adorn

 to make something or somebody more attractive or beautiful synonym: decorate, beautify, embellish

(1) **adorn** a bride, (2) **adorn** the table with flowers
The architect **adorned** the interior with great artworks and frescoes.

carving

- n. the act or process of cutting or shaping a hard material, such as wood or stone, into a specific form or design
 synonym: sculpture, engraving, sculpture
- (1) a wood **carving**, (2) **carving** instrument

 The intricate **carving** on the wooden box was the work of a master craftsman.

inscription

- n. a message or design that is written or engraved on a surface of something, such as stone or metalsynonym: engraving, writing, script

grotesque

limestone

dissolve

- synonym: disband, disappear, liquefy
- (1) **dissolve** the sugar, (2) officially **dissolved** the marriage The political party **dissolved** after much internal fighting.

bacteriophage

- n. (also "phage") a virus that infects and destroys bacteriasynonym: phage, bacterial virus, bacteriovore
- (1) DNA-containing bacteriophage, (2) bacteriophage infection

Scientists are studying the use of **bacteriophages** to combat bacterial infections.
