#### crisis

## fertilizer

#### chemical

## agriculture

 the practice or science of cultivating the land or raising stock

## precedent

 a previous event or action that serves as an example or rule to authorize or justify similar events or actions in the future

synonym: example, model, pattern

## biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

#### nutrient

 any substance that is essential for the maintenance and growth of living things

synonym: food, vitamin

(1) **nutrient** medicine, (2) a **nutrient** for hair

They used fast-acting **nutrients** on the flowers in the flower beds.

soil

n. the top layer of Earth in which plants grow

synonym: earth, ground, mud

(1) **soils** retentive of moisture, (2) parched **soil** 

**Soil** moisture is another significant component controlling soil respiration.

#### essential

adj. indispensable; fundamental synonym: critical, crucial, basic

(1) **essential** amino acid, (2) **essential** commodities of life Trial and error is an **essential** part of education.

## nitrogen

- a chemical element with the symbol N and atomic number 7, which is a highly reactive element that forms part of many compounds, including amino acids and proteins

#### calcium

 a chemical element with the symbol Ca and atomic number 20, which is an important mineral for the human body

#### extract

## problematic

*adj.* full of difficulties; difficult to deal with or solve *synonym*: inappropriate, inconvenient, worrisome

## precise

adj. sharply exact or accurate or delimited synonym: accurate, exact, distinct

## component

 one of several parts that combines with others to form something bigger

synonym: element, part, factor

### molecule

 a group of two or more atoms held together by attractive forces known as chemical bonds

synonym: particle, element, atom

#### cellular

adj. of or connected with the cells of animals or plants; of or connected with a mobile telephone system that uses several short-range radio stations instead of wires

#### communicate

## extraordinary

adj. exceptional, unexpected, very unusual; surpassing the ordinary or usual

#### launch

to send or propel something into the air or space using a device such as a rocket, missile, or spacecraft; to make something available or on sale for the first time

synonym: start, initiate, begin

#### discuss

 to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

## increasingly

adv. more and more

*synonym*: more and more, progressively

## politician

 a person who is a member of a government or law-making organization, especially as an elected member of parliament, etc.

synonym: congressperson, lawmaker, legislator

- a hole in the ground or a cavity in a surface; a place for storing or holding something; a section of a theater or sports arena where people can sit

pit

## dimension

## giant

## perspective

## comparison

#### mention

#### graph

 a picture consisting of a line, lines, points, etc., that shows how two or more sets of certain quantities are

#### related to each other

This bar **graph** shows sales over the past five years.

## rough

adj. not quite exact or correct; having or caused by an irregular surface

*synonym*: inelegant, coarse, barbarian

(1) **rough** and tough, (2) **rough** estimation

The vehicle bounced along the **rough** mountain road.

## represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

## prediction

 the act of predicting the future by reasoning; a statement made about the future

synonym: forecast, anticipation, foretelling

(1) make my **predictions**, (2) gloomy **predictions**These results muddled the **prediction**.

peak

 the point to which something or someone is at its strongest, best, or most successful; the pointed top of a mountain

synonym: summit, vertex, apex

(1) at **peak** hour, (2) the **peak** current in the circuit This measurement aims to reduce traffic at **peak** periods.

dot

- n. a very small circular mark, especially one that is printed synonym: drop, dab, fleck
- (1) connecting the **dots**, (2) **dot** blot method

The wallpaper had a pattern of pink **dots** on a white surface.

#### retire

v. to withdraw from one's position or occupation, especially because of age

synonym: relinquish, step down, withdraw

## paradox

 a statement, situation, or person that has two opposite facts or features and therefore seems impossible, is difficult to understand, or is strange;

## organization

a group of people who work together for a shared purpose

synonym: association, institution, community

## paradoxical

- adj. seemingly contradictory or absurd because of having two opposite features or facts, though it is probably truesynonym: contradictory, conflicting, perplexing

#### alternative

## optimize

## microscopic

#### mushroom

 a type of fungus that grows on dead or decaying organic matter and typically has a stalk and an umbrella-shaped cap

The **mushroom** risotto was delicious, but I couldn't identify all the mushrooms in it.

## mysterious

adj. difficult to understand, explain, or identify; having an aura of secrecy, intrigue, or puzzlement

## complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

*synonym*: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

#### fascinate

to attract and hold the attention of someone deeply and irresistibly

synonym: captivate, intrigue, mesmerize

(1) **fascinate** the public, (2) **fascinate** the young The magic tricks **fascinated** the children.

## laboratory

 a workplace for doing scientific research or teaching science; a lab

*synonym*: lab, workshop, testing room

(1) **laboratory** accident, (2) anthropology **laboratory**Animal protection groups call for an end to animal testing in a **laboratory**.

## symbiosis

 a close, prolonged association between two or more different species of organisms, typically to the advantage of all

synonym: cooperation, interdependence, mutualism

(1) industrial **symbiosis**, (2) **symbiosis** establishment The **symbiosis** between the coral and the algae is an important example of mutualism.

#### bidirectional

 adj. capable of functioning or moving in two opposite directions; involving or allowing communication or transmission in two opposite directions

synonym: two-way, reciprocal, dual

#### mutual

*adj.* common to or shared by two or more parties *synonym*: shared, common, joint

#### beneficial

adj. helpful, useful, or sound; promoting or enhancing well-being

synonym: useful, advantageous, fruitful

#### association

 a people or groups of people who have joined in a single organization together for a particular purpose; a social or business connection or relationship

synonym: affiliation, collaboration, society

(1) word **associations**, (2) a scholarship **association** His membership in the **association** provided him with numerous benefits.

## mycorrhiza

n. a mutually beneficial association between a fungus and the roots of a plant, in which the fungus helps the plant absorb water and nutrients, and the plant provides the fungus with sugars produced through photosynthesis

*synonym*: fungus, root, relationship

slide

## normally

adv. usually; under normal conditionssynonym: commonly, generally, naturally

(1) complete **normally**, (2) not **normally** drink much I don't **normally** take a vacation in the middle of summer.

#### surround

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop
- (1) **surround** a town, (2) a stone wall **surrounds** the palace On three sides, mountains **surround** the settlement.

#### ineffective

adj. not producing any significant or intended effect or result synonym: useless, feeble, fruitless

(1) an **ineffective** speech, (2) pull an **ineffective** player These treatments were **ineffective** against a virus.

## scope

n. the range of one's perceptions, thoughts, or actions, or a subject that

synonym: content, coverage, extent

(1) **scope** of a project, (2) have broad **scope** The **scope** of human thought is diverse.

#### invention

n. the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation; the act of inventing

*synonym*: creation, design, innovation

(1) the **invention** of new techniques, (2) common **invention** Necessity is the mother of **invention**.

## biotechnology

the application of technological processes and methods to biological systems to develop new products or techniques, such as genetically modified organisms or biopharmaceuticals

synonym: genetic engineering, bioengineering, genetic modification

- (1) biotechnology research, (2) modern biotechnology Advancements in **biotechnology** have revolutionized medicine and agriculture.
- to develop gradually, or to cause the development of something or someone gradually

synonym: develop, mature, grow

## adapt

trace

evolve

to make fit for or change to suit a new purpose or environment

synonym: adjust, acclimate, accustom

## filament

## proliferate

 to grow or increase rapidly in number; to reproduce or spread rapidly, especially in an uncontrolled manner

## eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

## penetrating

adj. able to pierce or enter deeply into something; having a sharp, intense quality that cuts through superficiality or confusion

synonym: keen, piercing, sharp

## typical

adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

synonym: characteristic, usual, distinctive

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

## exchange

v. to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

synonym: trade, swap, interchange

interface

 n. (computer science) a program that controls a display for the user and that allows the user to interact with the system; (chemistry) a surface forming a common boundary between two things

diagram

 a simplified illustration of the appearance, structure, or workings of something

synonym: chart, figure, graph

#### recall

v. to remember something

synonym: remember, retrieve, recollect

(1) recall the incident, (2) recall his name

#### soluble

## argument
