### periosteum

n. a dense layer of connective tissue that covers the external surface of bones, serving to anchor tendons and ligaments and also providing a source of new bone cells during growth and repair

synonym: membrane, tissue, shell

(1) **periosteum** layer, (2) **periosteum** inflammation Damage to the **periosteum** can delay bone healing and increase the risk of complications like infection

### normally

### tight

### embryo

 an animal organism in the early stages of growth, either in its mother's womb or in an egg, or a plant that is developing in a seed

synonym: fetus, seed, origin

(1) destruction of human **embryos**, (2) **embryo** cloning Our latest project is still at the **embryo** stage.

### develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym:

evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

inject

v. to put a liquid such as a drug or other substance into a person's or an animal's body using a needle and syringe (= small tube)

synonym: shoot, infiltrate, insinuate

(1) **inject** under the skin, (2) **inject** a personal opinion into a debate

Let's try to **inject** a bit of enthusiasm into your performance.

#### underneath

adv. under or below something else

synonym: below, under, beneath

### liquid

 a substance, such as water or oil that flows freely and is neither a solid nor a gas

synonym: fluid

(1) colorless **liquid**, (2) hazardous **liquid** 

The sponge takes up the liquid well.

#### rigid

adj. extremely strict and difficult to change or adapt; incapable of or resistant to bending

synonym: strict, inflexible, stringent

(1) rigid rules, (2) rigid structure

He was unpopular because of his **rigid** adherence to the rules.

gel

n. a semi-solid substance, often transparent or translucent, that is used in various products from personal care to food to medicine, and which typically consists of a gelling agent that thickens the liquid

lift

essence

 the basic or most important part or quality of something that makes it what it is

synonym: core, nature, disposition

cavity

an empty space or hollowness within a solid object,
 especially within the body, such as a tooth or bone; a
 hole or depression in a surface or the ground

synonym: hollows, holes, indenture

pinhole

n. a tiny hole in a material, often made by a needle, that allows light or other substances to pass through

incision

 a sharp cut made in something with a sharp tool, especially during a medical procedure

### proliferation

 a rapid or uncontrolled increase in the number or amount of something; the process of growing, producing, or spreading rapidly and excessively

### histology

n. the branch of biology that deals with the study of the microscopic structure of tissues and cells; the microscopic examination and study of tissues to observe their structure, composition, and function
