typography

the art or process of printing with type; the design,
 layout, and arrangement of printed material, including text and images

synonym: printing, typesetting, font design

inward

adj. directed or facing towards the inside; inside or inward-looking

synonym: internal, introspective, interior

(1) inward peace, (2) inward cargo

The **inward** motion of the tide was gradually slowing down.

proverb

 a short saying that expresses a truth or gives advice based on practical experience synonym: adage, saying, maxim

(1) a hackneyed **proverb**, (2) ancient **proverb**The famous **proverb** "actions speak louder than words" reminds us to focus on deeds instead of words.

pictograph

 a symbol or picture that represents a word, phrase, or concept; a form of communication that uses pictures or symbols to convey information

synonym: symbol, glyph, icon

hand-drawn pictograph, (2) pictograph symbols
 The cave paintings are ancient pictographs that tell stories of the past.

intricate

adj. having many different parts and small details that all work together

synonym: complicated, convoluted, complex

intricate details, (2) intricate lacework
 The politician managed to deal with that intricate issue.

rainforest

- a forest rich in biodiversity that is generally found in tropical settings with heavy annual rainfall
- (1) **rainforest** destruction, (2) tropical **rainforest**The destruction of the **rainforest** is a ticking time bomb for the Earth.

interweave

v. to combine or blend substantive parts or elements; to interlace; to mix or intermingle

synonym: intertwine, intertwist, interlace

(1) **interweave** threads, (2) **interweave** ideas

The author expertly tried to **interweave** the story's plot and characters.

polyphony

 music consisting of two or more independent melodies or voices sounding together

synonym: multi-part, harmonization, counterpoint

(1) a beautiful **polyphony**, (2) the **polyphony** of the music

The composer wrote a complex **polyphony** for the orchestra, featuring multiple layers of sound.

weave

v. to make cloth, a carpet, a basket, etc., by repeatedly crossing a single thread through two sets of long threads at a right angle to them

synonym: braid, unite, contrive

(1) weave on a loom, (2) weave a story

The girl weaves a garland for her friend.

syllable

- a single unit of spoken language more significant than a phoneme containing a vowel sound and usually one or more consonants
- syllable structure, (2) single syllable
 Emphasize the second syllable when pronouncing it.

well-defined

adj. having clear and precise boundaries or characteristics;
 distinctly outlined or delimited; easily understood or recognizable

synonym: clear, distinct, precise

(1) **well-defined** terms, (2) **well-defined** objectives The **well-defined** set of instructions made it easy to assemble the furniture.

fractal

 a complex geometric pattern or shape that repeats itself on smaller and smaller scales, often occurring in nature or mathematical equations

synonym: pattern, design, geometry

(1) fractal pattern, (2) fractal art

The coastline of Norway is one of the most famous examples of **fractal** geometry in nature.

antiquity

the ancient past, especially the period of classical civilization

synonym: ancientness, oldness, hoariness

(1) remote antiquity, (2) unrecorded antiquity

The study of antiquity is important for understanding the

history, culture, and civilization of the past and their influence on the present.

cuneiform

 adj. of or relating to a form of writing consisting of pressing a reed stylus into clay to create wedge-shaped marks used in ancient Mesopotamia

synonym: wedge-shaped, triangular, pyramidal

(1) **cuneiform** writing, (2) external **cuneiform** bone The **cuneiform** tablets contain some of the oldest known examples of literature.

hieroglyph

a writing system using picture symbols, such as the one used in ancient Egypt

synonym: character, cipher, figure

(1) Egyptian **hieroglyph**, (2) the **hieroglyph** of the bird Each beautiful **hieroglyph** represents either an idea or a sound.

inscription

- n. a message or design that is written or engraved on a surface of something, such as stone or metalsynonym: engraving, writing, script
- (1) **inscription** on a plaque, (2) funerary **inscriptions**The ancient coin had an **inscription** in Latin and a picture of the emperor on the other side.

limestone

 a sedimentary rock that is composed mainly of calcium carbonate, which is the mineral calcite

synonym: calcareous rock, chalk

(1) sheer **limestone** cliffs, (2) **limestone** pavement The Great Pyramid of Giza was built using blocks of **limestone**.

decipher

v. to read or understand something that is written in code or in a difficult or obscure way

synonym: interpret, decode, translate

(1) decipher code, (2) decipher message

He spent hours trying to **decipher** the ancient text.

paleography

n. the study of ancient handwriting and scripts, particularly those used before the advent of printing, which involves deciphering and interpreting historical documents and manuscripts

synonym: calligraphy, script

(1) paleography study, (2) ancient paleography

By employing **paleography** techniques, researchers could determine the approximate age of the old manuscript.

seminal

adj. highly original, influential, or innovative; containing the seeds or beginnings of future development or growth; (of medicine) of or relating to semen or the male reproductive system

synonym: influential, groundbreaking, original

(1) **seminal** research, (2) **seminal** duct

The book was a **seminal** work in psychology, influencing generations of researchers.

vindicate

 to clear someone or something of blame, suspicion, or doubt; to show or prove that someone or something is right or justified

synonym: justify, absolve, exonerate

(1) **vindicate** innocence, (2) **vindicate** his reputation The athlete's exceptional performance **vindicated** their coach's training methods and strategies.
