- v. to give a loud shout to show support, praise, or approval synonym: comfort, encourage, hearten
- (1) **cheer** for the home team, (2) **cheer** me up Supporters in the stands **cheered** at every goal.

#### suffocate

- v. to die or cause someone to die from lack of air or inability to breathe; to be overwhelmed or constricted by a feeling or situation, such as anxiety or oppression
   synonym: choke, smother, stifle
- suffocate to death, (2) suffocate fire
   People can suffocate from a lack of oxygen in confined spaces.

#### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process** The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

#### cerebral

adj. relating to the brain or intellect; intellectual or studious rather than emotional or physical

synonym: brain, mental, intellectual

(1) **cerebral** palsy, (2) **cerebral** cortex

The patient experienced a **cerebral** hemorrhage and required surgery.

### palsy

 a condition characterized by the loss or impairment of movement or sensation due to damage or disease affecting the nervous system; paralysis or weakness

synonym: paralysis, tremor, twitch

(1) muscle palsy, (2) cerebral palsy

Some people with Parkinson's disease may experience tremors and **palsy** in their limbs.

#### exhaust

n. the system in a vehicle that removes waste gases from the engine; (verb) to make someone completely tired

synonym: emission, fumes, (verb) deplete

(1) exhaust pipe, (2) exhaust a topic

The factory's **exhaust** fumes polluted the air and affected the health of the nearby residents.

#### genetic

adj. of or relating to genes (= parts of the DNA in cells) or the science of genes

synonym: hereditary, genetical, inborn

(1) have **genetic** testing, (2) a **genetic** disorder

Understanding protein folding is a vital step in deciphering the **genetic** code.

#### defect

*n.* an imperfection, shortcoming, or lack of something or someone

synonym: fault, blemish, flaw

(1) visual **defects**, (2) **defects** of character

**Defects** in the design could cause much worse issues.

#### curse

 a rude or offensive word or an expression that is not polite and shows that you are very angry synonym: condemnation, cuss, hex

(1) under a curse, (2) few curse words

Many autocratic policies became a **curse** for that country's economy.

uterus

 a hollow muscular organ in the body of a woman or other female mammal in which a baby or young animal develops before birth

*synonym*: womb

(1) uterus cancer, (2) bleeding from uterus

The physician prescribed medication to relieve the contraction of the **uterus**.

cousin

*n*. the child of your aunt or uncle

synonym: relative

cross- cousin marriage, (2) cousin's family
 used to play with my younger male cousins when I was a

little girl.

accident

n. an unfortunate event, especially one causing damage or injury

synonym: calamity, casualty, chance

(1) cause an accident, (2) injury in a car accident

The **accident** partially destroyed my vehicle.

warn

v. to make someone aware of potential danger or difficulty, particularly one that may occur in the future

synonym: alert, caution, admonish

(1) warn a reckless driver, (2) warned me of the plan

I attempted to warn him, but he ignored me.

inspiration

 something that motivates or encourages someone to create or achieve something, or a feeling of excitement or creativity

synonym: motivation, drive, encouragement

(1) source of **inspiration**, (2) get **inspiration** from nature

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He found **inspiration** in the works of his favorite authors.

#### disabled

eve

adj. having a physical or mental condition that limits someone's specific actions that most other people can do

synonym: handicapped, impaired, incapacitated

- (1) a **disabled** veteran, (2) a learning- **disabled** child She was **disabled** in a car accident.
- n. (also as "Eve") the day or period of time immediately preceding a particular event; the biblical figure who was the first woman and wife of Adam, according to the Jewish and Christian faiths

synonym: evening, dusk, twilight

(1) eve of the party, (2) Christmas Eve

The **eve** of the wedding was filled with excitement and anticipation.

### handicap

 a physical or mental condition that limits a person's movements, senses, or activities

*synonym*: disability, impairment, limitation

(1) **handicap** parking space, (2) mental **handicap**The athlete overcame his physical **handicap** to become a world champion.

### oppress

v. to treat people in a cruel and authoritarian way, especially by denying them the same freedoms, rights, etc. as other people

synonym: antagonize, distress, burden

(1) **oppress** the minority, (2) **oppress** the people with force Historically, many countries have often **oppressed** certain religions to gain the support of the majority of the population.

### olympiad

n. a period of four years, originally the time between the ancient Olympic Games and now commonly used to refer to the modern Olympic Games, which are held every four years (1) the modern **olympiad**, (2) summer **olympiad**She won a gold medal in the physics **olympiad** and was praised by her teachers and peers.

#### medal

 a flat, usually circular piece of metal or other material that is often given as an award or commemoration for an achievement, victory, or honor

synonym: award, decoration, badge

(1) gold **medal**, (2) a prize **medal** 

She was proud to receive a **medal** for her hard work and dedication to the sport.

### jersey

 a knitted garment typically made of wool or cotton, worn as a shirt or pullover

synonym: shirt, sweater, top

(1) **jersey** material, (2) fabric of the **jersey** 

I always wear my favorite basketball player's **jersey** to the games.

#### cliff

 a steep rock face, especially one at the edge of the sea or a river

synonym: crag, escarpment, precipice

(1) a bold cliff, (2) cliff diving

He stood at the edge of the **cliff** and looked out to sea.

#### hometown

- n. the town or city where one was born or grew upsynonym: birthplace, home, native place
- hometown celebrity, (2) hometown memory
   always look forward to going back to my hometown during the holidays.

#### hood

a covering for the head and neck, especially one attached to a garment

synonym: hoodie, cowl, cloak

(1) hood ornament, (2) a silk hood

He pulled his waterproof **hood** up to protect himself from the

rain.

#### affliction

 a condition of physical or mental suffering or distress, often caused by illness, injury, or other adversity; a burden or trouble that causes hardship or grief

*synonym*: anguish, distress, suffering

(1) mental affliction, (2) autoimmune affliction

Chronic pain can be a debilitating **affliction** that affects every aspect of one's life.

#### initial

adj. of or happening at the beginning; (noun) the first letter of a word, especially a person's name

synonym: basic, primary, beginning

(1) initial velocity, (2) an initial letter

They took the **initial** step toward reconciliation.

#### mantra

 a word or phrase, often repeated, that is used as a focus for the mind during meditation

*synonym*: hymn, chant, phrase

(1) campaign **mantra**, (2) chant the **mantra** of structural reform

She repeated her personal **mantra** to herself to stay motivated.

sue

v. to claim a person or organization, especially by filing a legal claim for money or redress

synonym: accuse, plead, file

(1) **sue** a company for damages, (2) **sue** my boss for harassment

He planned to **sue** the organization for negligence.

#### heel

n. the rounded back part of the foot below the ankle;
 someone who is morally reprehensible; (verb) to follow someone or something

*synonym*: hindfoot

(1) **heel** bone, (2) **heel** wrestler She wore high **heels** to the party.

#### tactic

 a method or strategy used to achieve a particular goal or objective

synonym: strategy, approach, method

(1) an imprudent tactic, (2) alternative tactic

The coach implemented a new **tactic** to win the game.

### dangle

v. to hang or swing loosely, especially in a way that suggests instability or lack of support; to tempt or tantalize by holding out the prospect of something desirable but uncertain

synonym: swing, hang, drape

(1) dangle a carrot, (2) dangle a pendant

The earring on her earlobe would **dangle** as she moved her head.

#### chase

v. to pursue something or someone to catch or capture them; to go after something vigorously or with determination; (noun) a pursuit or a hunt; a narrow groove or channel cut into a surface, often used for decorative purposes

synonym: pursue, hunt, track

(1) chase a dream, (2) wild goose chase

The police officer **chased** the suspect through the crowded streets until they finally caught him.

### strip

v. to remove the surface from something; (noun) a sizeable narrow piece of something such as paper, metal, cloth, etc., or area of land, sea, etc.

synonym: deprive, undress, (noun) ribbon

(1) **strip** a tire off, (2) coast **strip** 

The doctor advised him to **strip** down for a check.

### kindergarten

 a school or class for young children, usually between the ages of four and six

synonym: preschool, nursery school, daycare

(1) kindergarten class, (2) kindergarten teacher

The kindergarten students were having a good time playing

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#### with toys.

### champion

someone who has won first place in a competition;
 someone who fights for a specific group of people or a belief

*synonym*: victor, winner, fighter

(1) a **champion** of peace, (2) the grand **champion** The **champion** bicyclist outrode all his competitors.

### punch

v. to strike someone or something with one's fist; to make a hole in something

synonym: hit, strike, slap

(1) punch out numbers, (2) punch a ticketHe punched the wall in anger.

### politician

 a person who is a member of a government or law-making organization, especially as an elected member of parliament, etc.

synonym: congressperson, lawmaker, legislator

(1) a **politician** in the ruling party, (2) a corrupt **politician**The **politician** lost his position in the end due to the scandal.

### appropriate

adj. suitable or proper in the circumstances; fitting synonym: fitting, suitable, proper

(1) **appropriate** behavior, (2) an **appropriate** time It would be **appropriate** to dress nicely for the wedding.

### slogan

 a short, catchy phrase or motto that is used by a person, organization, or company to promote a particular product, cause, or idea

synonym: catchphrase, tagline, motto

(1) catchy **slogan**, (2) advertising **slogan** 

The company spent months researching and testing different brand **slogans** before finally settling on 'Just Do It' as their new tagline.

faith

complete trust in something or someone's ability or knowledge; a strong belief in religion, divine power, etc.

synonym: belief, trust, confidence

(1) religious faith, (2) faith in government He kept his robust **faith** in his company.

starve

to suffer or die from lack of food; to cause someone or something to suffer or die from lack of food; to deprive something of necessary nourishment or sustenance

synonym: famish, hunger

(1) **starve** for a victory, (2) **starve** to death If you don't eat soon, you're going to **starve**.

sunrise

the time in the morning when the sun first appears in the

synonym: daybreak, morning, dawn

- (1) beautiful **sunrise**, (2) high-technology **sunrise** industries I got up early to watch the **sunrise** at the summit.
- the time in the evening at which the sun begins to fall below the horizon; (verb) to expire or be terminated automatically at the end of a fixed period

synonym: evening, sundown, dusk

- (1) **sunset** this function, (2) spectacular **sunset** views He is in the **sunset** of his life.
- to hit someone or something quickly, gently, and often repeatedly; to use existing resources, such as energy, knowledge, etc.

synonym: knock, exploit, use

(1) **tap** a new market, (2) **tap** keyboard with an index finger To expand the company, we must **tap** new human resources.

crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry synonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

(1) **crazy** about cars and racing, (2) a **crazy** scheme The rain and thunder are **crazy** today.

sunset

tap

#### afford

- to have enough money or time to be able to buy or do something
- (1) **afford** to buy a new car, (2) **afford** a high travel cost He cannot **afford** a holiday.

### therapy

chic

*n*. the act of caring for someone through medication, remedial training, etc.

synonym: antidote, medicine, treatment

- (1) therapy for a patient, (2) field of gene therapyI underwent aversion therapy for my addiction to alcohol.
- a fashionable, stylish, and sophisticated elegance or gracefulness, particularly in dress or behavior; (adjective) sophisticated, elegant, and fashionable

synonym: style, fashion, trend

(1) chic boutique, (2) casual chic

She's always dressed in the latest **chic**, making her the envy of her friends.

#### vacation

 a period in which someone does not have to attend work or school and is free to do whatever they choose, such as travel or leisure

synonym: leave, recess, break

(1) a short **vacation**, (2) summer **vacation**Do you have a plan for a long **vacation?** 

shore

n. the land along the edge of a sea, lake, broad river, or other large body of water; (verb) to support by placing against something solid or rigid

synonym: coast, seaside, beach

- (1) a sandy **shore**, (2) **shore** up demand
- The waves are beating against the **shore**.

#### zone

 a specific area, region, or section that is marked off or defined in some way

synonym: area, region, territory

(1) time **zone**, (2) **zone** defense

He was reluctant to leave his comfort **zone** and try something new.

#### madonna

- n. a representation of the Virgin Mary, especially in artsynonym: virgin, mother
- (1) wooden **Madonna**, (2) **madonna** painting
  The **Madonnas** and Child painting is a famous piece of art from the Renaissance period.

#### consist

- v. to be composed or made up of synonym: lie in, comprise, exist
- (1) **consist** mainly of cells, (2) **consist** only in knowing facts This examination **consists** of five problems to solve.

#### heal

- v. to make a wound or injury to become well again synonym: recover, bring around, mend
- (1) **heal** a broken bone, (2) **heal** the hurt mind It will take time for her mental scars to **heal**.

#### dunk

- v. to immerse or submerge briefly in a liquid, often repeatedly to coat or moisten; to slam or force something down into a container of liquid
- synonym: dip, plunge, soak
- (1) dunk in water, (2) dunk a basketballI like to dunk my cookies in milk before eating them.

#### miracle

 an act or occurrence that is not explicable by natural or scientific laws and is therefore believed to be caused by God

synonym: wonder, marvel, phenomenon

(1) miracle person, (2) economic miracleThe doctors said that her recovery was a miracle.

#### yoga

n. a Hindu spiritual and ascetic discipline including breath control, simple meditation, and the adoption of specific bodily postures, which is widely practiced for health and relaxation synonym: meditation, exercise, spiritual practice

(1) aerial yoga, (2) yoga teacher

Many people find that regular **yoga** practice can help reduce stress and anxiety.

### boring

adj. lacking interest or excitement; tedious or dull

synonym: dull, tedious, monotonous

(1) boring work, (2) boring day

The lecture was so **boring** that many people fell asleep.

#### reinforce

opera

 to strengthen or support something, especially by adding another material to it; to make emotion, idea, etc. stronger

*synonym*: strengthen, fortify, support

- (1) **reinforce** the military, (2) **reinforce** good behavior We should **reinforce** the troops at the front line.
- a drama set to music, in which the words are sung rather than spoken

synonym: musical, operetta, oratorio

(1) ballad **opera**, (2) **opera** performance

She loves going to the **opera** house and hearing the beautiful music.

#### affirmative

adj. indicating agreement, support, or confirmation; positive or assertive in tone

synonym: positive, confirming, approving

(1) **affirmative** decision, (2) **affirmative** action

The teacher gave an **affirmative** nod to let the student know they had answered the question correctly.

### scholarship

 a grant or payment made to support a student's education usually awarded based on academic or other achievements

synonym: grant, award, stipend

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(1) a scholarship association, (2) college scholarship

She received a full **scholarship** to study abroad.

#### pet

- an animal that you have at home as a companion and treated kindly
- (1) a **pet** bird, (2) a teacher's **pet** I have a parrot as a **pet**.

### depart

- v. to go away or leave, especially to start a journey synonym: go away, leave, vacate
- (1) arrive and **depart** on time, (2) **depart** from the faith We **departed** before the temperature fell below zero.

### intelligent

adj. having the capacity for thought and reason, especially to a high degree

*synonym*: brilliant, clever, competent

(1) an **intelligent** person, (2) **intelligent** assisting system **Intelligent** robots that can cooperate with humans have limited motor output for safety.

### menagerie

 a collection of wild animals, especially exotic ones, kept for display

synonym: collection, assortment, group

(1) a large **menagerie**, (2) **menagerie** keeper The circus had a **menagerie** of animals, including elephants, lions, and monkeys.

### weep

- v. to cry tears because of sadness, rage, or pain synonym: cry, sob, mourn
- weep bitter tears, (2) weep for joy
   I'm easily moved to tears, so I would weep in sympathy if I saw that movie.

#### cast

v. to cause light or shadow to appear on a surface; to assing or choose someone such as an actor or representative, especially by selection process

synonym: throw, project, select

(1) cast a ballot, (2) cast a charming eye

This accident **cast** a dark shadow over their lives.

fin

 a thin flat part on the body of a fish or other aquatic animal used for propulsion or balance

synonym: flipper, appendage, stabilizer

(1) back fin, (2) a fin of a plane

The shark's powerful **fins** allowed it to swim at high speeds.

#### decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta

### rooftop

 the upper surface or cover of a building's roof, often used for recreational or other purposes

synonym: roof, terrace, deck

for dinner.

(1) rooftop live, (2) rooftop deck

They held the dinner party on the **rooftop** terrace, enjoying the beautiful view of the city.

### almighty

adj. having supreme or ultimate power or authority; complete and total; omnipotent

synonym: omnipotent, all-powerful, supreme

(1) almighty power, (2) almighty dollar

The **almighty** ruler of the kingdom held ultimate power over his subjects.

### hysterical

adj. marked by or in a state of excessive or uncontrollable emotion

synonym: agitated, frantic, crazy

(1) hysterical laughter, (2) get hysterical easily

The frustration that had accumulated for a long time made her **hysterical**.

stunt

n. a feat or action that is often dangerous or difficult, designed to attract attention or admiration; something that blocks or impedes growth or development; (verb) to hinder or impede growth or development, especially in a physical or mental sense

synonym: feat, accomplishment, (verb) hinder

(1) skydiving **stunt**, (2) **stunt** brain growth

The daredevil attempted a dangerous **stunt** by jumping off a tall building with a parachute.

excuse

 a reason or explanation, either true or invented, given to justify a fault or defend your behavior; (verb) to make someone free from blame or clear from guilt

synonym: apology, justification, reason

(1) **excuse** for inaction, (2) perfect **excuse**He quickly fabricated an **excuse** for not attending the meeting.

actress

- n. a female actor, particularly in the theater or moviessynonym: performer, player, star
- (1) an **actress** of real quality, (2) a well-known **actress**The acclaimed **actress** received an Oscar for her outstanding performance in the film.

imitate

v. to copy the speech, behavior, appearance, etc. of someone or something

synonym: mimic, emulate, replicate

(1) **imitate** painting styles, (2) **imitate** animal sounds He **imitated** the modus operandi of the famous phantom thief.

sordid

adj. involving immoral or unethical actions; dirty or unpleasant; morally corrupt or depraved

synonym: dirty, seedy, sleazy

(1) sordid business, (2) sordid past

The tabloid newspaper exposed the **sordid** details of the politician's scandalous affair.

#### able-bodied

adj. having a healthy and strong body capable of physical activities; not suffering from physical disabilities that limit movement or strength

synonym: capable, fit, healthy

(1) **able-bodied** worker, (2) **able-bodied** athlete The job posting required an **able-bodied** person for heavy lifting.

### graduate

a person who has a first degree from university or college; (verb) to complete the first course of university or college and get a degree

synonym: alumna, alum, grad

- (1) graduate degree program, (2) honor graduate Many employers hire **graduate** trainees to train as managers.
- a performance by a musician or group of musicians, n. especially playing modern or pop music or jazz; a work that someone undertakes on a temporary basis

synonym: show, concert, engagement

(1) gig economy, (2) have a gig at the stadium We are planning a speaking gig by a well-known author at a community center in a neighboring town.

### promote

to encourage or persuade people to like, buy, use, do, or ν. support something; to raise someone to a higher position or rank

synonym: boost, raise, advertise

(1) **promote** a better relationship, (2) **promote** bad behavior The government should do more to **promote** sustainable agribusiness.

#### wacky

- adj. funny in a slightly odd, peculiar, irregular way synonym: absurd, eccentric, ludicrous
- (1) wacky value, (2) wacky plan for selling more books His friend was a pretty wild and wacky character.

gig

### glorify

v. to praise or honor something or someone, often in an exaggerated or overly positive way; to elevate or exalt something or someone to a higher status or position

synonym: exalt, celebrate, honor

(1) glorify god, (2) glorify violence

Religious leaders often **glorify** their messengers to encourage people to follow their teachings.

### recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

(1) **recognize** talent, (2) **recognize** achievement It's important to **recognize** your strengths and weaknesses.

#### hire

v. to give somebody a job

synonym: employ, engage, lease

(1) hire a guide, (2) hire a car by the hour

We should always be prepared to hire talented recruits.

### fluffy

adj. soft and light, often with a texture that resembles feathers or fur

synonym: soft, feathery, puffy

(1) fluffy clouds, (2) fluffy blanket

The kitten had **fluffy** fur that was soft to the touch.

#### ethnic

adj. relating or belonging to a group of people who share a cultural tradition

synonym: racial, ethnical, tribal

(1) ethnic minority, (2) single ethnic group

Each ethnic group has its unique rituals.

#### comic

adj. funny and making you laugh

*synonym*: amusing, funny, humorous

(1) comic books, (2) a comic hat

The novel is **comic** and tragic.

### turnpike

 a high-speed, limited-access highway, often with toll booths; a barrier across a road with a rotating spindle used to control access

synonym: toll road, expressway, freeway

(1) turnpike interchange, (2) turnpike exit

The toll booth on the **turnpike** caused a traffic backup.

#### chick

n. a baby bird, especially a young chicken

synonym: biddy, fledgling, nestling

(1) baby chick, (2) chick sorting

The majority of the **chicks** are raised on local family farms.

#### **Arabic**

- the Semitic language of the Arab people, widely spoken throughout the Middle East and North Africa; of or relating to Arab peoples, culture, or language
- (1) **Arabic** cuisine, (2) **Arabic** language I'm studying **Arabic** calligraphy as part of my art class.

#### censor

n. a person or institution responsible for examining books, movies, and other forms of media to determine if they are harmful or offensive and should be banned or altered; an official in charge of banning or suppressing information

*synonym*: suppressor, scrutineer, examiner

(1) **censor** a book, (2) **censor** a TV program

The newspaper editor decided to **censor** the controversial headline to avoid backlash.

#### uncover

v. to remove the cover from something; to discover something previously unseen or hidden

synonym: disclose, reveal, unveil

(1) **uncover** a potential problem, (2) **uncover** the truth He continued his investigation and soon **uncovered** another crime.

#### claim

v. to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to

something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

(1) **claim** responsibility, (2) false **claim** 

He wants to **claim** ownership of the abandoned property.

nasty

adj. very bad, unpleasant, or offensive synonym: disgusting, offensive, foul

(1) a **nasty** smell, (2) receive a **nasty** surprise

The weather turned **nasty**.

rumor

 a piece of unverified information of uncertain origin that is spread by word of mouth

synonym: gossip, whisper, talk

(1) a false rumor, (2) rumor mill

There was a baseless **rumor** that the company was going bankrupt.

dean

n. a person in charge of a college, faculty, or other academic departments, tasked with overseeing its operations, policies, and staff; a senior member of a profession or organization who is highly respected for their knowledge and experience

synonym: head, director, chancellor

(1) dean's list, (2) dean of faculty

The university's **dean** was responsible for overseeing the academic programs and policies.

comedy

a genre of dramatic entertainment that aims to amuse and provoke laughter by depicting amusing or ludicrous situations, characters, or events; the use of humor, wit, and satire in writing, films, and other forms of entertainment

synonym: humor, farce, satire

(1) comedy series, (2) romantic comedy

I love going to see live **comedy** shows with my friends.

#### festival

n. a celebration or event, usually marking a particular religious or cultural occasion, often involving processions, music, dancing, and the performance of plays or other artistic works

*synonym*: fair, holiday, celebration

(1) **festival** attendee, (2) international film **festival**The music **festival** attracts visitors from all over the world.

### negative

adj. having the quality of something bad or harmful; expressing refusal

synonym: minus, adverse, pessimistic

(1) have a **negative** effect, (2) a **negative** number The movie has received almost universally **negative** criticism.

### synonymous

adj. having the same or a similar meaning as another word or phrase

synonym: equivalent, interchangeable, similar

(1) **synonymous** terms, (2) non-**synonymous** mutation The phrase "big shot" and "important person" are **synonymous**.

#### mainstream

n. the ideas, opinions, beliefs, etc., that are considered normal or accepted by most people

synonym: prevailing, average, common

(1) join the **mainstream**, (2) **mainstream** political beliefs His thinking is **mainstream** in the country's culture.
