synonym: buzzword, trend

This cute dog's photo spread around the world as an Internet **meme**.

greet

 to say hello to someone; to express welcome on meeting someone

synonym: welcome, salute, acknowledge

(1) greet a customer, (2) greet an idea

He **greeted** his friends with a warm smile and a hug.

determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

mockup

 a full-scale or scaled-down model or representation of a design or concept, typically used for demonstration, evaluation, or testing purposes before the final product is produced

synonym: prototype, model, sample

(1) mockup design, (2) product mockup

The designer created a website **mockup** to get client feedback before finalizing the design.

mistakenly

adv. in a mistaken or incorrect way; wronglysynonym: incorrectly, erroneously, wrongly

(1) **mistakenly** left his keys, (2) **mistakenly** delete the important file

He mistakenly thought the red liquid was juice, but it was

phishing

n. the act of attempting to trick individuals into divulging sensitive information or clicking on a malicious link by posing as a trustworthy entity in emails, texts, or other forms of communications

synonym: scamming, cyber fraud, online deception

(1) phishing attacks, (2) phishing email

I received a fraudulent email, a **phishing** scam, trying to obtain my personal information.

bystander

 a person who witnesses an event or situation but does not actively participate or intervene

synonym: spectator, observer, witness

(1) innocent **bystander**, (2) shocked **bystander**

The **bystander** effect is a phenomenon where people are less likely to intervene in an emergency if others are present.

gamble

v. to take risky action in the hope of being successful; to play or game for money or other stakes

synonym: bet, venture, wager

(1) **gamble** \$100 on the race, (2) **gamble** away my fortune Will you **gamble** on the result of the fight?

visualize

 to form a mental image or concept of something; to make something visible

synonym: imagine, picture, envision

(1) **visualize** data, (2) **visualize** flying through space She tried to **visualize** the layout of the new house in her mind.

catastrophe

- n. a sudden event that causes extreme ruin and misfortunesynonym: disaster, calamity, cataclysm
- (1) **catastrophe** risk management, (2) avoid climate **catastrophe**

university system.

dissonance

- n. a lack of harmony or agreement between people or things; a harsh or discordant combination of soundssynonym: conflict, disharmony, disagreement

synonym: bridal, matrimonial, marital

benign

adj. kind and gentle; not harmful or malicious

perspective, position, viewpoint

gloomy
