badger

boundary

 a real or imaginary line that marks the limit or extent of something and separates it from other things or places

synonym: border, frontier, limitation

disparate

adj. very different or distinct from something else and is not connected or comparable in any way

synonym: different, distinct, separate

default

zigzag

adj. having short sharp turns or angles

compensate

to make up for a loss, injury, or inconvenience by giving something of value

photograph

lace
