#### herd

 a group of animals of the same type that live or are kept together as livestock

synonym: flock, brood, horde

(1) herd of cattle, (2) the common herd

### wildebeest

 n. (also "gnu") a large African antelope with a broad muzzle and curved horns, known for its annual migration

synonym: gnu

(1) grazing wildebeest, (2) wildebeest herd

The migration of **wildebeest** across the Serengeti is an awe-inspiring natural phenomenon.

#### shoal

n. a shallow area in a body of water, such as a river, lake, or sea, where the depth is significantly less than surrounding areas; a sandbar or underwater ridge that can be a hazard to navigation; a large group of fish or other aquatic animals swimming together

synonym: sandbank, sandbar, shallows

(1) **shoal** of fish, (2) reef **shoal**

#### flock

n. a gathering of sheep, goats, or birds

synonym: herd, crowd, assembly

# spectacle

 something or someone seen, especially a notable or unusual sight; an optical device consisting of a frame that houses a pair of lenses for correcting defective vision

*synonym*: marvel, sensation, phenomenon

(1) pretty **spectacle**, (2) **spectacle** lens

She could not help watching the sad **spectacle**.

#### hunt

v. to go after and try to catch wild animals to kill them for food, sport, or profit

synonym: chase, pursuit, quest

(1) hunt a job, (2) hunt after knowledge

Hounds **hunt** their prey by using their keen scent.

### breed

 to keep animals for producing offspring in a regulated manner

synonym: raise, multiply, reproduce

(1) breed horses, (2) breed suspicion

This animal **breeds** in northern latitudes.

### assume

 to think or accept something to be true without having proof of it; to take or begin to have power; to begin to exhibit a specific quality or appearance

synonym: guess, presume, suppose

(1) **assume** a lousy attitude to his boss, (2) **assume** an important role

The following example **assumes** that the capacity of each battery is the same.

# brine

 a strong solution of salt water used for preserving food, especially meat or fish; saline water found in salt mines or evaporated from seawater synonym: saltwater, seawater, saline

(1) **brine** solution, (2) **brine** shrimp

The recipe called for a teaspoon of **brine** to add flavor.

# shrimp

 a small, freshwater or saltwater creature with a slender body and long legs

synonym: prawn, langoustine, scampi

(1) **shrimp** cocktail, (2) **shrimp** farming

The seafood restaurant had a variety of dishes featuring **shrimp**.

# typical

adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

synonym: characteristic, usual, distinctive

### **swarm**

 a group of many things, such as insects, fishes, etc., in the air or water or on the ground

synonym: horde, hive, throng

(1) a **swarm** of mosquitoes, (2) locust **swarm**A **swarm** of angry bees attacked because we had

approached the hive.

# span

 the entire length of something, such as time or space from beginning to end; the amount of space that something covers

synonym: interval, period, length

(1) the **span** of a bird's wings, (2) the average life **span**He slightly modified the **span** of training because it was just before a match.

# parasite

 an organism that lives on or in another organism and benefits by deriving nutrients at the other's expense

synonym: hitchhiker, leech, saprophyte

(1) blood-sucking **parasite**, (2) **parasite** disease

Tapeworms are **parasites** that live in the intestines of humans and animals.

#### infect

v. to affect a person, an animal, or a plant with a disease-causing organism

synonym: pollute, contaminate, affect

(1) **infect** other animal species, (2) **infect** a computer with a virus

Children often **infect** parents with this head cold.

# tapeworm

 a parasitic worm that lives in the intestines of animals, including humans, and feeds on their food; it is long and ribbon-like in shape with a segmented body

*synonym*: helminth, cestode, ribbon worm

The doctor diagnosed the patient with **tapeworm** infection.

gut

n. the long tube in the body of a person or animal through which food passes when it leaves the stomach; the mental strength or bravery required to do something difficult or unpleasant

# genital

adj. of or relating to the external and internal reproductive organs

synonym: reproductive, genetic, sexual

### hooked

adj. being caught or caught up in something; curved down like an eagle's beak

### freelance

# sympathize

# drain

- v. to empty or dry something by removing the liquid from it synonym: draw off, bleed

# nutrient

 any substance that is essential for the maintenance and growth of living things

synonym: food, vitamin

beds.

## involve

# ultimate

adj. furthest or highest in degree or order

# flamingo

- a tall wading bird with predominantly pink or orange plumage and a long, slender neck and legs, native to Central and South America and parts of Africa

# reproduce

# manipulate

# conspicuous

*adj.* visible or observable; likely to draw attention *synonym*: apparent, noticeable, evident

# consumption

Her golden hair was **conspicuous** in China.

### spot

- a particular location or place; a small round or roundish area, differing in color or feels from the surface around it
   synonym: dot, mark, place
- (1) beauty **spot**, (2) a **spot** on his honor This remote **spot** is rarely visited.

#### devour

 to eat or consume something eagerly or ravenously; or to destroy something rapidly

synonym: consume, swallow, destroy

(1) devour a meal, (2) devour my way

She **devoured** the mystery novel in one sitting.

### sociable

- adj. being friendly, outgoing, and inclined to engage in social activities or interactions; enjoying the company of others
- synonym: friendly, outgoing, affable
- (1) **sociable** gathering, (2) **sociable** atmosphere She is a very **sociable** person who loves meeting new people.

#### volition

 n. the power or ability to make choices or decisions by one's own will or conscious choice; the act of consciously choosing or deciding

synonym: choice, decision, free will

(1) volition level, (2) freedom of volition

He canceled the meeting of his own **volition** as he thought it was unnecessary.

# opposition

the act of disagreeing or resisting; the state of strong disagreement

synonym: resistance, hostility, antagonism

(1) **opposition** campaign, (2) meet with **opposition** The **opposition** party strongly disagreed with the government's proposed legislation.

# hijack

v. to seize control of an airplane or other vehicle during an operation, especially with violence

synonym: commandeer, seize, pirate

# brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon

# parasitic

*adj.* living off another organism to the detriment of the host *synonym*: symbiotic, dependent, exploitative

(1) **parasitic** relationship, (2) brood- **parasitic** bird The **parasitic** plant was able to survive by stealing nutrients from its host.

### suicide

- n. the act of killing yourself intentionallysynonym: self-destruction, self-annihilation, felo-de-se

#### cricket

- leaping insect; a game played with a ball and bat by two teams of eleven players

#### swallow

v. to make food, drink, pills, etc., pass down your throat into your stomach; (noun) small long-winged songbird noted for swift, graceful flight and the regularity of its migrations

#### larva

the immature free-living form of insect or an animal, which at hatching from the egg, is fundamentally unlike its parent and must metamorphose

synonym: caterpillar, grub, maggot

(1) larva of a butterfly, (2) a moth larva

The butterfly emerged from its **larva** stage.

#### worm

- a long, thin creature with a soft and long cylindrical tube-like body, no limbs, and a lack of eyes
- (1) wiggly worms, (2) can of worms

**Worms** help dispose of the food waste produced by humans.

#### release

- to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge
- (1) **release** a prisoner, (2) **release** CO2 into the air The animal rights group worked to **release** the dolphins back into the wild.

# protein

- a molecule made up of a long chain of amino acids, which is essential for the structure and function of the body's tissues
- (1) stress **protein**, (2) **protein** synthesis The body needs a certain amount of **protein** to build and repair tissues.

#### addle

- to confuse or muddle someone's mind; to make something unclear or incoherent synonym: confuse, muddle, befuddle
- (1) addle my mind, (2) addle my taste buds The unfamiliarity of the foreign language addled his

comprehension, but he was eager to learn.

to die or cause to die by being unable to breathe underwater

*synonym*: douse, drench, overwhelm

#### drown

(1) **drown** in a bath, (2) I was **drowned** in work Floods have the potential to **drown** any subsurface animals easily.

# wriggle

v. to twist and turn with quick, writhing motions; to move in a twisting or contorting manner

synonym: squirm, jerk, twist

(1) wriggle free, (2) wriggle in surprise

The child started to **wriggle** out of their seatbelt during the long car ride.

# corpse

n. the dead body of a human being

*synonym*: body, remains, cadaver

desiccated corpse, (2) the corpse of an animal
 The police found the corpse in the abandoned building.

### cavalcade

n. a procession or parade of people or vehicles, typically on horseback or in vehicles, often celebrating a special occasion or event; a continuous flow or series of things, often described as a dazzling or impressive display

synonym: procession, parade, march

(1) **cavalcade** of cars, (2) extravagant **cavalcade**The parade featured a colorful **cavalcade** of floats, marching bands, and dancers.

fungus

 a type of organism that includes yeasts, molds, and mushrooms, which are heterotrophic, meaning they do not produce their food and must consume organic matter to survive

synonym: mold, mildew, yeast

(1) fungus infection, (2) symbiotic fungus

Certain types of **fungus** can be toxic to humans, causing severe illness if ingested.

### virus

 a tiny infectious organic material that causes disease in people, animals, and plants

synonym: bacterium, germ, ailment

(1) spread of the virus, (2) a strain of virus

An infected person in the hospital will likely pass the **virus** to others.

#### insect

- any small creature that has six legs and a body divided into three sections
- (1) **insect** antenna, (2) **insect** biology

These **insects** are more prevalent above a certain latitude.

### subvert

v. to undermine, overthrow, or weaken the established order, system, or authority; to bring about fundamental change or revolution from within

synonym: overthrow, undermine, sabotage

(1) **subvert** power, (2) **subvert** expectations

The rebels could **subvert** the government's plans by leaking classified information.

### override

v. to use one's authority or power to cancel or disregard something, especially a decision or rule made by someone else

synonym: overrule, annul, nullify

(1) **override** the system, (2) **override** a veto

The CEO decided to **override** the decision made by the lower-level managers.

#### creature

n. a living being, especially an animal synonym: being, animal, organism

(1) **creature** of habit, (2) artificial **creature** 

The deep sea **creature** was unlike anything the scientists had ever seen before.

#### enthrall

v. to capture or hold someone's attention or interest completely; to captivate or fascinate

synonym: captivate, charm, fascinate

# compelling

adj. arousing strong and irresistible interest, attention, or admiration

*synonym*: tempting, captivating, influential

(1) tell a **compelling** story, (2) new and **compelling** evidence

# delight

- n. a feeling of great pleasure or happinesssynonym: pleasure, joy, satisfaction
- (1) a tremor of delight, (2) with delight

The **delight** on the child's faces when they received the toy was priceless.

### macabre

adj. gruesome, grisly; relating to death synonym: grotesque, gruesome, sinister

(1) macabre tales of war, (2) macabre art

The **macabre** scene in the horror movie gave her nightmares for weeks.

### **lexicon**

- all the words and phrases of a particular language or branch of knowledge, such as nautical or medical
   synonym: glossary, dictionary, vocabulary
- (1) Greek-English **lexicon**, (2) **lexicon** of business phrases This bilingual **lexicon** was essential for his language improvement.

#### swell

v. to become larger or more inflated; to become more intense or important

synonym: expand, increase, inflate

(1) **swell** at room temperature, (2) **swell** a population His arm was **swelling** from the insect bite.

# phrase

a group of words that mean something specific when used together

synonym:

expression, idiom, term

(1) ready-made **phrases**, (2) noun **phrase** 

We bought a Spanish **phrase** book.

fellow

adj. someone who has the same job or interests as you, or is in the same class, profession, or situation as you

synonym: buddy, mate, affiliate

(1) junior **fellow**, (2) nice **fellow** 

He is the kind of **fellow** who only works for his success.

invite

 $\nu$ . to ask someone to come or join; to offer an opportunity or possibility for something to happen or take place

synonym: ask, request, summon

(1) invite guests, (2) invite criticism

We want to **invite** you to our annual charity event.

resist

v. to refuse to accept something and attempt to prevent it from happening

synonym: fight, defy, revolt

(1) **resist** temptation, (2) **resist** being kissed

I chose to **resist** cancer by trying every possible treatment.

obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand

synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

(1) **obvious** reasons, (2) his conclusion was **obvious** 

There are **obvious** differences between the two wine-producing regions.

plot

 a secret plan or scheme to achieve a specific goal; the plan or main story of a literary work; (verb) to plan secretly, usually something illegal

synonym: scheme, plan, design

(1) **plot** twist, (2) **plot** a revolution

The **plot** of the novel centers around a group of friends who uncover a conspiracy to control the world's water supply.

#### twist

- v. to bend or turn something into a certain shape synonym: wrench, turn, twirl
- (1) **twist** around to the left, (2) **twist** a wet towel He **twisted** pieces of rope out of straw.

# unexpected

- *adj.* not anticipated or regarded as likely to happen *synonym*: surprising, unanticipated, incredible
- an unexpected visitor, (2) some unexpected events
   the unexpected rainstorm caused the collapse of the corral.

# caterpillar

- n. the wormlike larva of a butterfly or mothsynonym: larva, grub, worm
- (1) **caterpillar** of a butterfly, (2) **caterpillar** in a cocoon The wooly bear **caterpillar** munched on leaves all day.

### violent

- adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something
- synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent
- (1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

# thrash

- v. to beat violently with a stick or whip; to move violently and uncontrollably; to defeat soundly in a competition or contest
- synonym: beat, pummel, thrum
- (1) **thrash** about with pain, (2) **thrash** out a deal He **thrashed** in the water when he realized he was too far from the shore.

#### cocoon

- a protective covering spun by some insects and other invertebrates
- synonym: chrysalis, pupa, case
- (1) cocoon silk, (2) a dried cocoon

The caterpillar spins a **cocoon** around itself before turning into a butterfly.

# sibling

*n.* a brother or sister; member of a family born to the same parents

*synonym*: brother, sister, relative

(1) have a **sibling** quarrel, (2) play with my **siblings** Children often copy their parents or elder **siblings**.

wasp

 a flying insect with a narrow waist and a sting, typically feeding on nectar and known for its aggressive behavior towards other insects and animals

synonym: insect, hornet, yellow jacket

(1) wasp nest, (2) wasp sting

A giant wasp flew into the room, and everyone panicked.

### hatch

 to cause an egg to break to allow a young animal to come out; to produce and expand something that is in an early stage

*synonym*: incubate, breed, produce

(1) hatch a plan, (2) hatch a baby chick

The eggs began to hatch, and the small chicks emerged.

#### defend

v. to protect someone or something from attack, criticism, danger, etc.

synonym: protect, guard, support

(1) **defend** my country, (2) **defend** against a threat International law allows each nation to **defend** itself when its rights and interests are illegally violated.

# metamorphose

- v. to undergo a dramatic change in form, structure, or substance; to transform or alter in appearance or naturesynonym: transform, change, alter
- (1) **metamorphose** in appearance, (2) **metamorphose** over time

The caterpillar **metamorphoses** into a butterfly during its life cycle.

# headbanging

the act of violently shaking one's head in rhythm with the music

(1) her severe **headbanging**, (2) **headbanging** and moshing

She shouted with **headbanging** in the front row.

#### zombie

 a dead body that has been brought back to life by a supernatural force; someone who acts or responds in a mechanical or apathetic way

synonym: living dead, ghost, machine

(1) **zombie** bank, (2) **zombie** movie

If you don't get a good night's sleep, you will become a **zombie** at work.

# bodyguard

 a person or group of people employed to protect someone, typically a public figure or a person of importance, from harm or attack

synonym: protector, guard, defender

(1) VIP bodyguard, (2) elite bodyguard unit

The celebrity hired a personal **bodyguard** to protect them from the paparazzi.

# offspring

n. descendant; any immature animal or plant

synonym: children, descendants, heirs

(1) female **offspring**, (2) produce **offspring** 

How many **offspring** does the average lion have?

# desperately

adv. in a way that shows a lack of hope and a willingness to do anything because of the problematic situation; with great urgency

synonym: urgently, perilously, seriously

- (1) desperately anxious, (2) desperately ill patient
- The baby clung **desperately** to her mother.

#### claw

n. a curved, pointed appendage found on the foot or leg of an animal, used for gripping or grasping; a human hand with long, narrow fingers that are curved like a claw; a machine or tool with a claw-like opening used for gripping or lifting objects synonym: paw, talon, nail

(1) claw marks, (2) claw hammer

The bear used its **claw** to catch a fish in the river.

#### solace

 n. comfort or consolation in a time of distress, sadness, or disappointment; (verb) to comfort or console someone in a time of distress, loss, or suffering

synonym: comfort, condolence, peace

(1) solace in music, (2) offer solace

The grieving widow found **solace** in reading her late husband's letters.

# oddity

n. something unusual or different

synonym: rarity, curiosity, peculiarity

(1) find an **oddity**, (2) genetic **oddity** 

The two-headed snake was an **oddity** at the zoo.

### overlook

v. to fail to notice something; to watch over someone; to provide a view from above

synonym: disregard, look down, supervise

(1) **overlook** a street, (2) **overlook** that fact

We cannot overlook an opportunity for great success.

### estuary

 a place where a river meets the sea, typically where the fresh and saltwater mix

synonym: delta, mouth, inlet

(1) estuary port, (2) estuary delta

The mouth of the river formed an **estuary** where saltwater and freshwater met.

# weigh

 to have a particular weight; to carefully evaluate things before making a conclusion

*synonym*: consider, cogitate, count

(1) **weigh** heavily on stock prices, (2) **weigh** a cargo The baby **weighs** 1 pound 3 oz.

#### dissect

v. to cut into pieces to study the structure of something in detail

synonym: analyze, examine, study

(1) **dissect** the data, (2) **dissect** a personality

The scientist **dissected** the frog to study its internal organs.

#### extreme

adj. very great in amount or degree

synonym: farthermost, outermost, fierce

(1) **extreme** sports, (2) **extreme** weather events

Solar gravity creates **extreme** pressures and temperatures.

### abundance

*n.* a significant amount of something; the situation in which there is too much of something

synonym: plenty, affluence, plentitude

(1) an age of **abundance**, (2) an **abundance** of examples A healthy farm provides an **abundance** of food.

# trematode

 a parasitic flatworm belonging to the class Trematoda, also known as flukes, typically has an oval body shape with suckers and undergoes complex life cycles involving multiple hosts

synonym: fluke, flatworm, parasite

(1) trematode infection, (2) liver trematode

The researcher discovered a new species of **trematode** in the freshwater lake.

#### unfortunate

adj. having bad luck or fortune; unlucky

synonym: unlucky, pitiful, wretched

(1) an **unfortunate** orphan, (2) an **unfortunate** situation

The **unfortunate** accident caused many injuries and some fatalities.

#### snail

 a slow-moving mollusk with a spiral shell that it uses to protect its body

synonym: escargot, slug, whelk

(1) snail mail, (2) snail pace

The gardener found a **snail** slowly making its way through the lettuce patch.

# microscopic

adj. tiny; exceedingly precise and detail-oriented; of or used in microscopy

synonym: infinitesimal, tiny, atomic

(1) **microscopic** inquiry, (2) **microscopic** analysis Inspectors noticed **microscopic** cracks in the submarine's hull.

#### stream

*n.* a small, narrow river; a continuous flow of something, such as liquid, gas, people, vehicles, etc.

*synonym*: flow, current, brook

(1) the **stream** of time, (2) an endless **stream** of cars

Jet **streams** are the common name for air currents that form high in the atmosphere.

# grasshopper

 large jumping insect; used to symbolize restlessness or ephemerality

synonym: locust, katydid, cricket
