 a stone coffin, often adorned with sculpture or inscriptions, usually used to hold the remains of a deceased person or people

synonym: coffin, tomb, casket

The pharaoh was buried in an ornate **sarcophagus** complete with intricate hieroglyphics.

## coffin

 a box or container used to bury a dead body; a case or structure resembling a coffin

synonym: casket, box, chest

(1) coffin lid, (2) wooden coffin

The priest prayed over the **coffin** before it was lowered into the ground.

# typical

adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

synonym: characteristic, usual, distinctive

(1) typical leader, (2) fairly typical symptoms

This artwork is **typical** of her work.

# adorn

 to make something or somebody more attractive or beautiful

synonym: decorate, beautify, embellish

(1) adorn a bride, (2) adorn the table with flowers

The architect **adorned** the interior with great artworks and frescoes.

# decorative

adj. serving to make something look more attractive or pretty; embellishing

synonym: ornamental, beautifying, embellishing

(1) decorative art, (2) decorative design

The **decorative** tiles on the wall added a colorful and unique touch to the room.

# carving

the act or process of cutting or shaping a hard material,
 such as wood or stone, into a specific form or design

synonym: sculpture, engraving, sculpture

(1) a wood carving, (2) carving instrument

The intricate **carving** on the wooden box was the work of a master craftsman.

# inscription

 a message or design that is written or engraved on a surface of something, such as stone or metal

*synonym*: engraving, writing, script

#### crawl

to move forward slowly, as people or animals with their bodies near the ground

synonym: creep, drag

(1) **crawl** across the floor, (2) **crawl** away from a car Along the gravel roads, sizeable yellow school buses **crawl**.

# grotesque

adj. bizarre or fantastic in shape, appearance, or character; fantastic; bizarre

synonym: bizarre, deformed, monstrous

(1) have **grotesque** design, (2) **grotesque** appearance The **grotesque** sculpture made me feel uneasy.

### horror

 intense fear or disgust, especially at something shocking or terrifying

synonym: fear, terror, dread

(1) horror movie, (2) horror-struck look

The stories of war crimes filled her with **horror**.

# origin

n. the first existence or beginning of something

*synonym*: root, source, ancestor

(1) origin of information, (2) racial origin

There are various hypotheses concerning the **origin** of life.

#### trace

- v. to find or discover someone or something that was lost synonym: seek, follow, depict

# empire

## flesh

 the soft substance composing the body of a person or animal, as opposed to bones and other structures

#### desirable

adj. worth having or achieving; pleasing, attractive, or sought after

synonym: appealing, attractive, advisable

#### construct

v. to build or create something; to assemble or combine different parts to form something whole

synonym: build, assemble, create

(1) construct a 3D image, (2) construct a dam

He **constructs** hypotheses that no mathematician has ever imagined before.

# unclear

 adj. poorly stated or described and therefore not easy to understand; not easy to perceive

synonym: ambiguous, fuzzy, obscure

(1) an unclear match, (2) in no unclear terms

It is important not to undertake tasks with **unclear** objectives to improve productivity.

# widespread

adj. existing or happening in various places or among many people

synonym: across-the-board, overall, general

(1) widespread use, (2) widespread fear of nuclear war In medieval times, death punishment was widespread and socially accepted.

## accurate

adj. correct and exact in all details

synonym: exact, precise, proper

# bacteriophage
